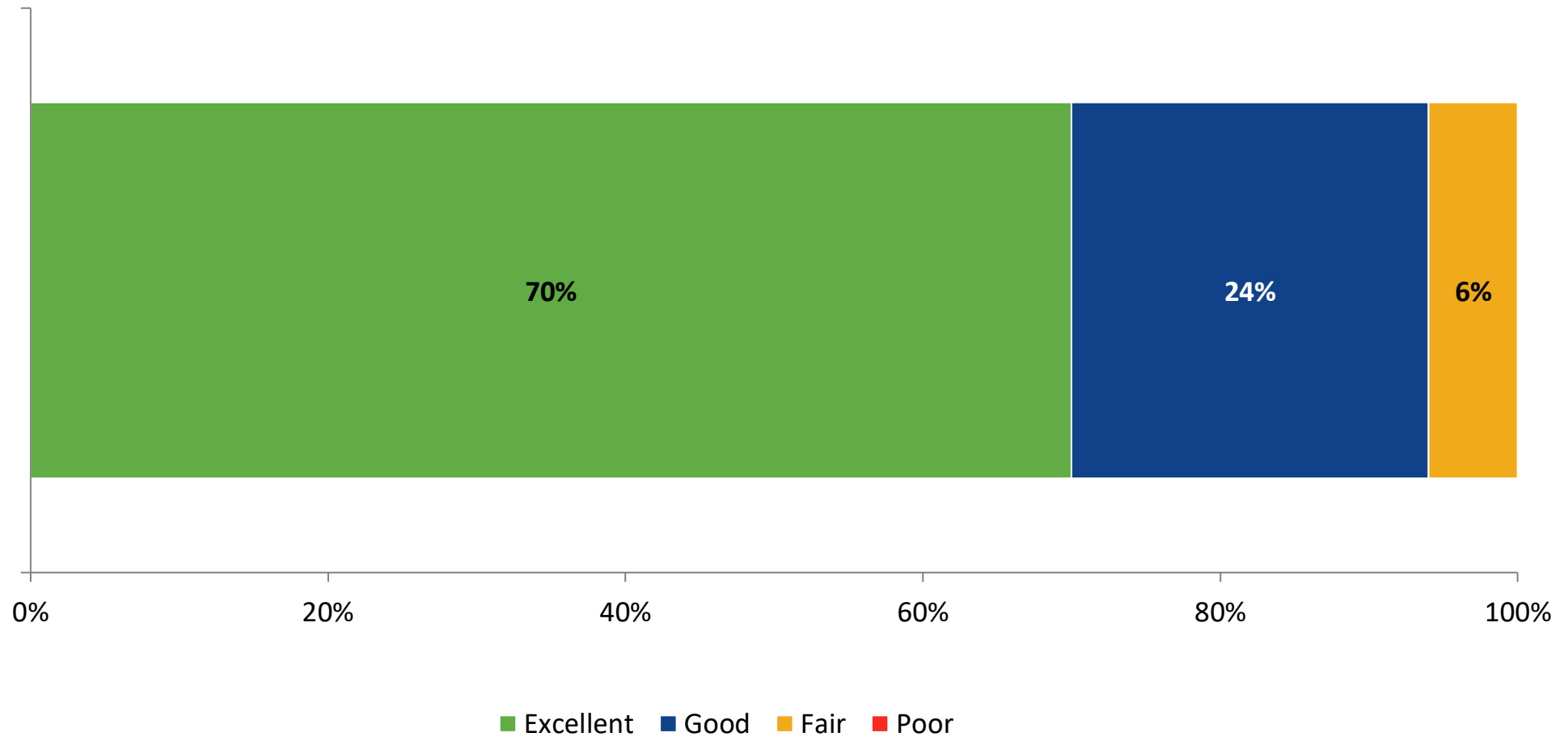

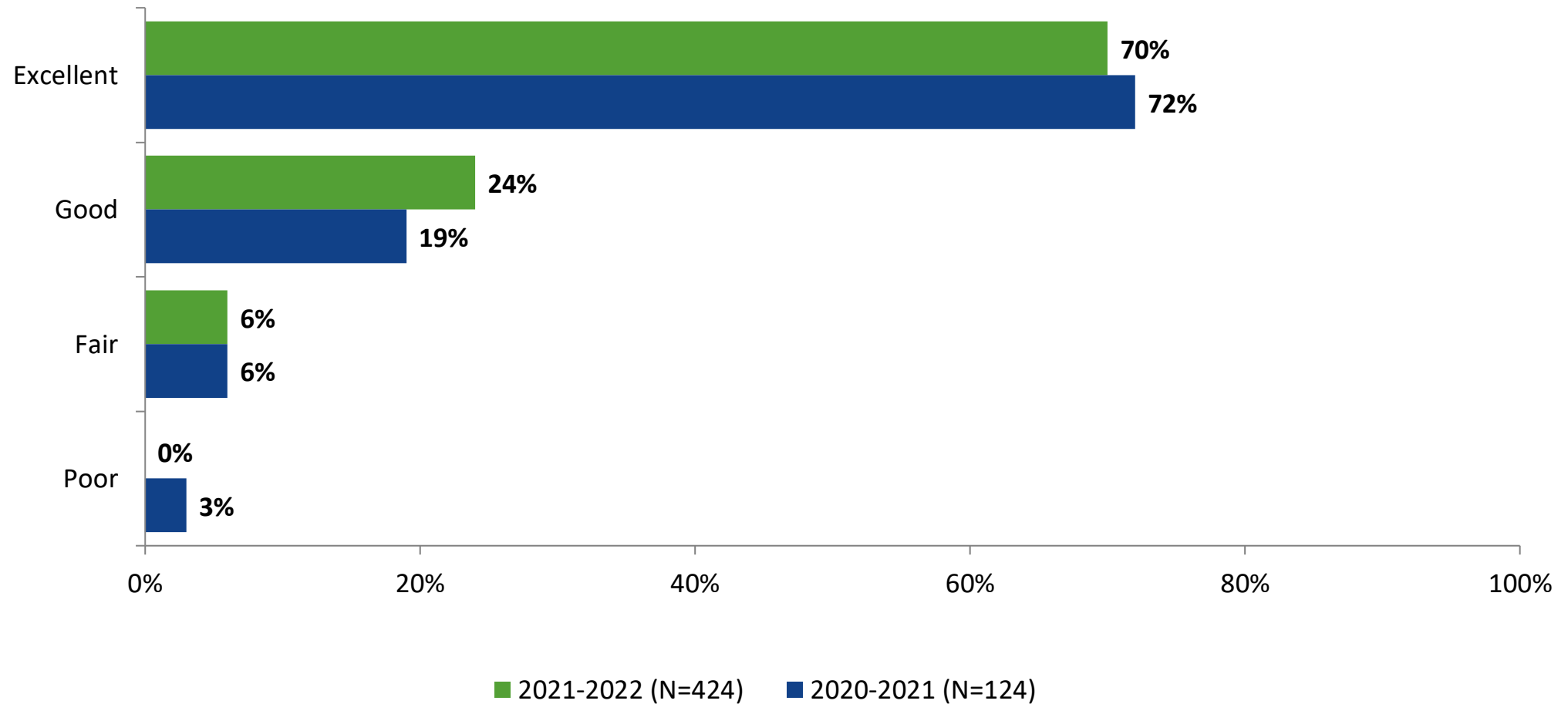
# Overall Quality

How would you rate the overall quality of your child's school? (N=424)



