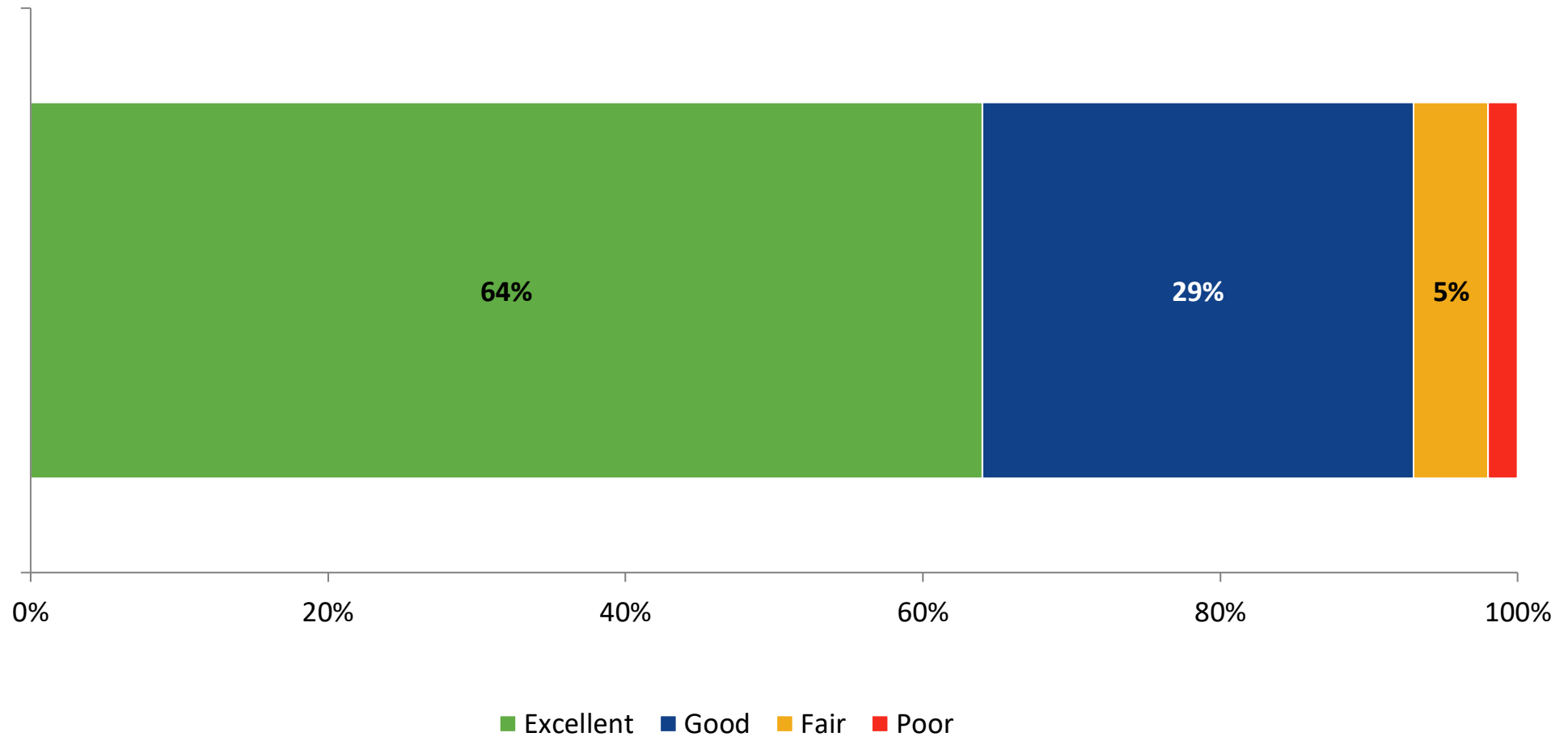

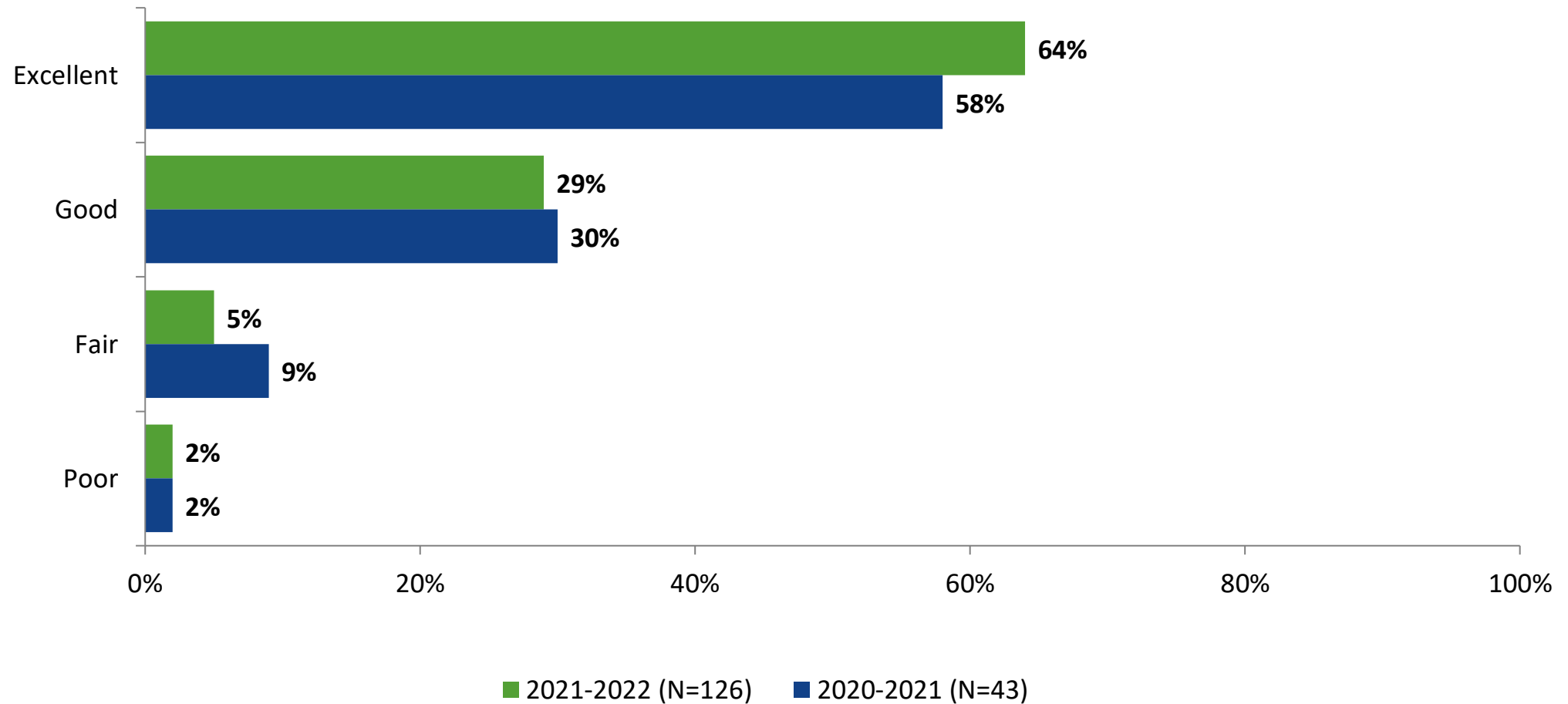
