



National Technical Honor Society Membership Criteria for Richard O. Jacobson Technical High School

Scholarship: To be eligible, a student must be currently enrolled at Richard O. Jacobson, an unweighted GPA of 3.0 and must have attended Richard O. Jacobson for at least one full semester.

Service: This quality is defined through the voluntary contributions made by a student to the school or community, done without compensation and with a positive, courteous, and enthusiastic spirit.

Leadership: Student leaders are those who are resourceful, good problem solvers, promoters of school activities, idea-contributors, dependable, and persons who exemplify positive attitude about life. Leadership experiences can be drawn from school or community activities while working with or for others.

Character: The student of good character upholds principles of morality and ethics, is cooperative, demonstrates high standards of honesty and reliability, shows courtesy, concern, and respect for others, takes criticism willingly, observes instructions and rules, has powers of concentration and self-discipline. Students must have a clear discipline record for one previous year.

1. Candidate must be a secondary or postsecondary student participating in a CTE pathway, program, major or coursework.
2. A Junior or Senior
3. A minimum overall 3.0 unweighted GPA
4. Clear discipline record - NO REFERRALS FOR ANY REASON FOR PREVIOUS YEAR.
5. NTHS membership dues are a one-time \$30 per student fee