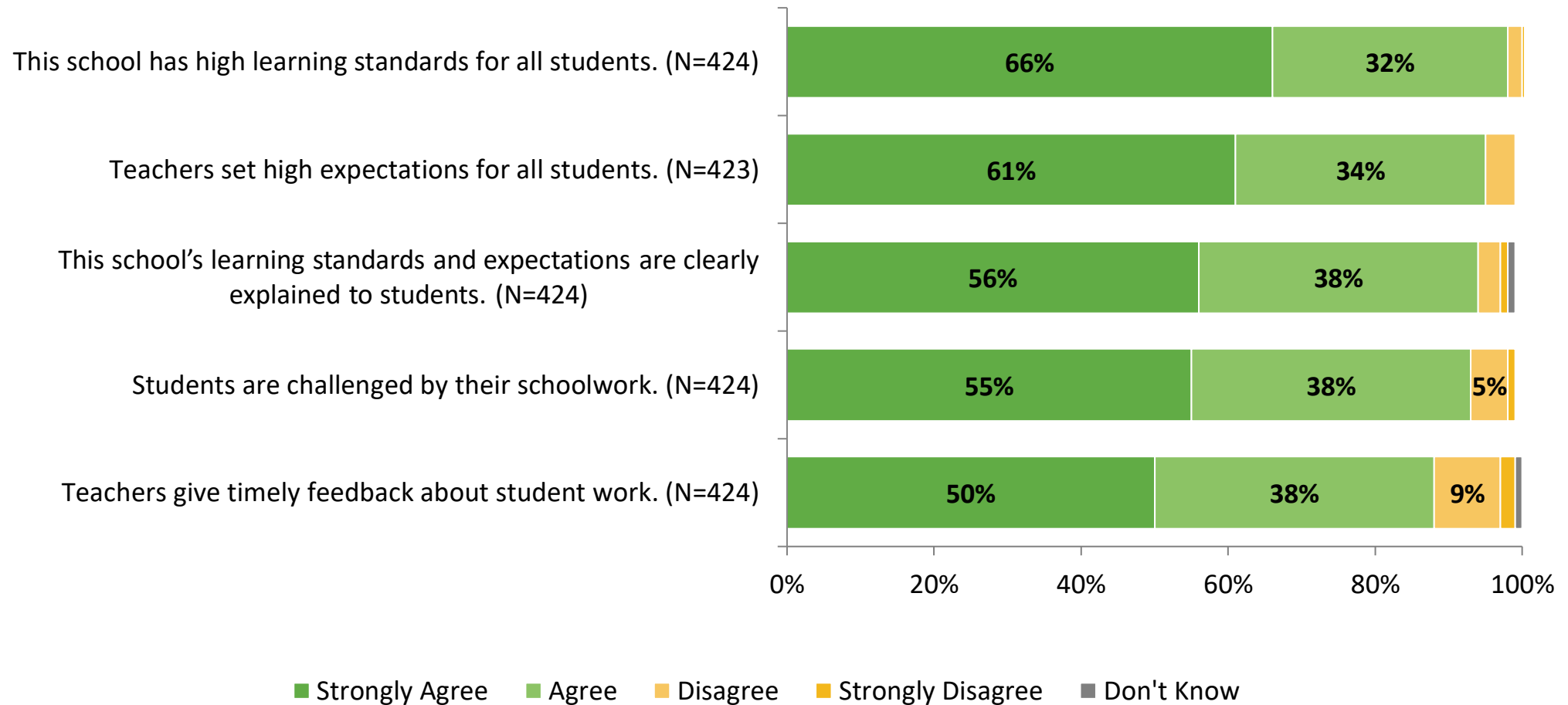
# Overall Quality: Comparison Over Time

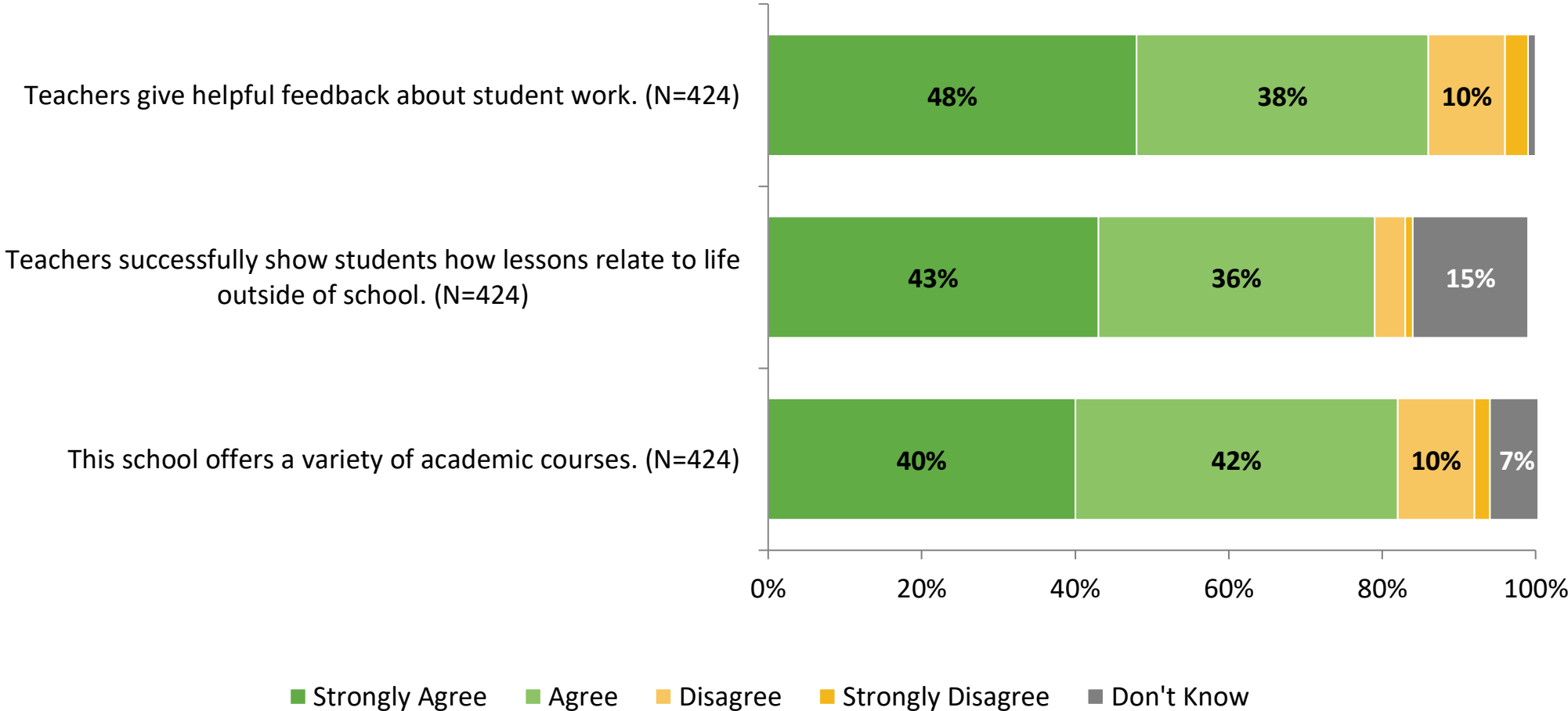

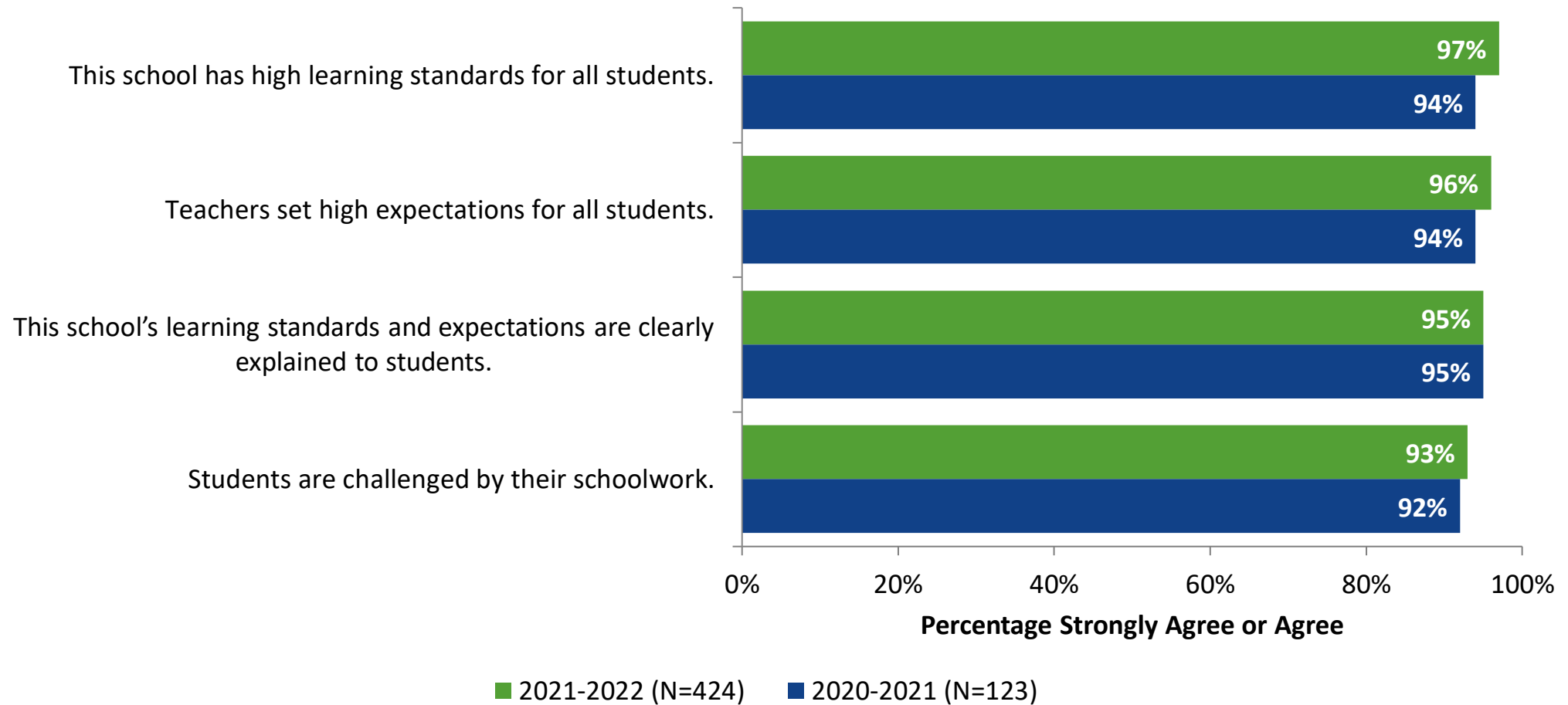

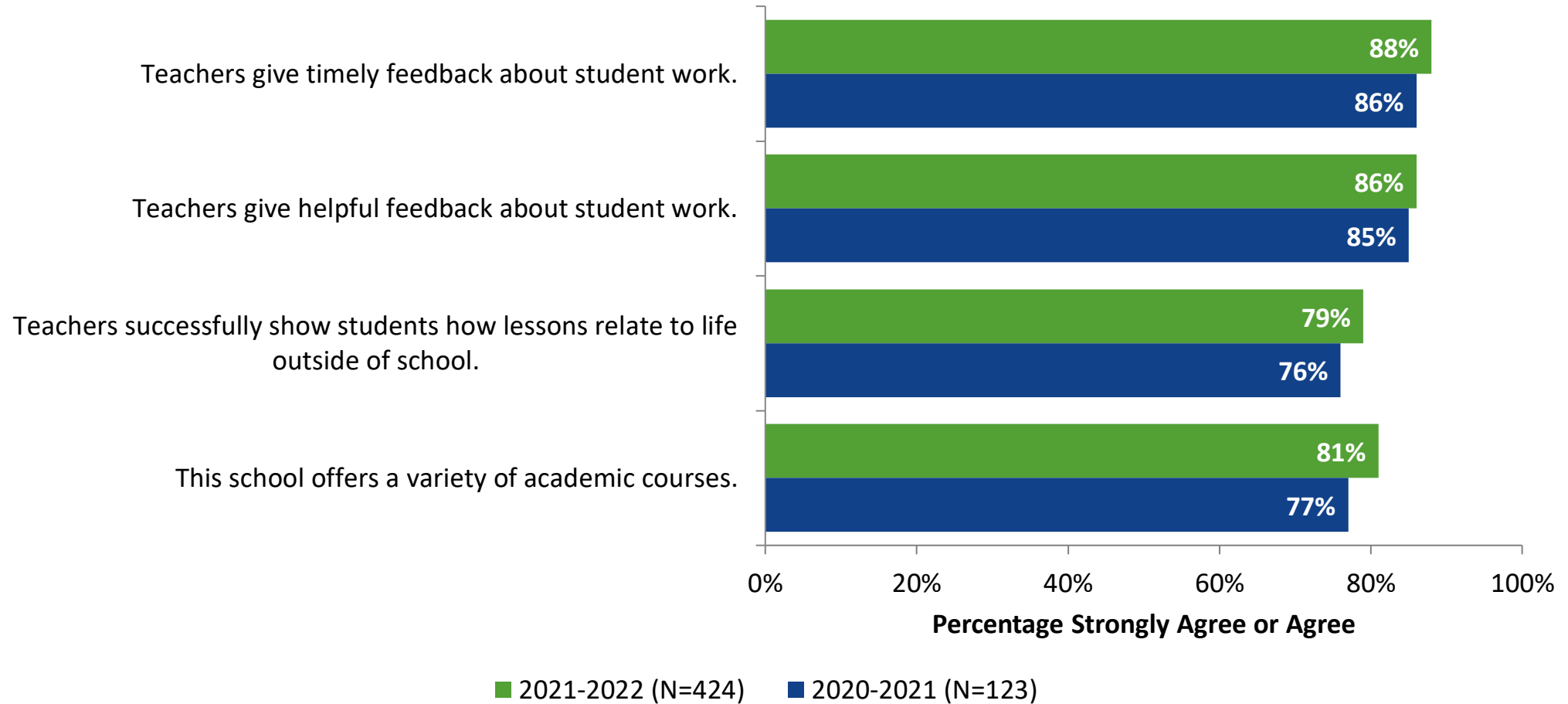

