## **Schedule Change Procedures**

**Valid reasons** for a schedule change may include: failing a required course, passing a previously failed course, assessment data, lacking a graduation requirement, and lacking the proper prerequisite.

- 1. Elective changes most often cannot be honored due to teacher unit allocation and the Class Size Reduction Amendment.
- 2. Schedule change requests will **NOT** be considered for teacher preference or change of mind.
- 3. A change request may require the entire schedule to be altered to meet the request you have made, including different teachers and different class periods.
- 4. Once a schedule has been changed, it cannot be changed back again to the original schedule.
- 5. The student is responsible for all class work from the beginning of the semester, regardless of the date the student entered the class.
- 6. No schedule change requests will be approved after the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of the semester.
