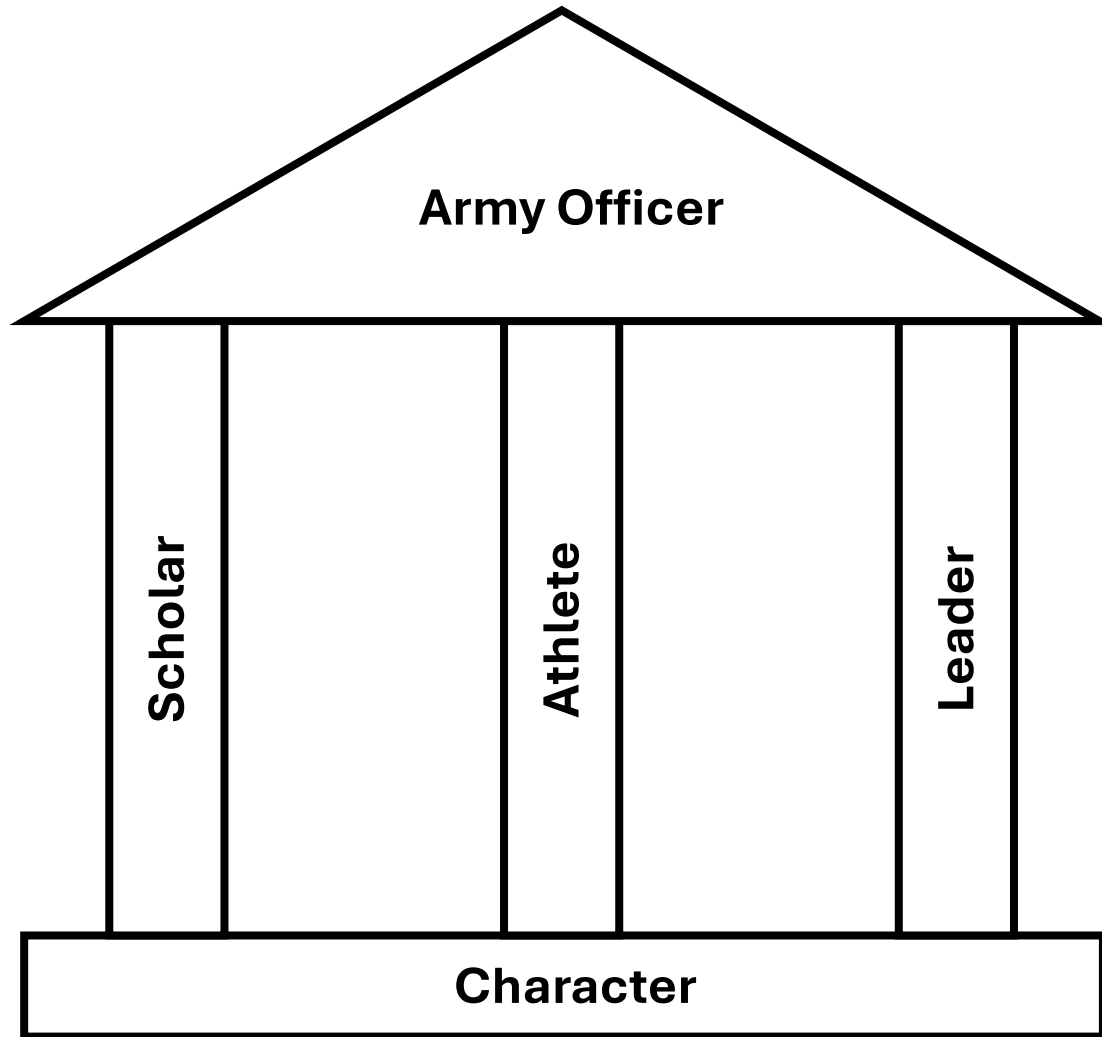

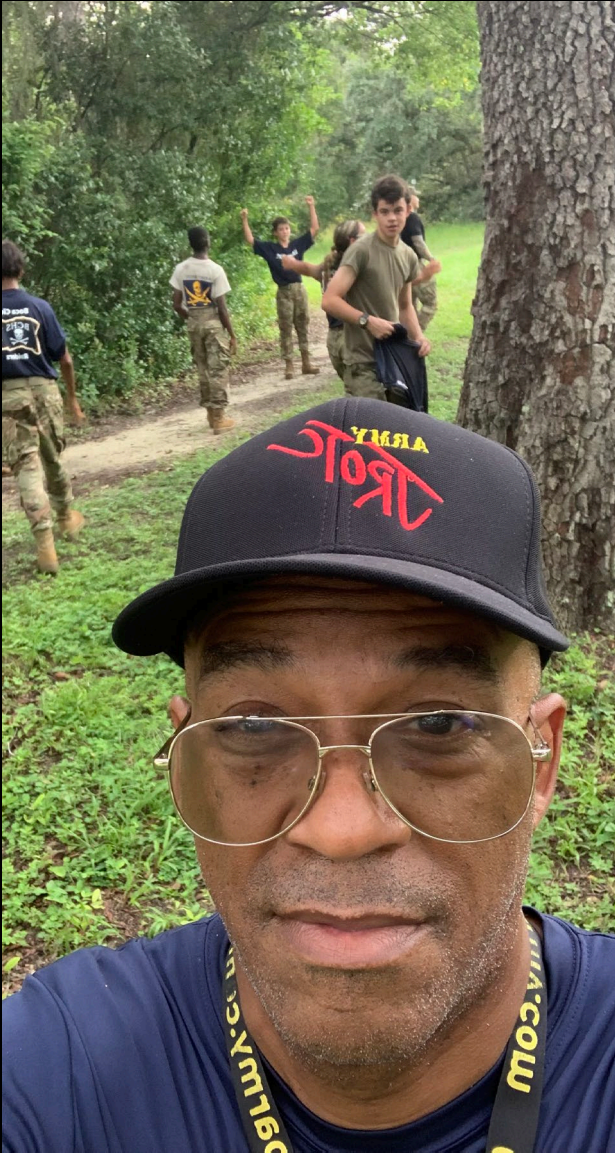