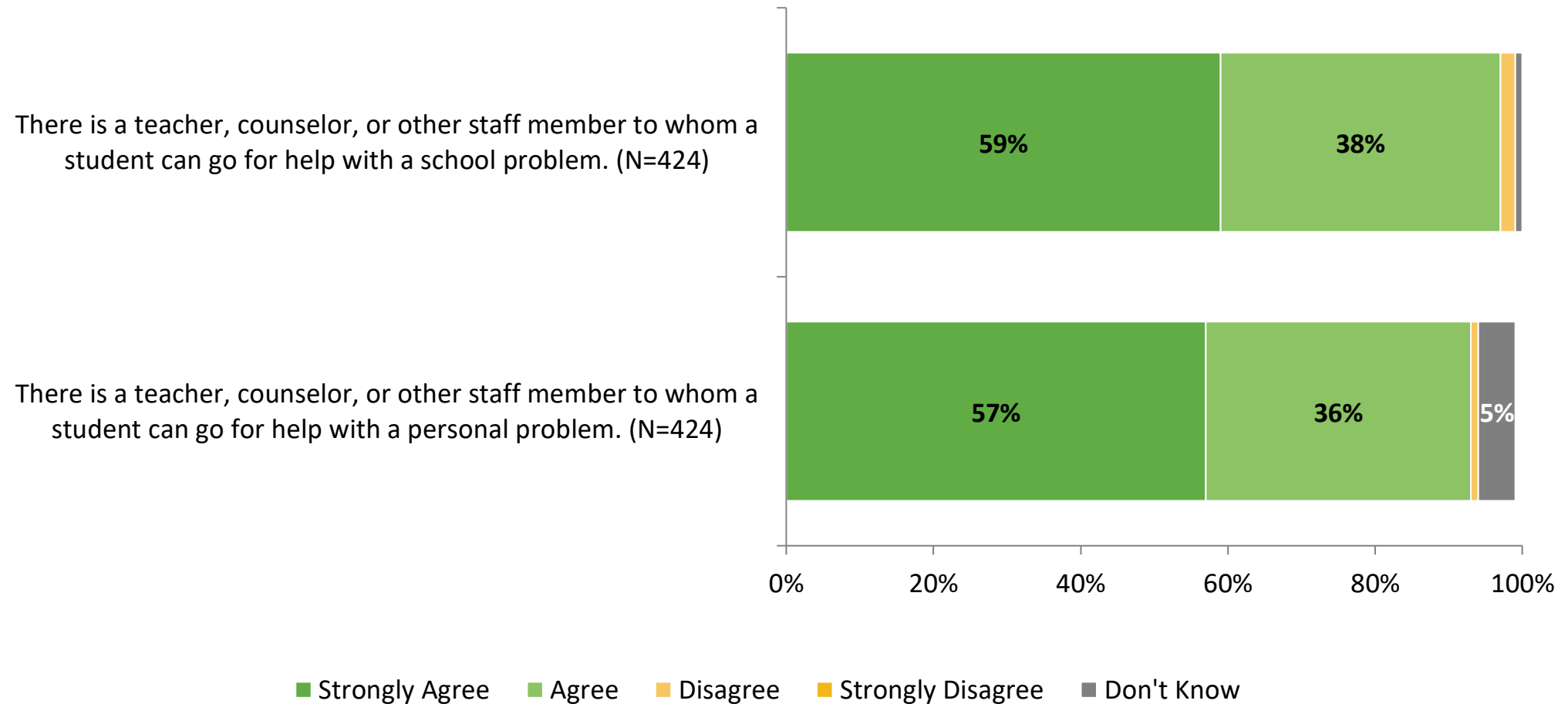

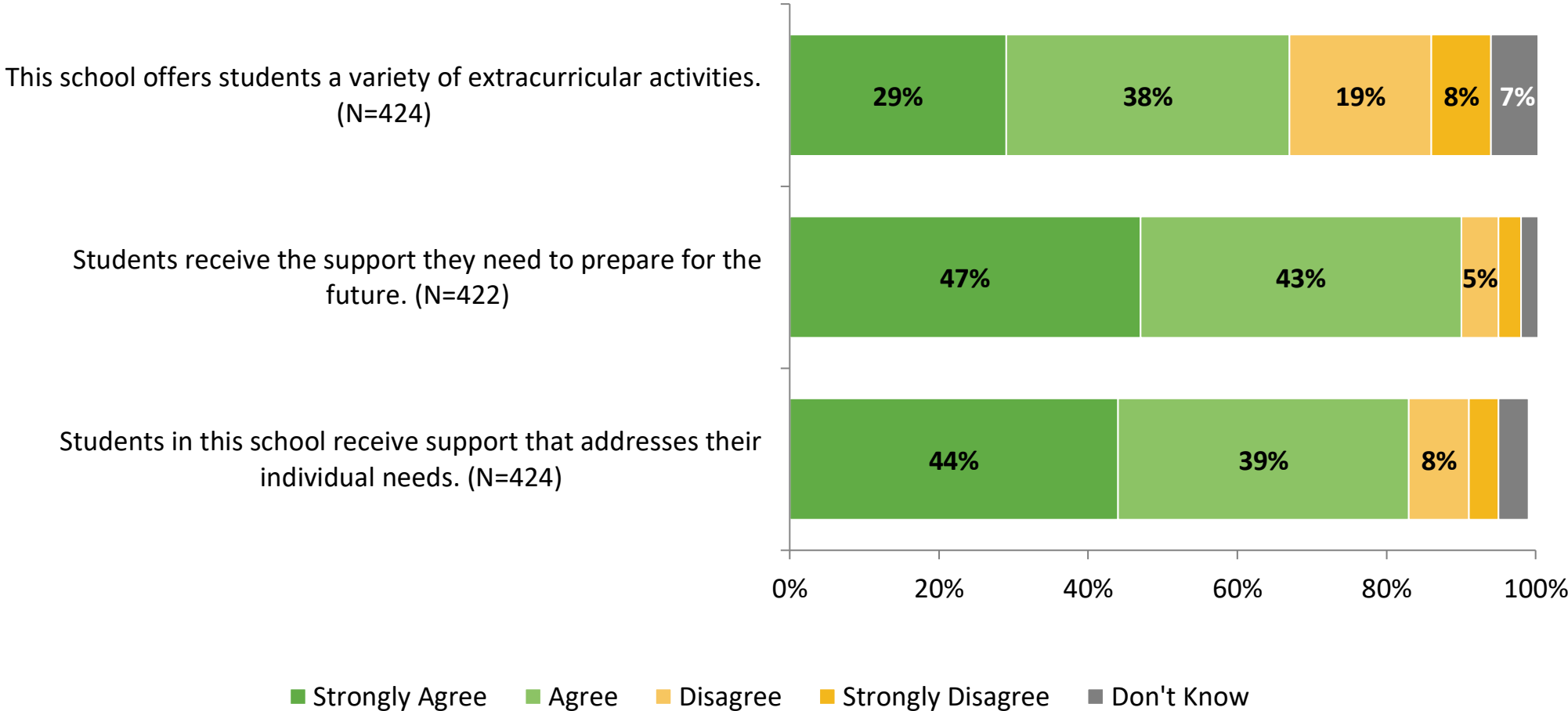

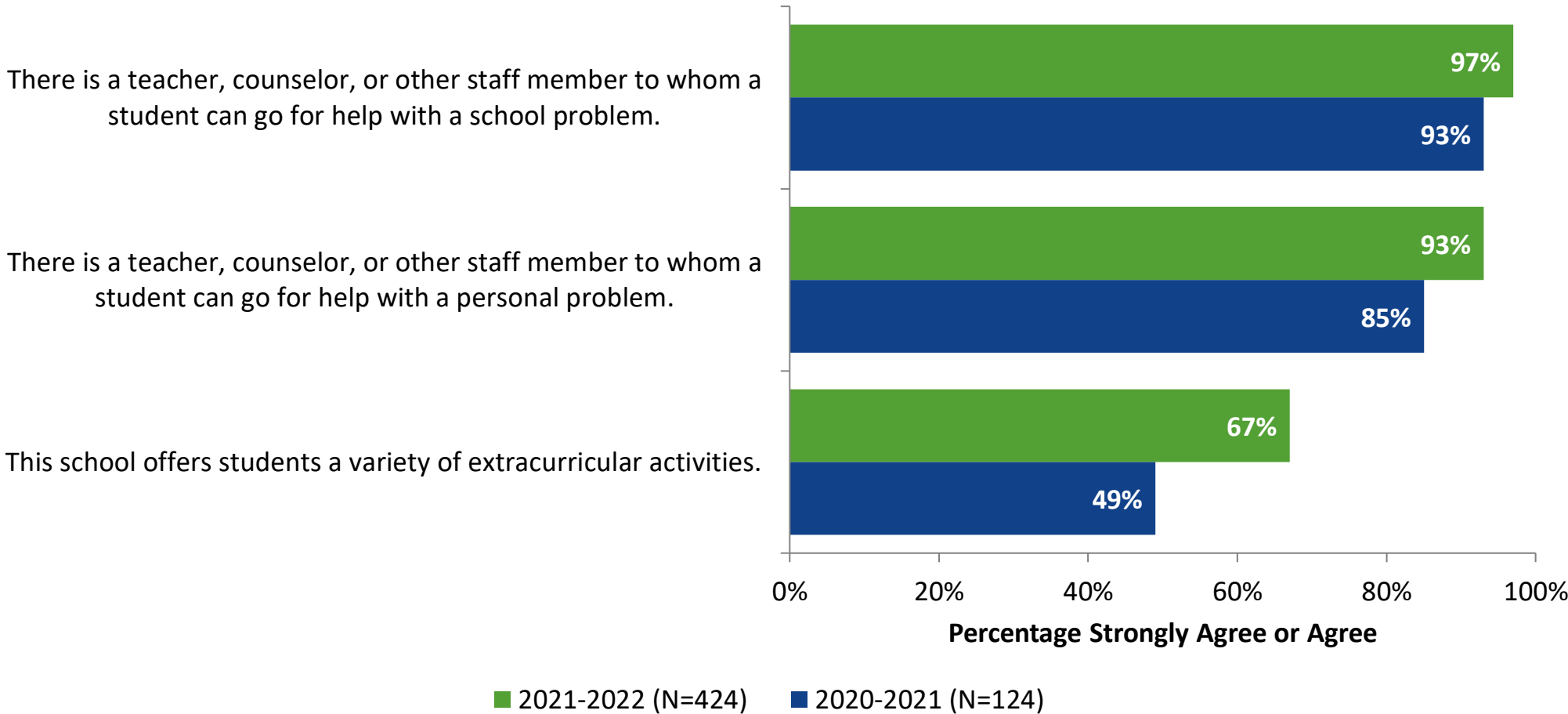

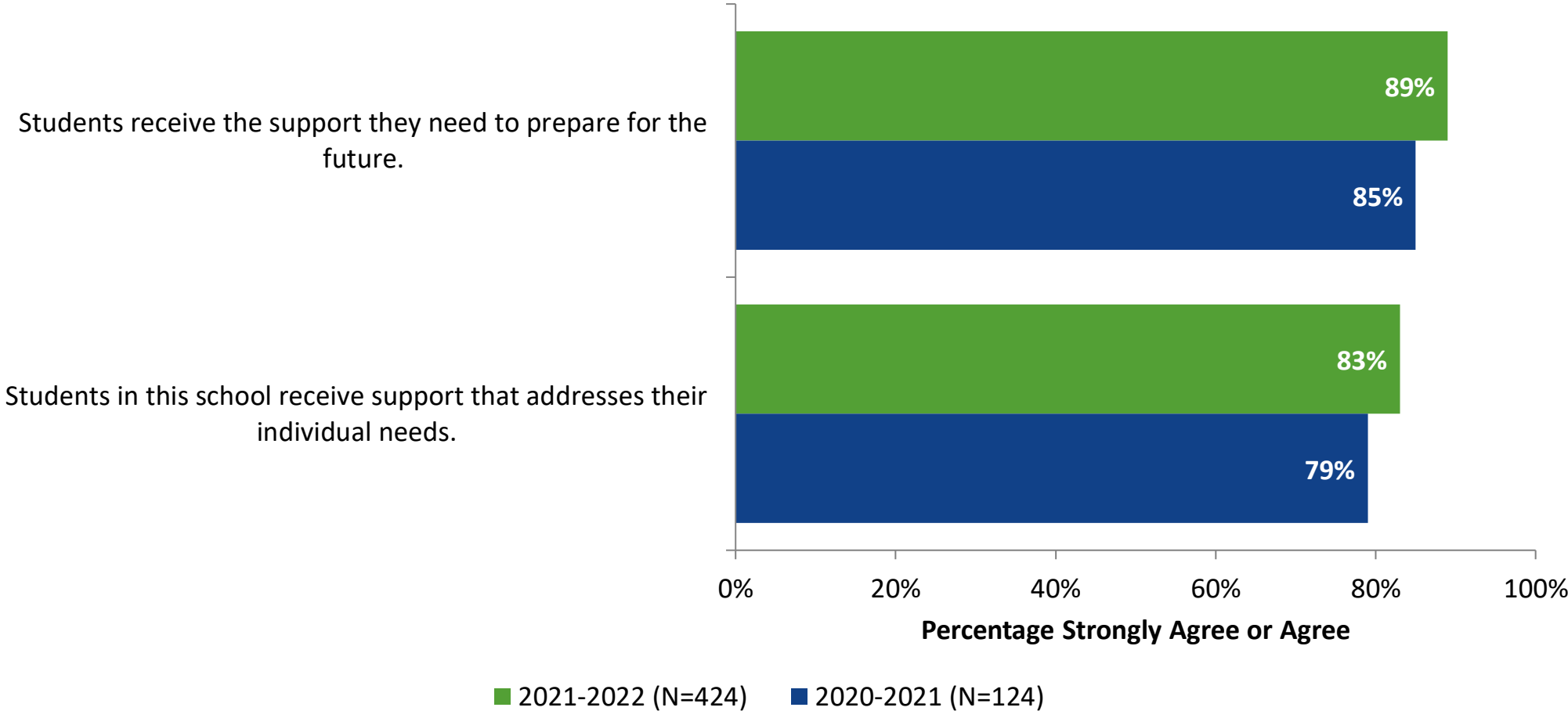

