### Schedule Change Procedures

**Valid reasons** for a schedule change may include: failing a required course, passing a previously failed course, assessment data, lacking a graduation requirement, and lacking the proper prerequisite.

1. **Elective changes most often cannot be honored** due to teacher unit allocation and the Class Size Reduction Amendment.
2. Schedule change requests will **NOT** be considered for teacher preference or change of mind.
3. A change request may require the entire schedule to be altered to meet the request you have made, including different teachers and different class periods.
4. Once a schedule has been changed, it cannot be changed back again to the original schedule.
5. The student is responsible for all class work from the beginning of the semester, regardless of the date the student entered the class.
6. **No schedule change requests will be approved after the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of the semester.**