Good morning!

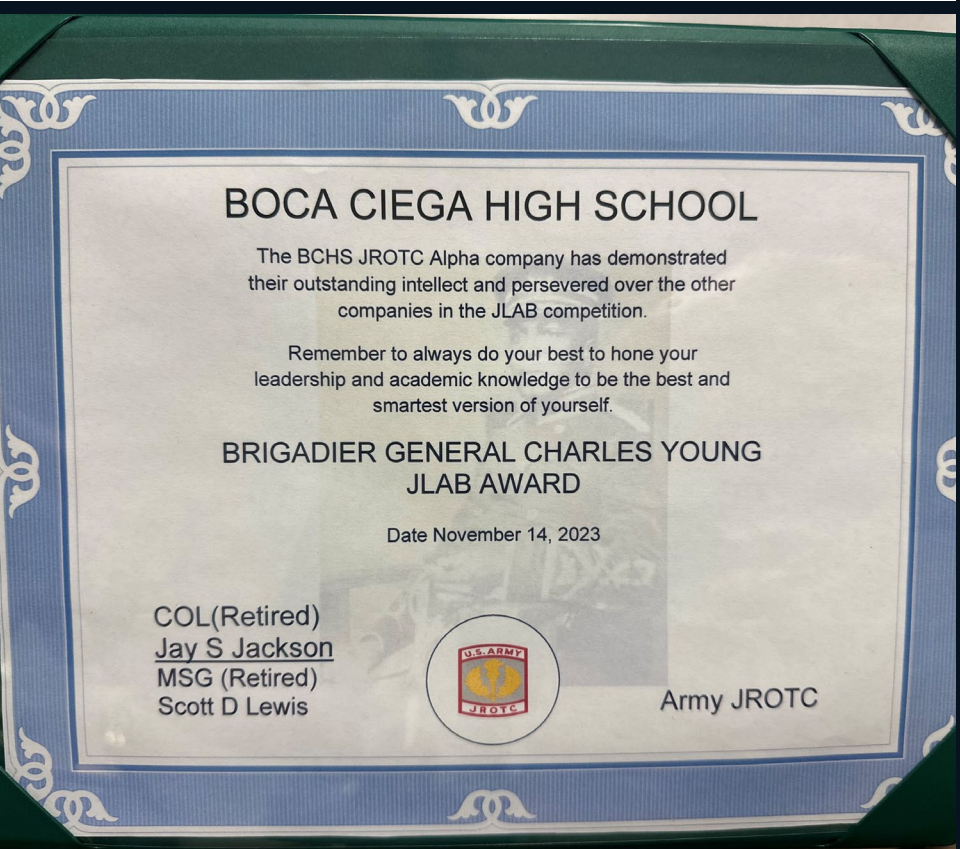