# Overall Quality

How would you rate the overall quality of your child's school? (N=126)



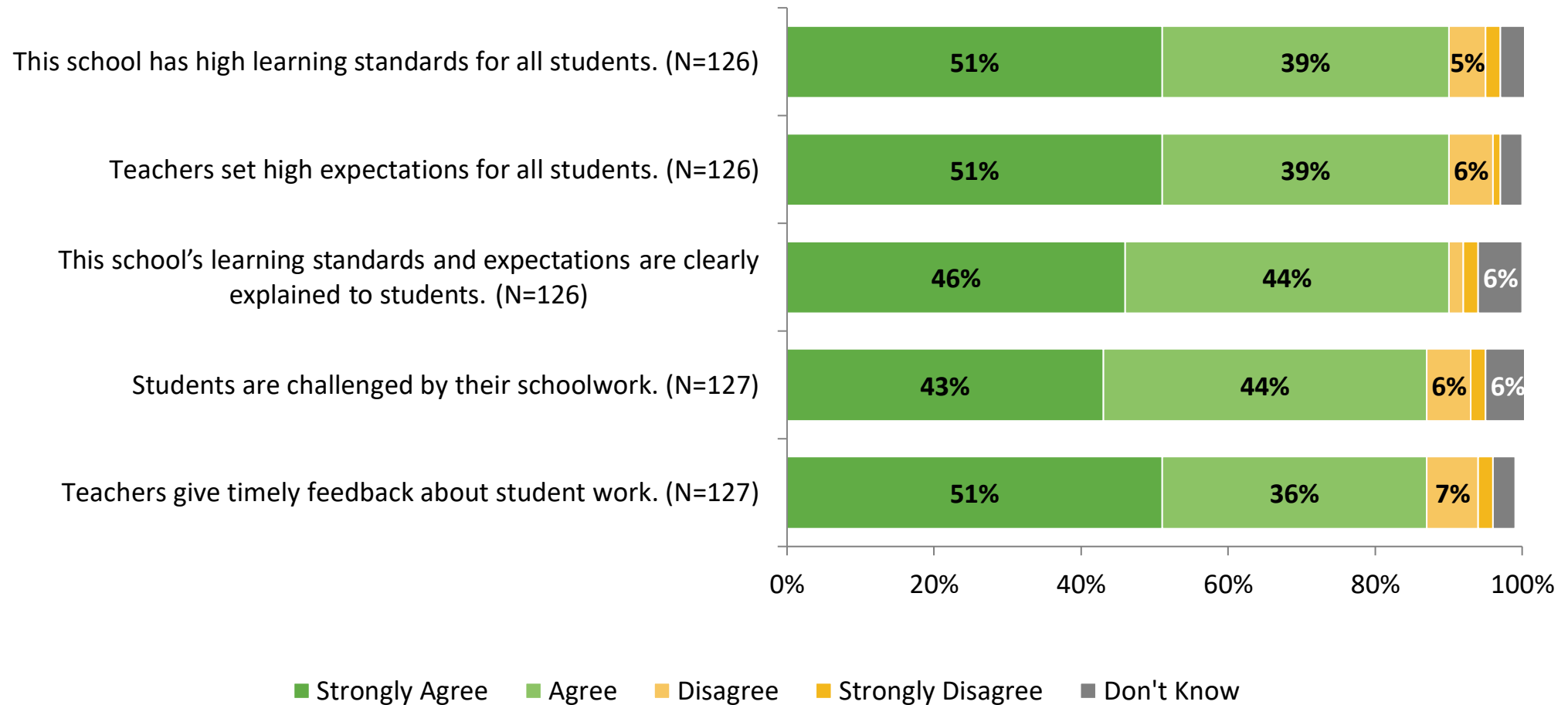