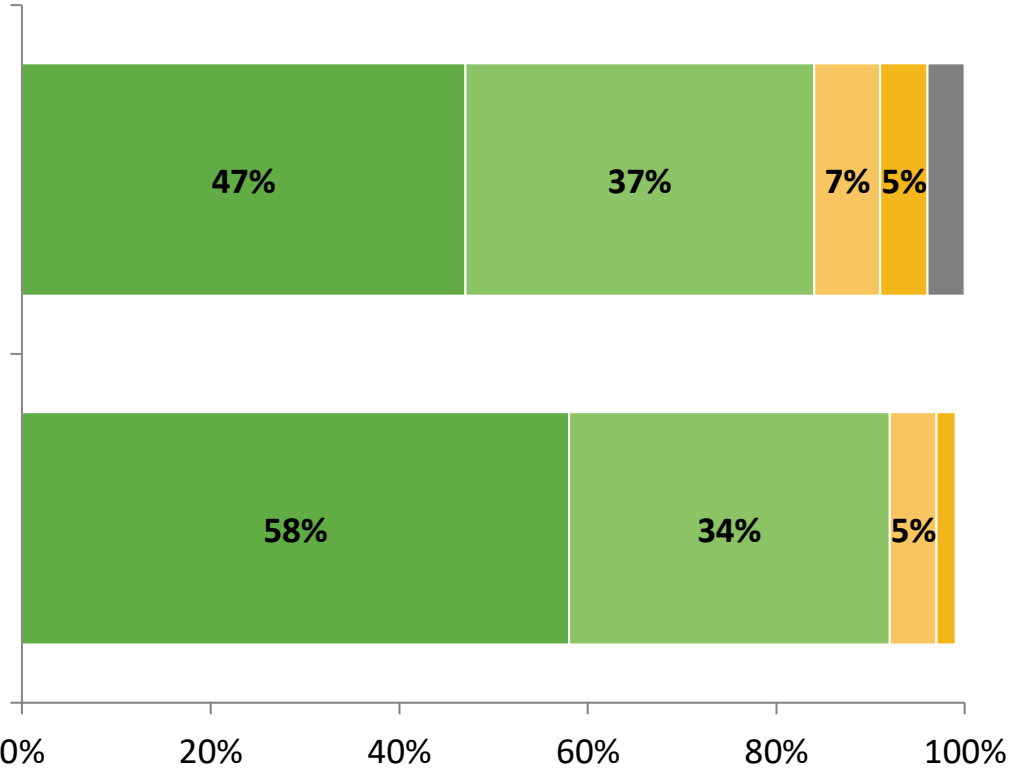

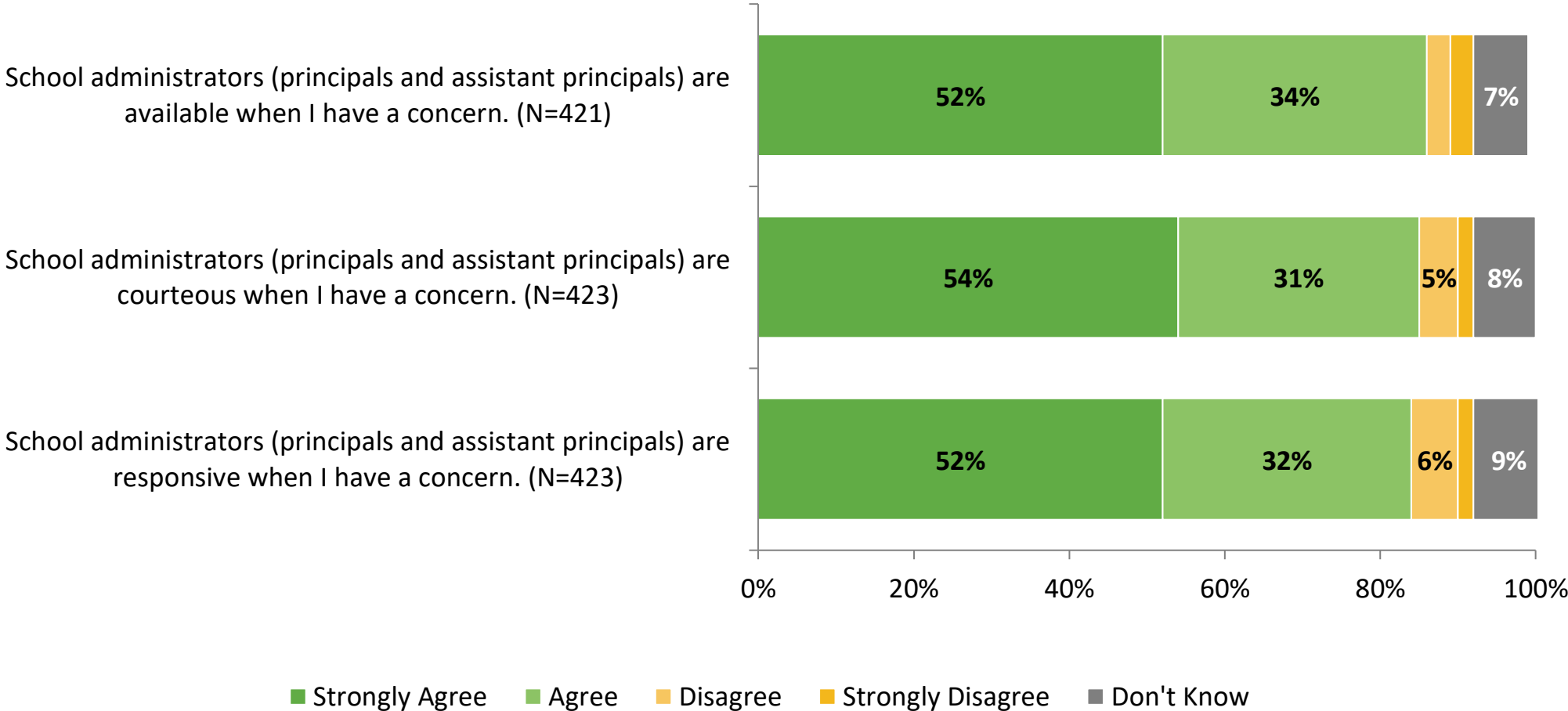
School administrators (principals and assistant principals) make decisions that are in the best interests of students. (N=422)