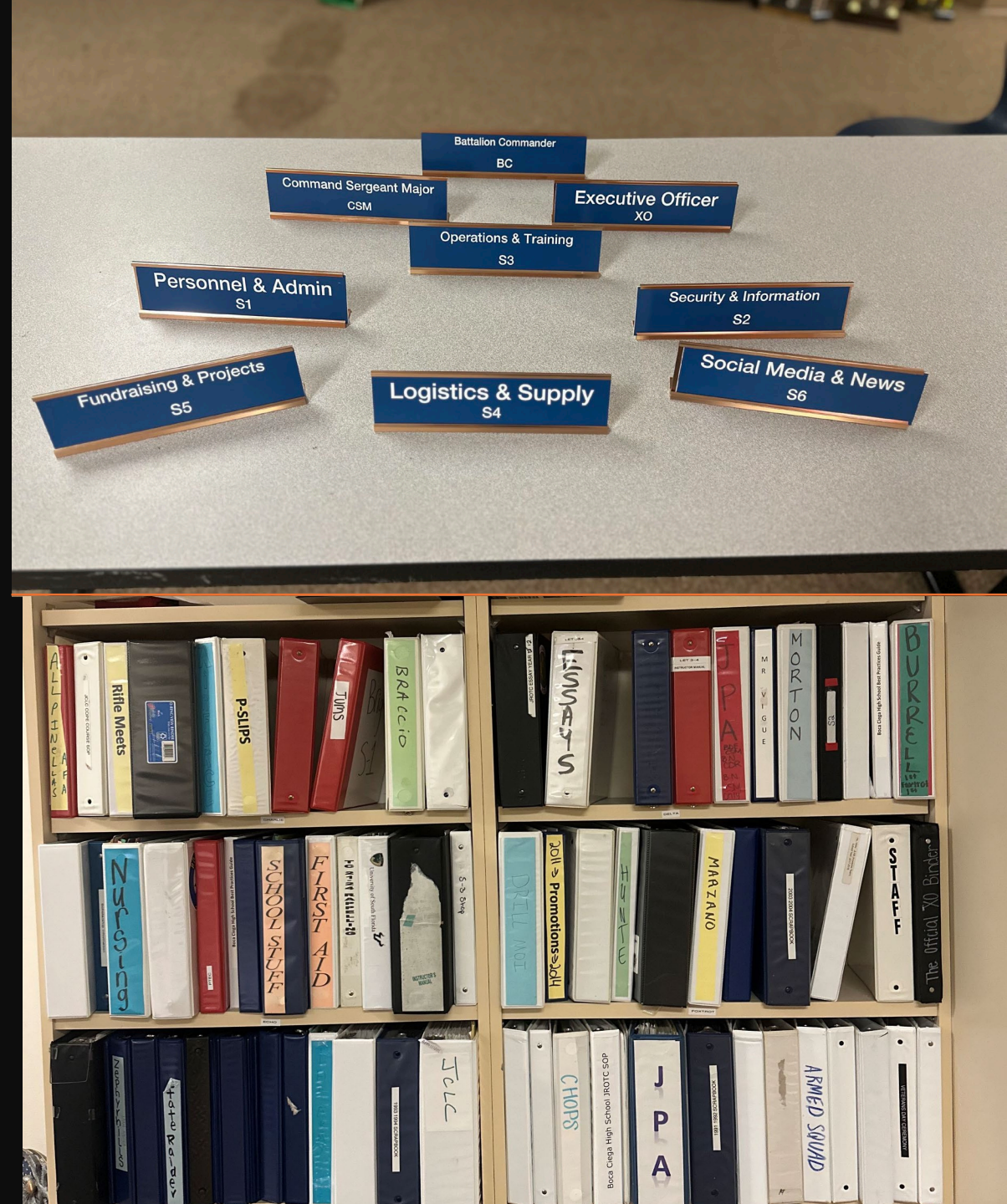
Raider Team

- -The uniform for