# Overall Quality: Comparison Over Time

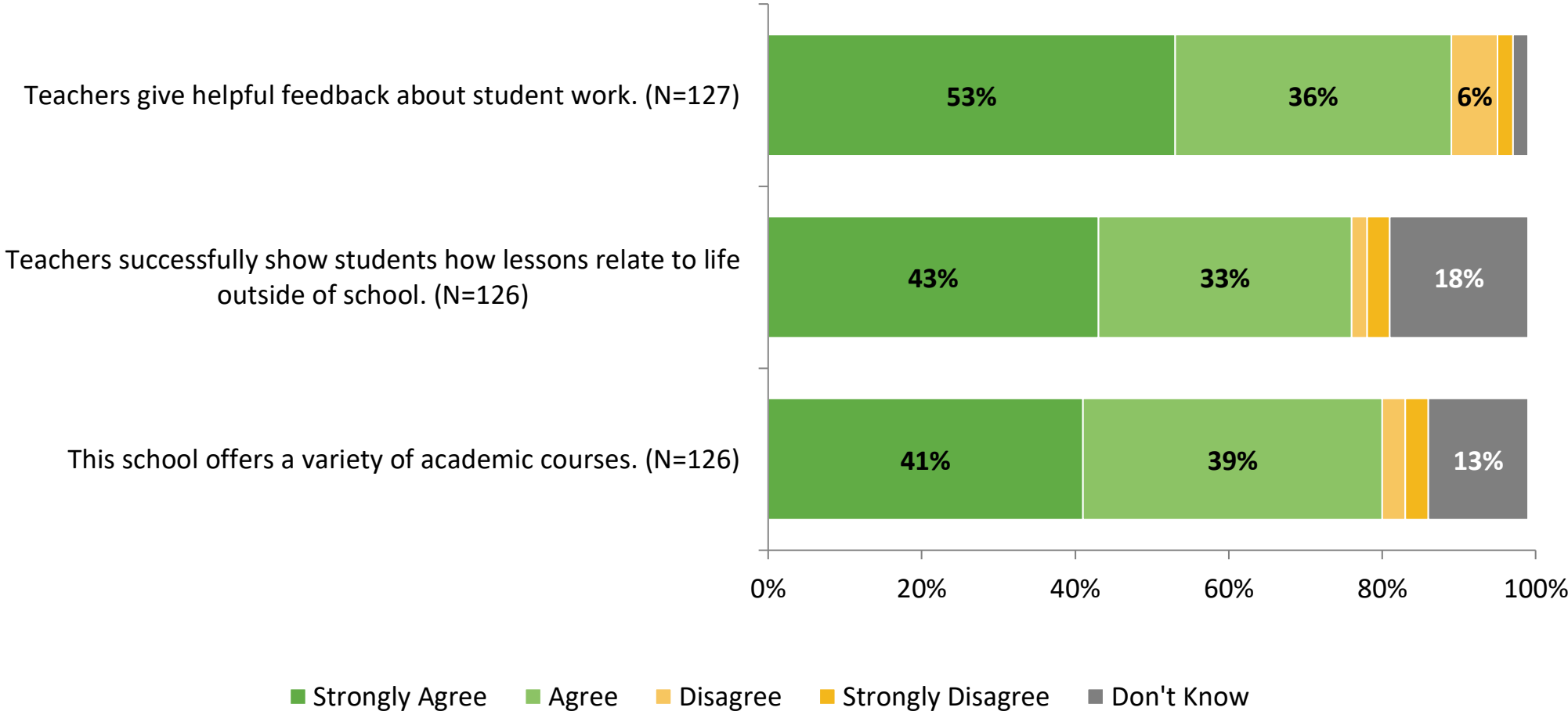

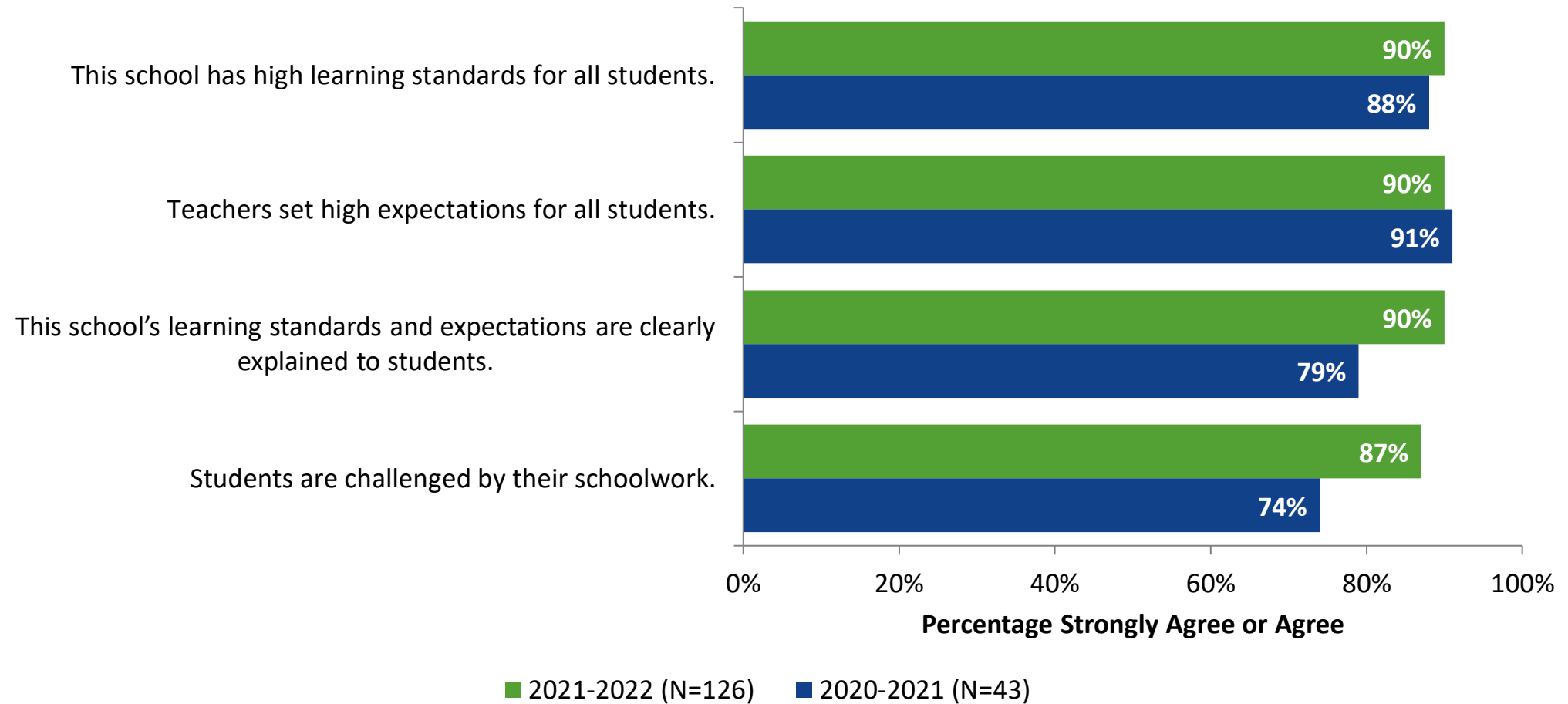