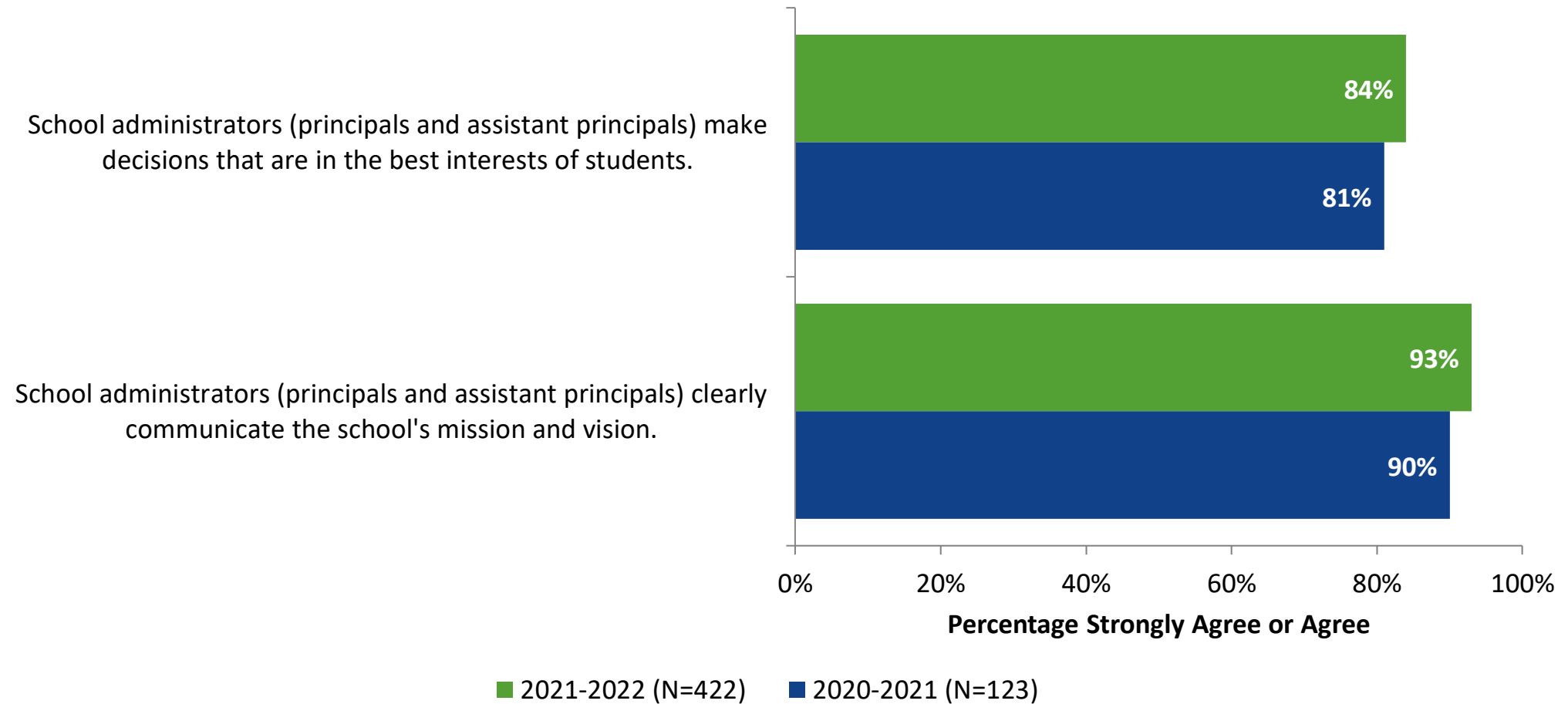

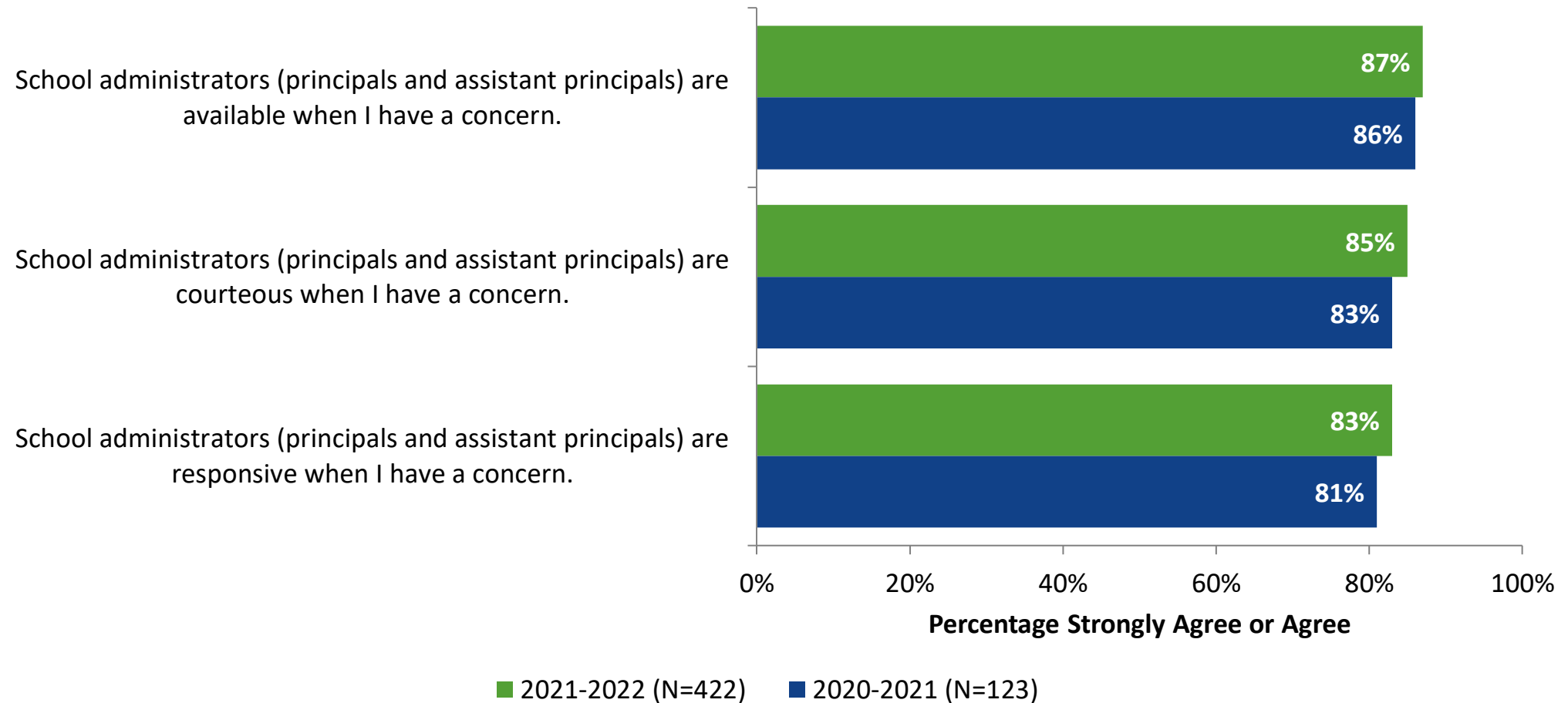

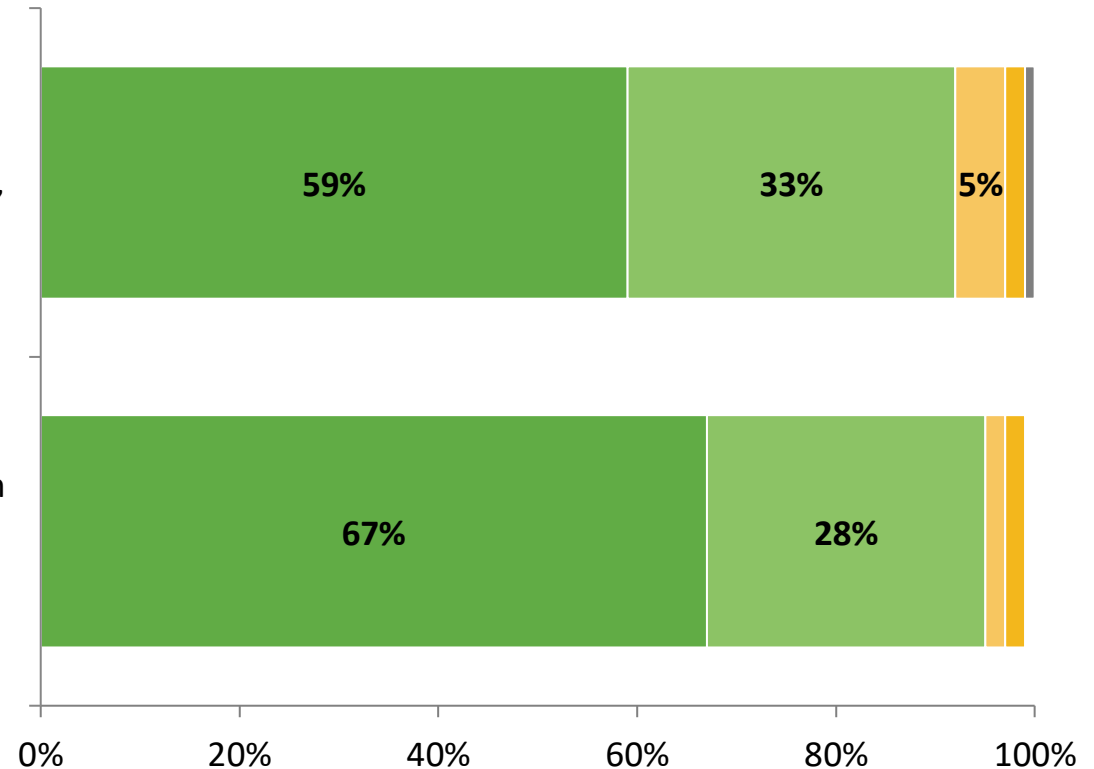

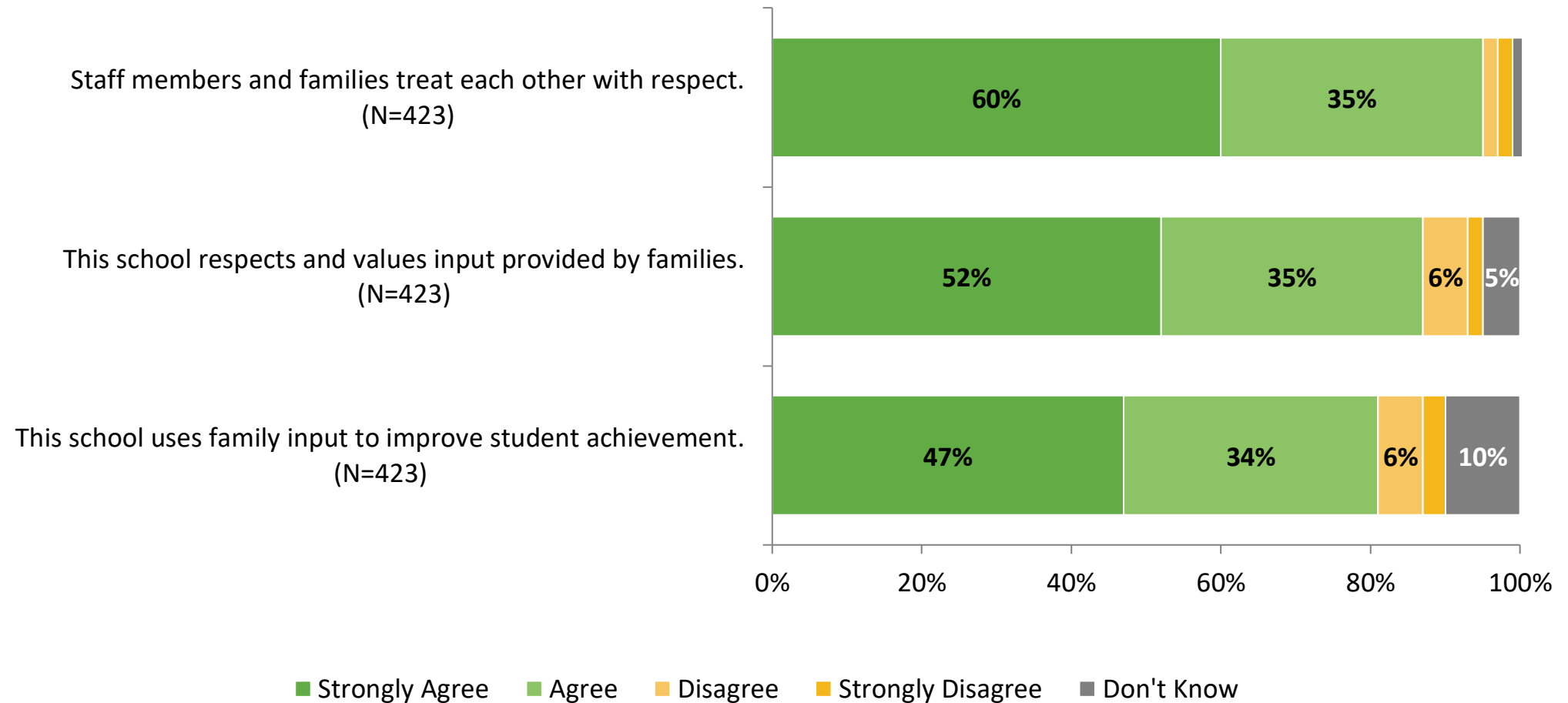

