Whether your student is a new or returning Eagle, welcome to the 2024-25 school year – we can't wait to get started in only one week! This message contains information surrounding upcoming events and helpful reminders as we get closer to the beginning of the school year. This is a longer message filled with lots of helpful information but the email contains all of the information that you can peruse at your leisure.

Student's First Day

The first day is, again, August 12^{th} , 2024, and student hours are still from 7:25am – 1:55pm. This year we continue our commitment to both academic and extracurricular excellence, centered around what it means to **SOAR** like an Eagle at East Lake High School: have a **S**uccess mindset, take **O**wnership of learning, have an **A**ttitude centered around positivity, and have **R**espect for all. We're also excited to announce that last year we achieved a school grade of an "A" for the 20th time in school history, with our best performance as a school since the 2016-17 school year! This is a direct result to the unwavering commitment of this outstanding Eagle's staff and the amazing student body's dedication to both their academic studies and involvement outside of the classroom. We can't wait to see what the 2024-25 school year brings as we continue to SOAR to new heights!

We've spent countless hours to ensure that our campus is safe, clean, and ready for another amazing school year – a massive shout out to our plant operations team for all of their hard work throughout the summer to prep the campus for day 1! As you prepare for the first day of school, please know that we are working to ensure classes are well balanced. With that, schedules may not be completely finalized until Friday, August 9th.

Get Involved

Students – we pride ourselves in having a multitude of opportunities available to students outside of the classroom, whether it's in athletics, performing arts programs, or clubs. I highly recommend that you check out our school's website for information on these options on campus and have your student explore their interest at the start of the school year. A few weeks into the school year, we'll have a club gallery walk day to learn more about those options.

School Safety Updates and Lunches

As many are aware, new state law, HB1473, went into effect at the beginning of July surrounding school safety measures. With that, interior building doors will be locked throughout both the school day and during any extracurricular events. With that, we have made some adjustments with the flow of the school day, including passing time and when students need to be out of the classroom on a hall pass. As always, it is imperative and expected that students never prop open an exterior gates or doors for another student during the school day. Any student arriving after the start of the day must check in through the front office.

In the mornings, students will either enter campus through A) the north gates by the parent car circle/student parking lot or B) the southeast gate near the auditorium connected to the bus loop. Students will no longer enter

through the gates by the front office this school year. We are also adding a 7:15am bell which is when students will be able to leave the cafeteria and main outdoor hallway to access lockers and begin heading to class.

Lastly, attached you will find the bell schedule for the 2024-25 school year. Based on these new laws, we will be shifting to two lunches this school year – students will have lunch either before or after 4th period, determined by which lunch their 4th period teacher is assigned. Students will receive that information on the first day of the school year. To ensure that this won't impact student participation in clubs and tutoring, we will still be offering the same tutoring opportunities for each of the core subject areas in the media center, along with offering several clubs during lunch, along with options after school as well.