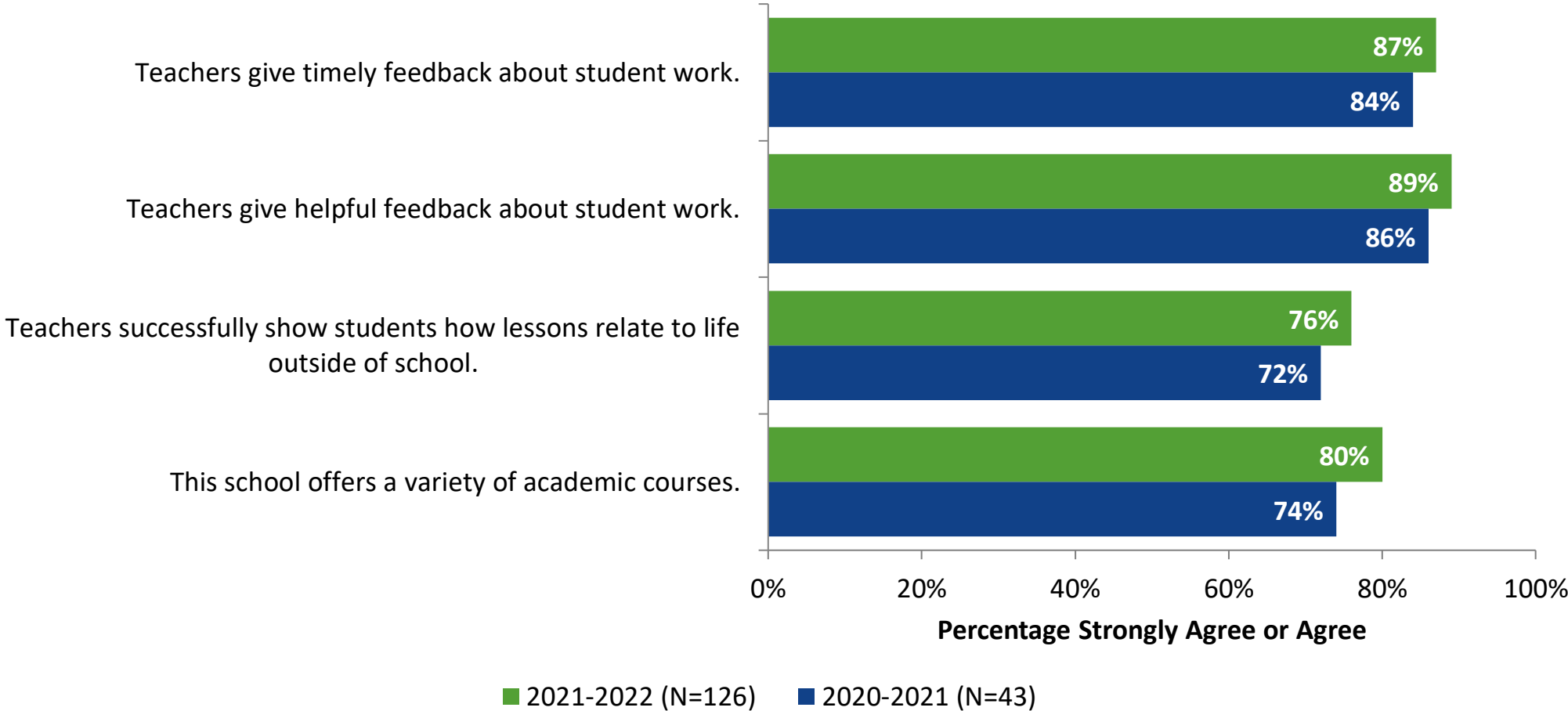