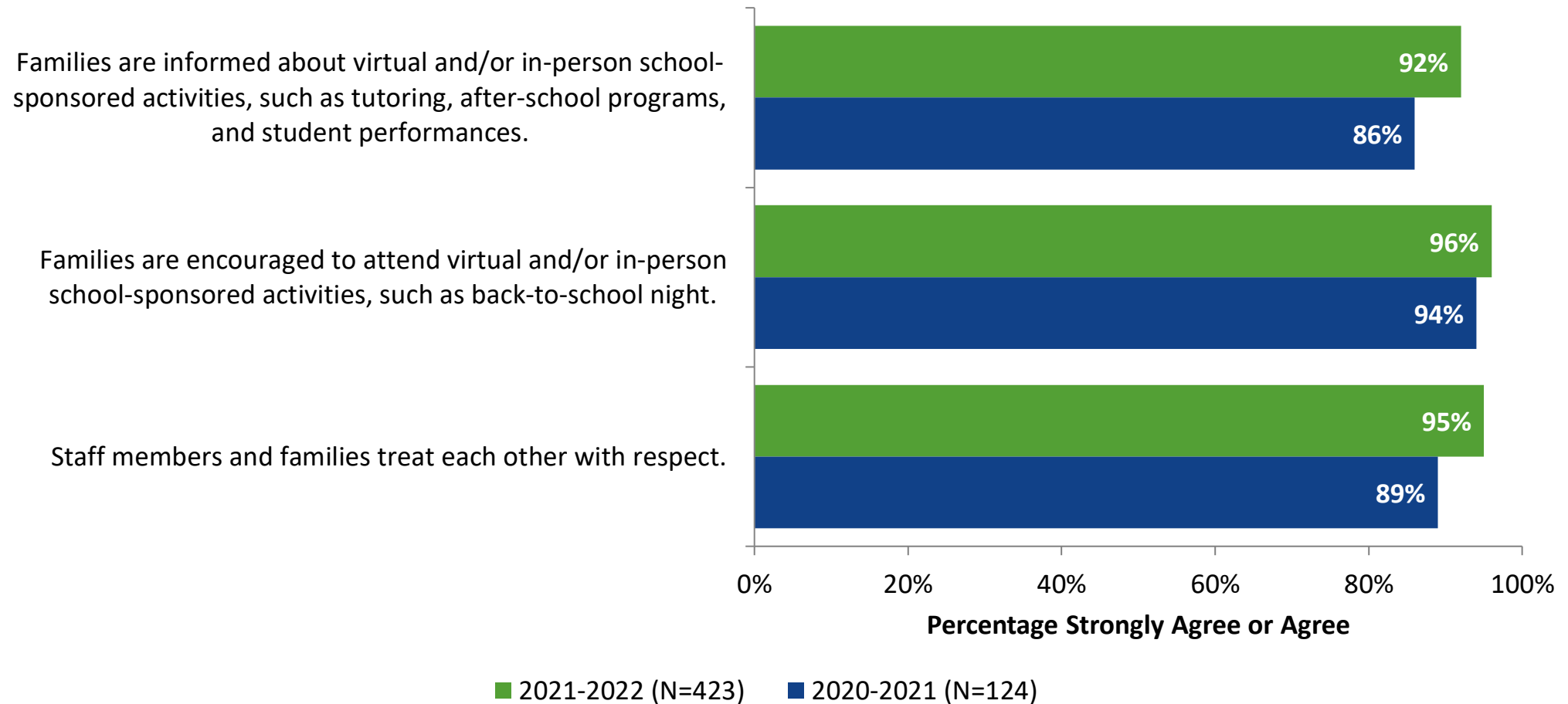

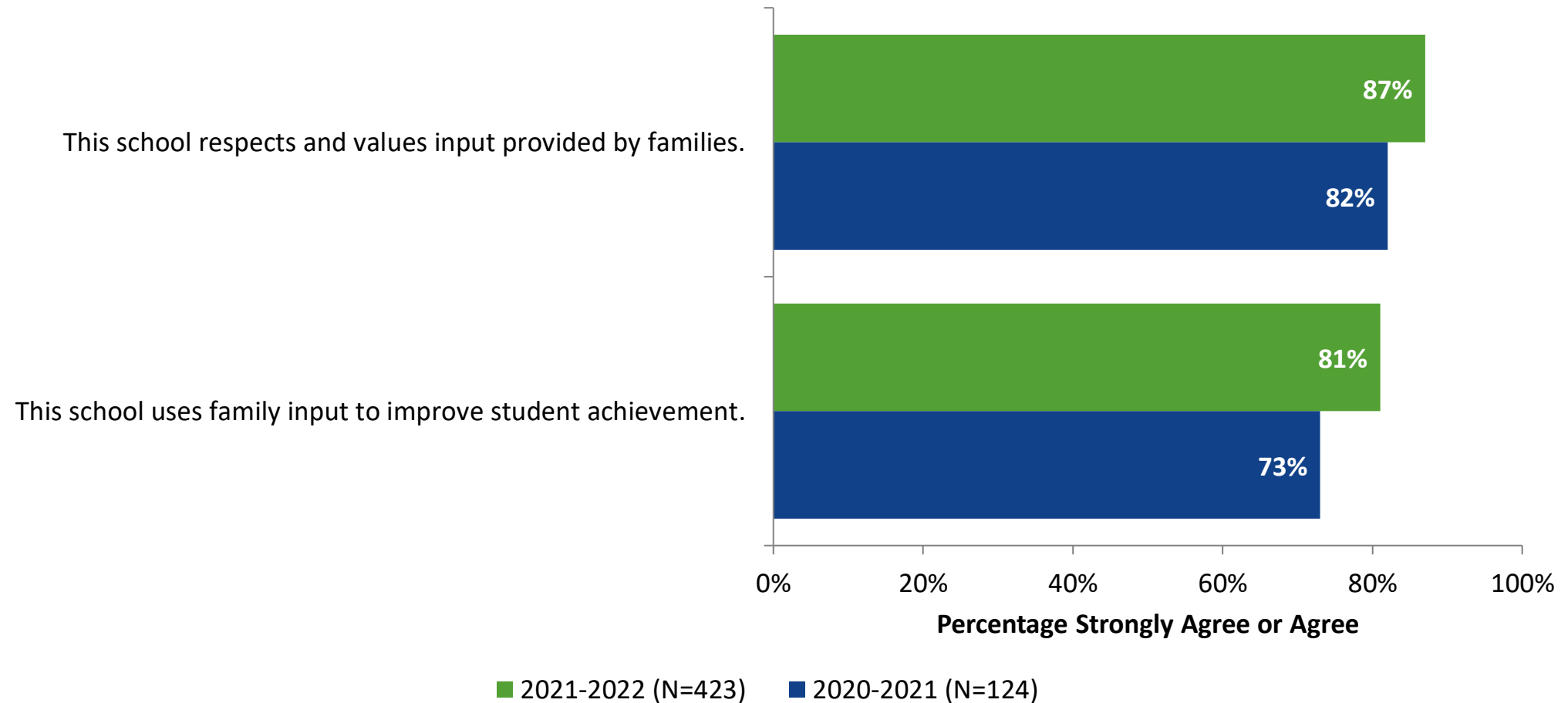

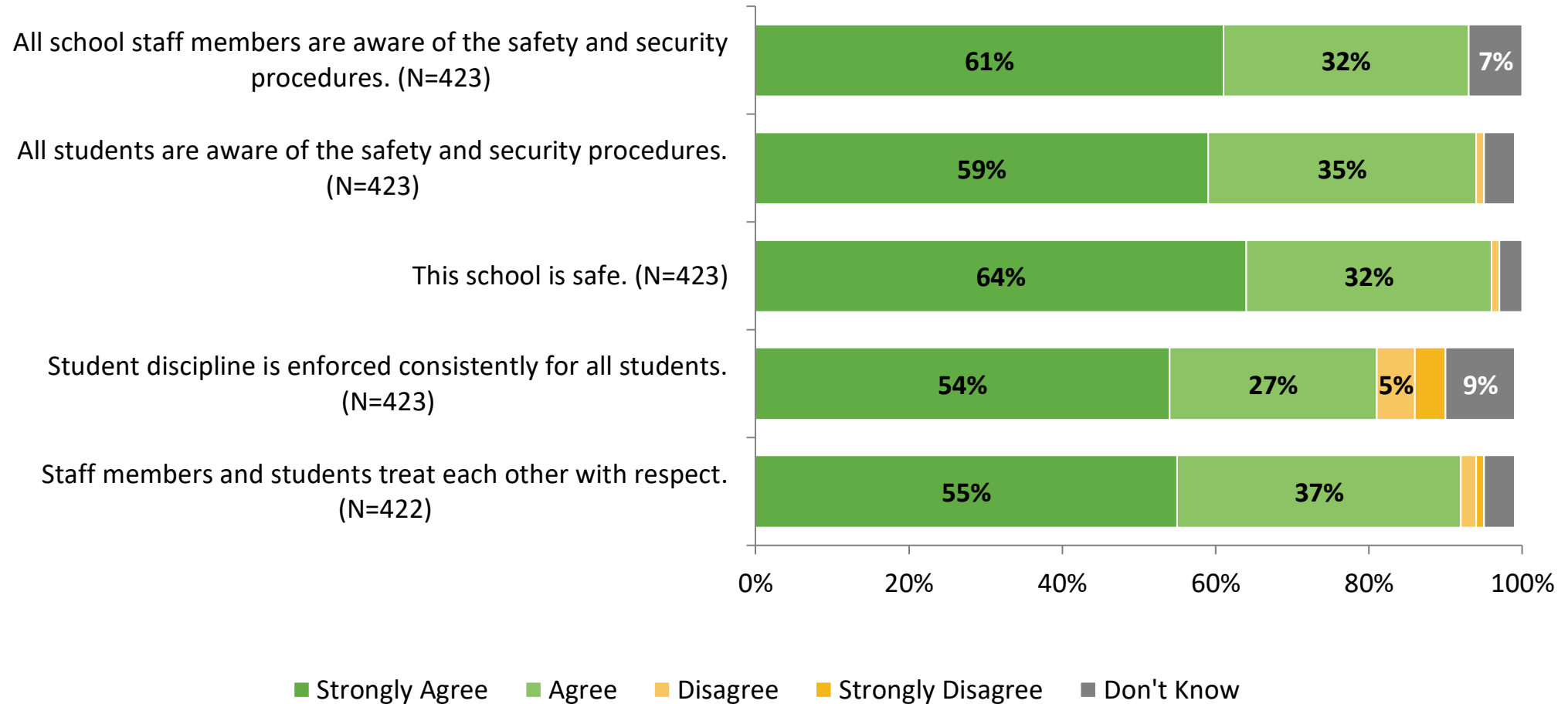