the raiders team are OCP's

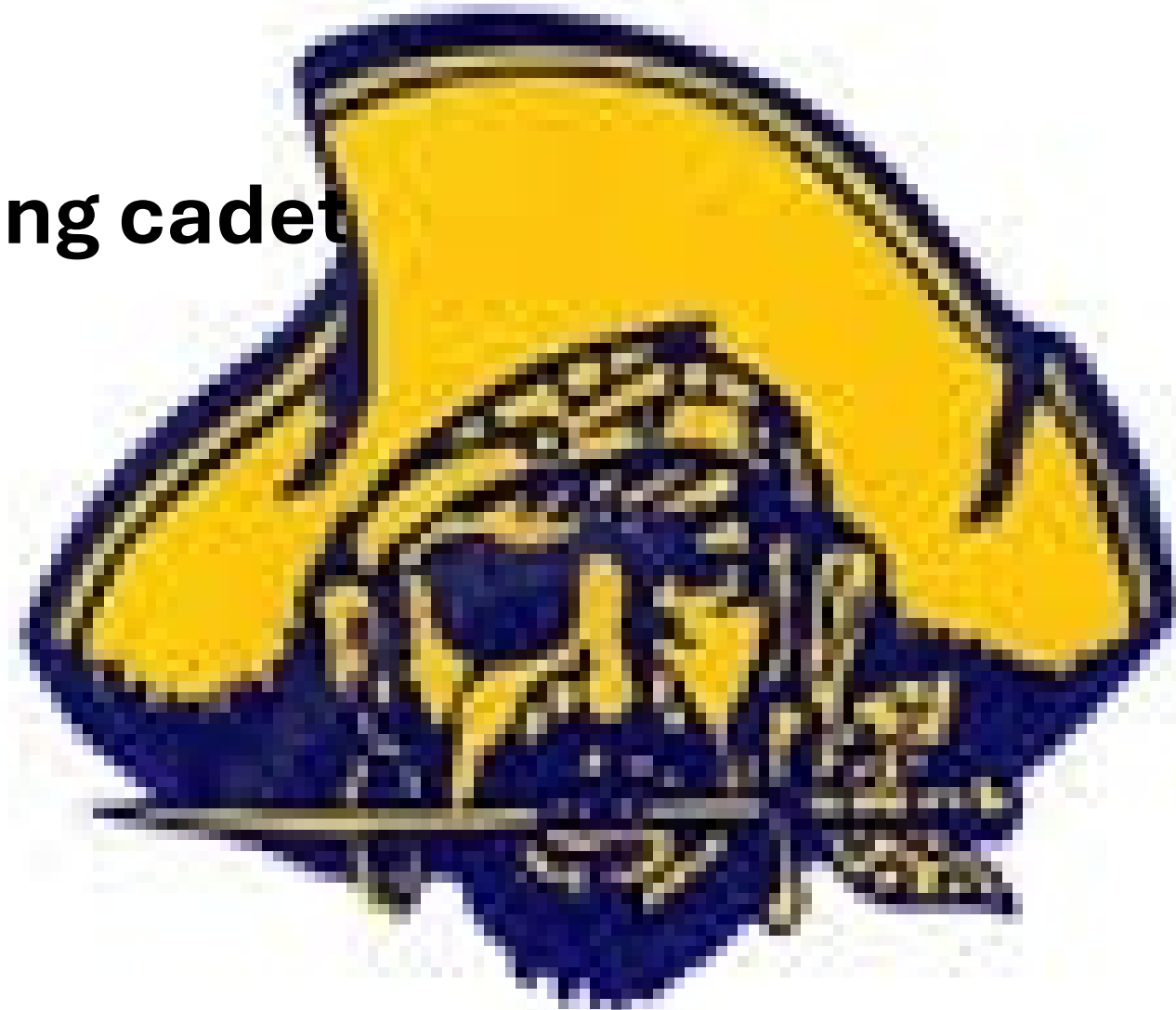