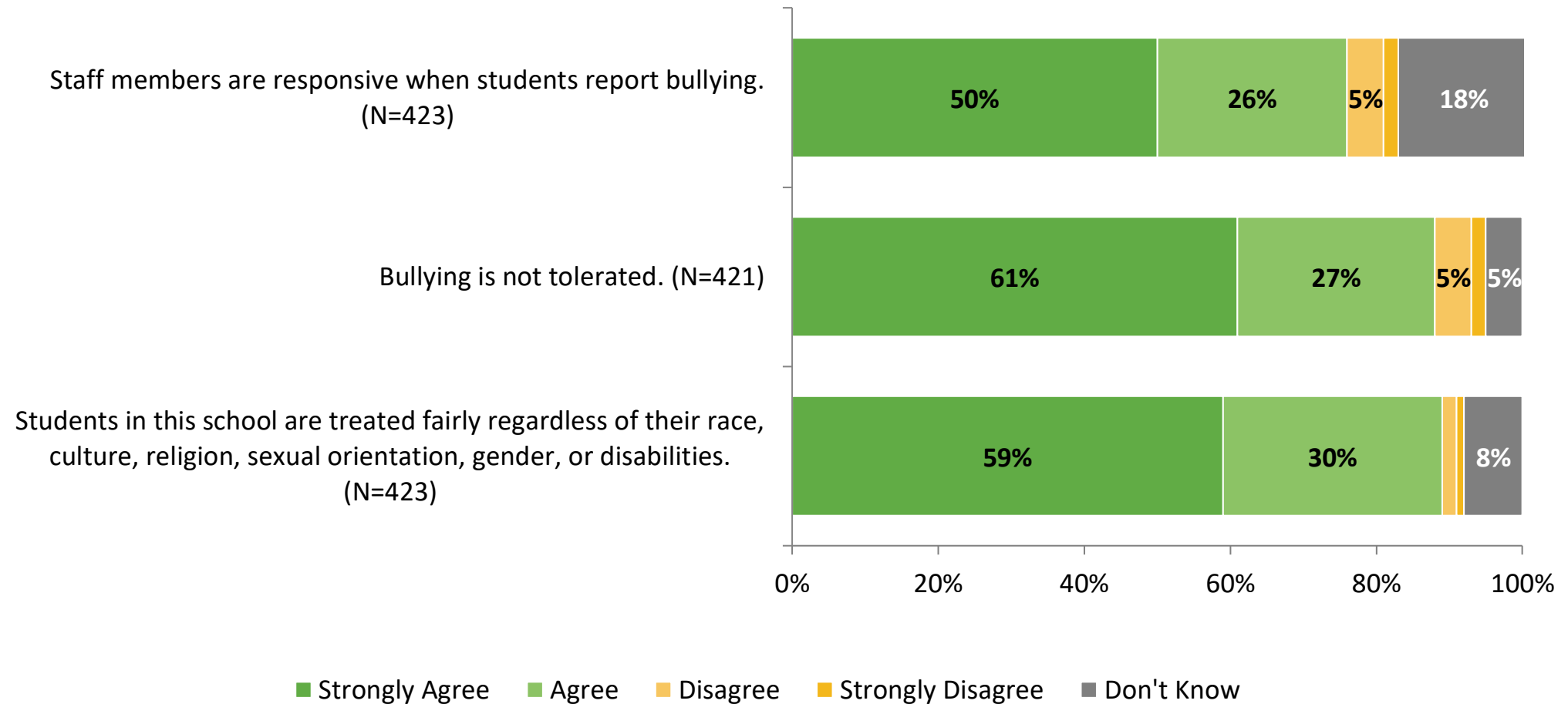

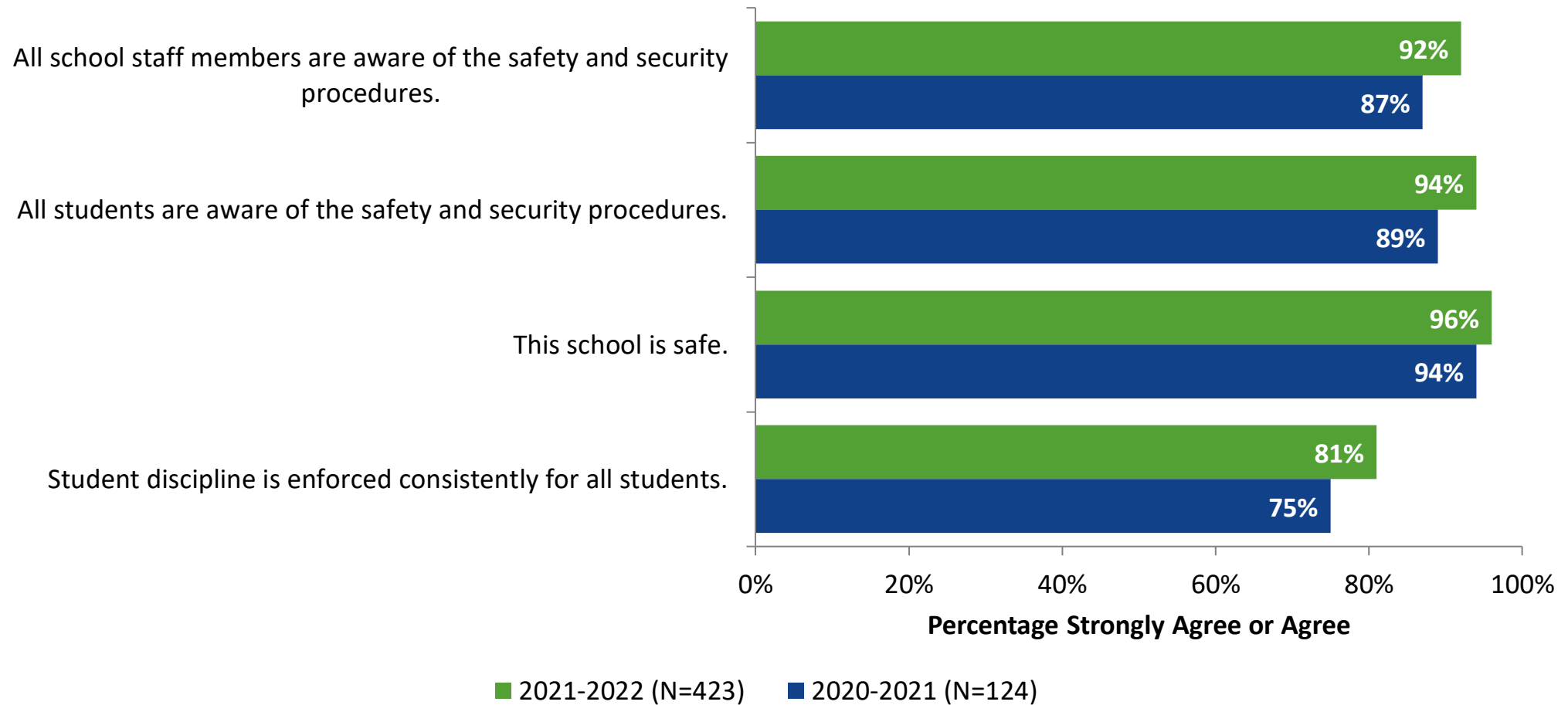

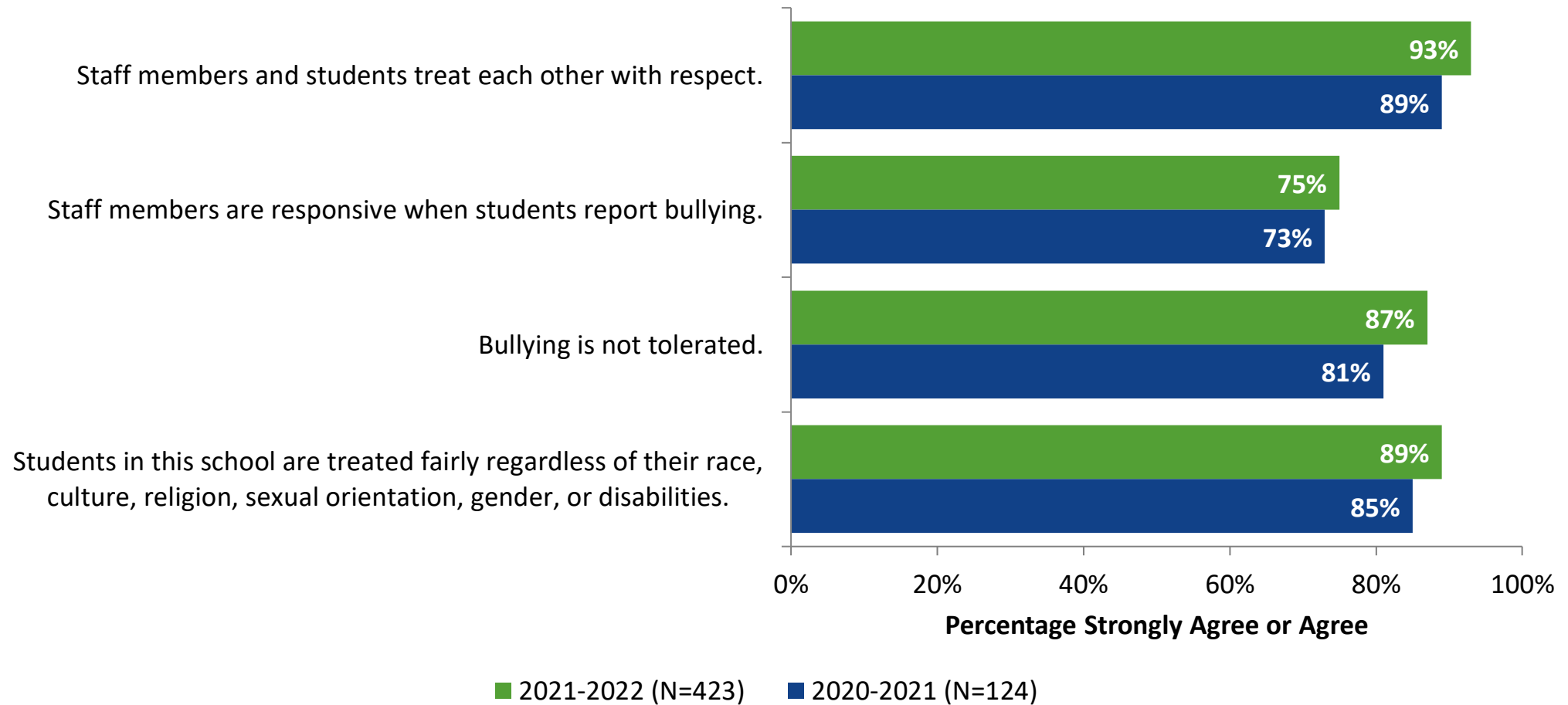

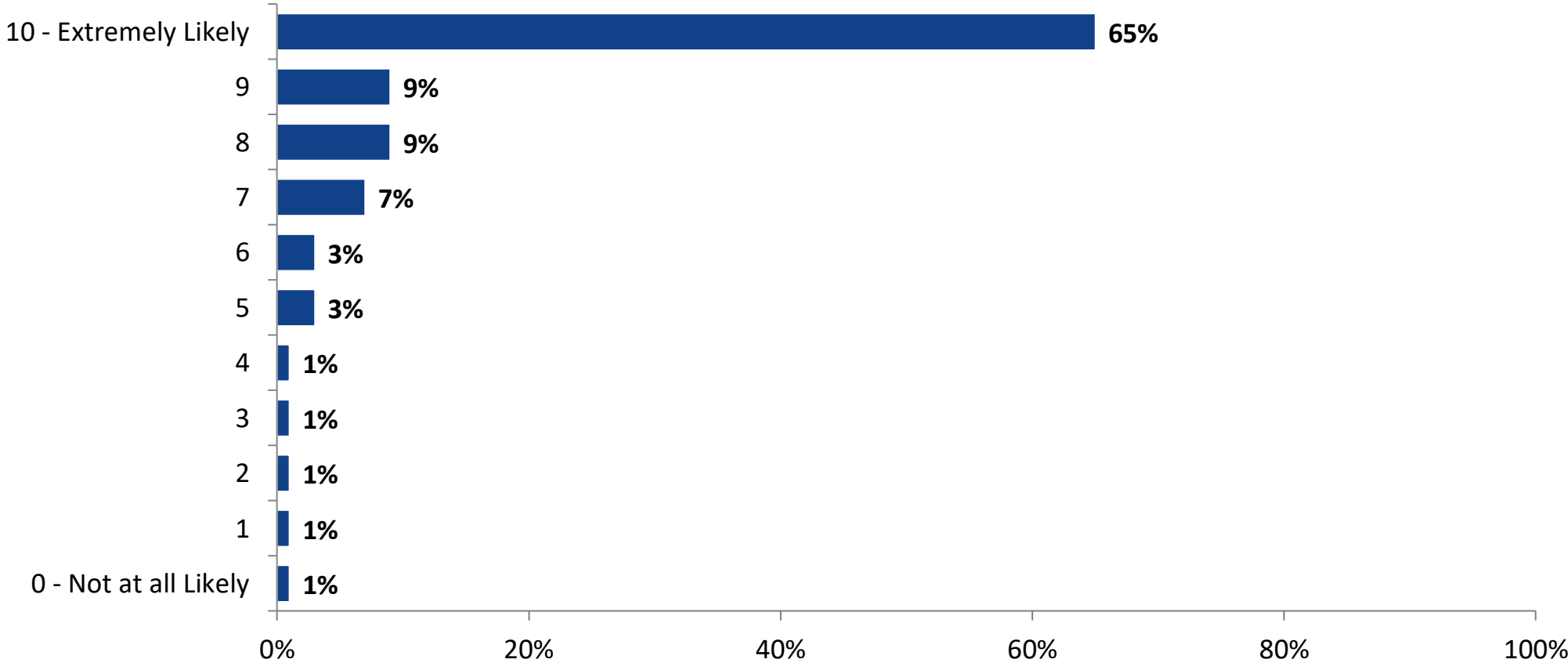

# Net Promoter Score - School

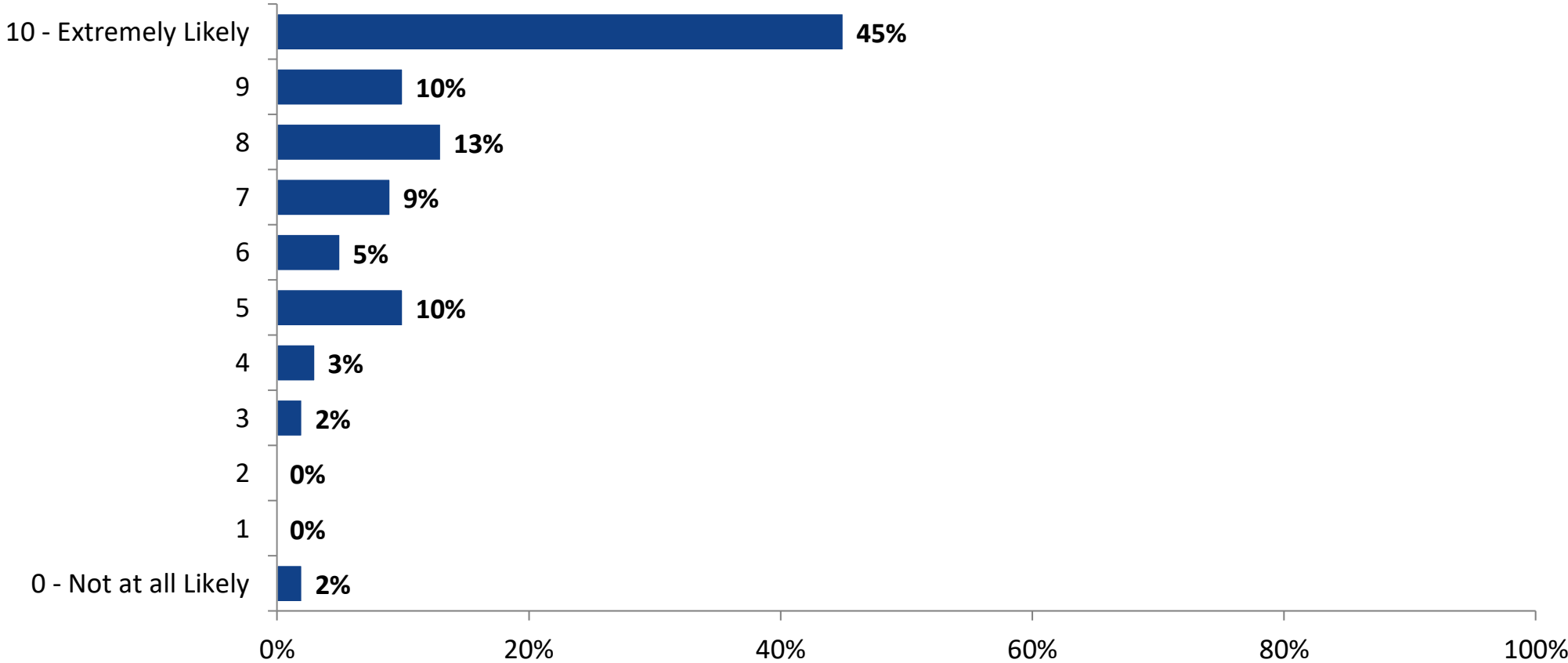
How likely are you to recommend your child's school to a family member or friend? (N=423)