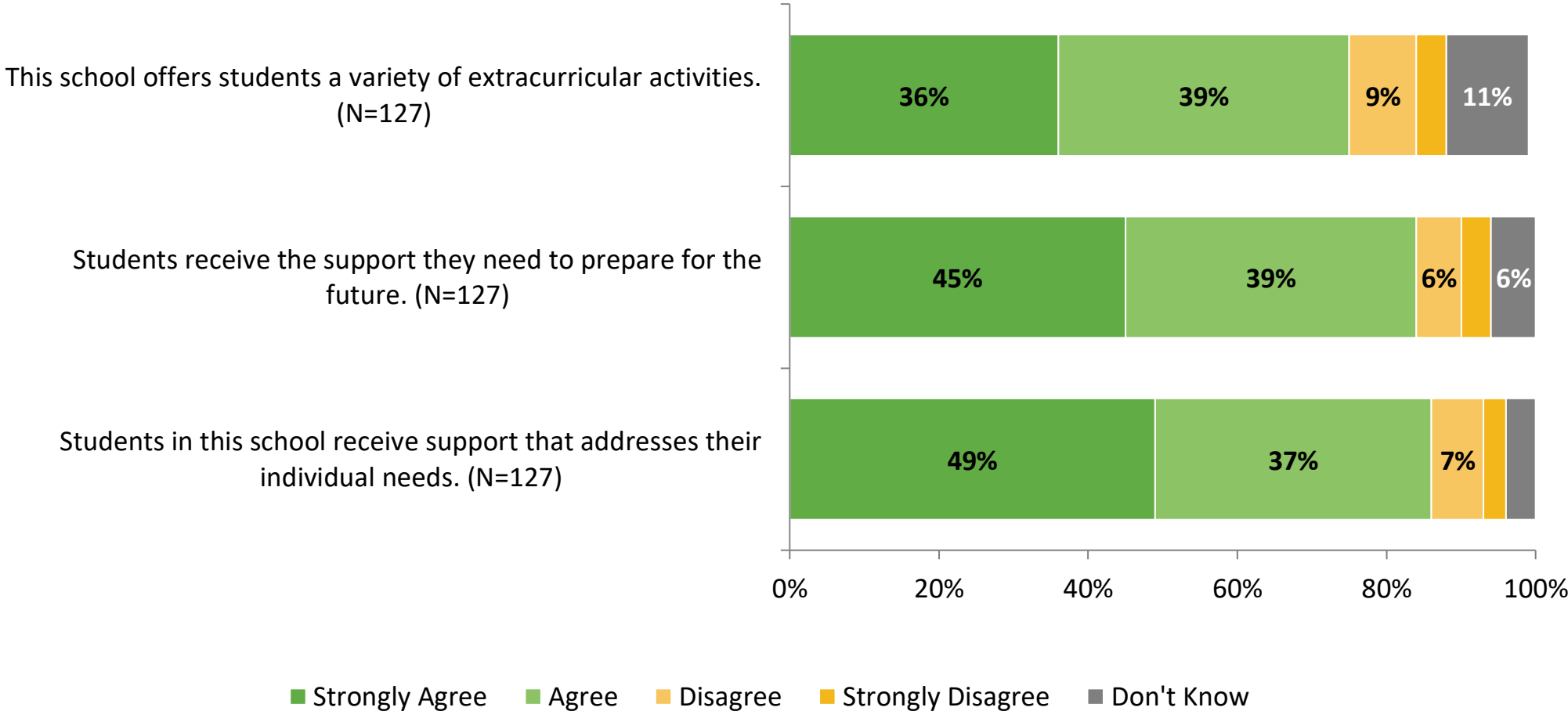

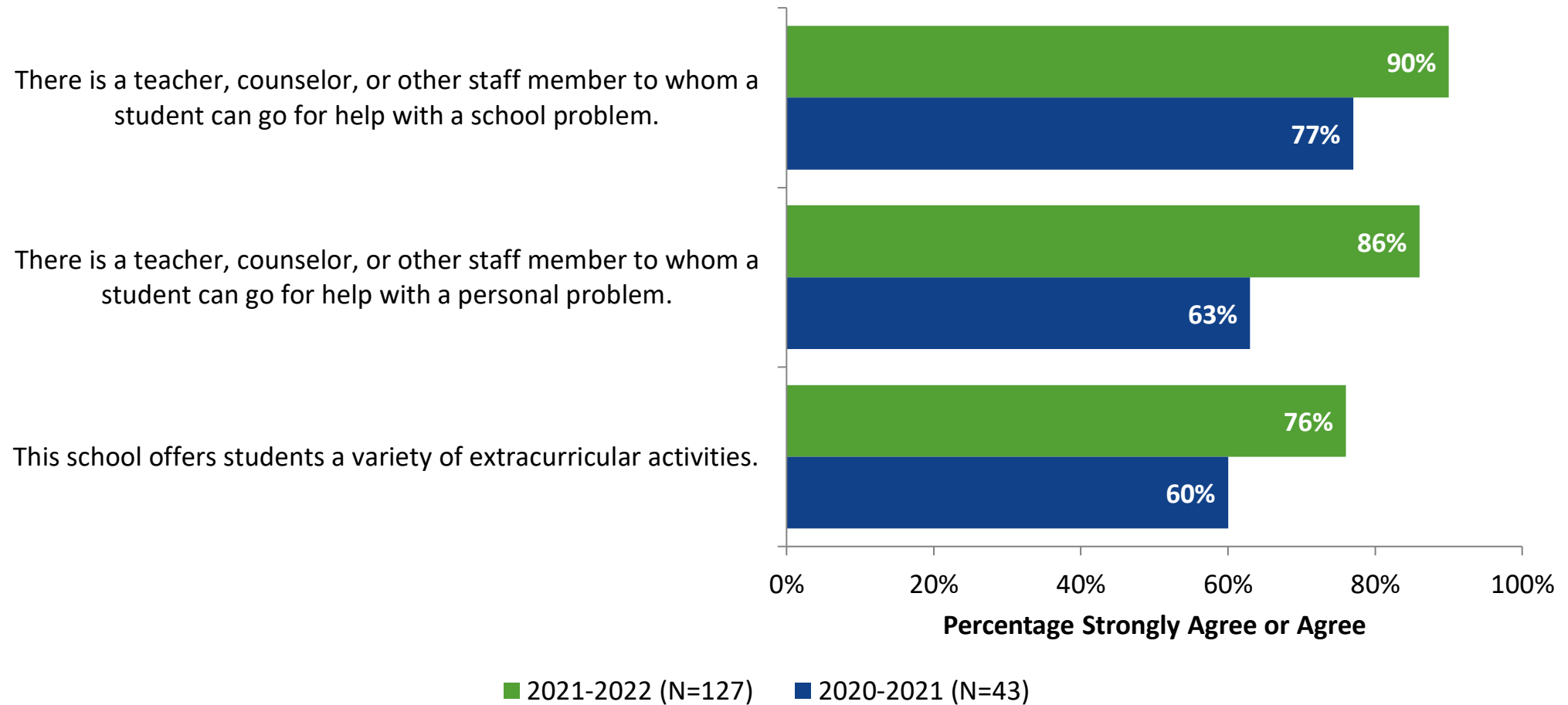

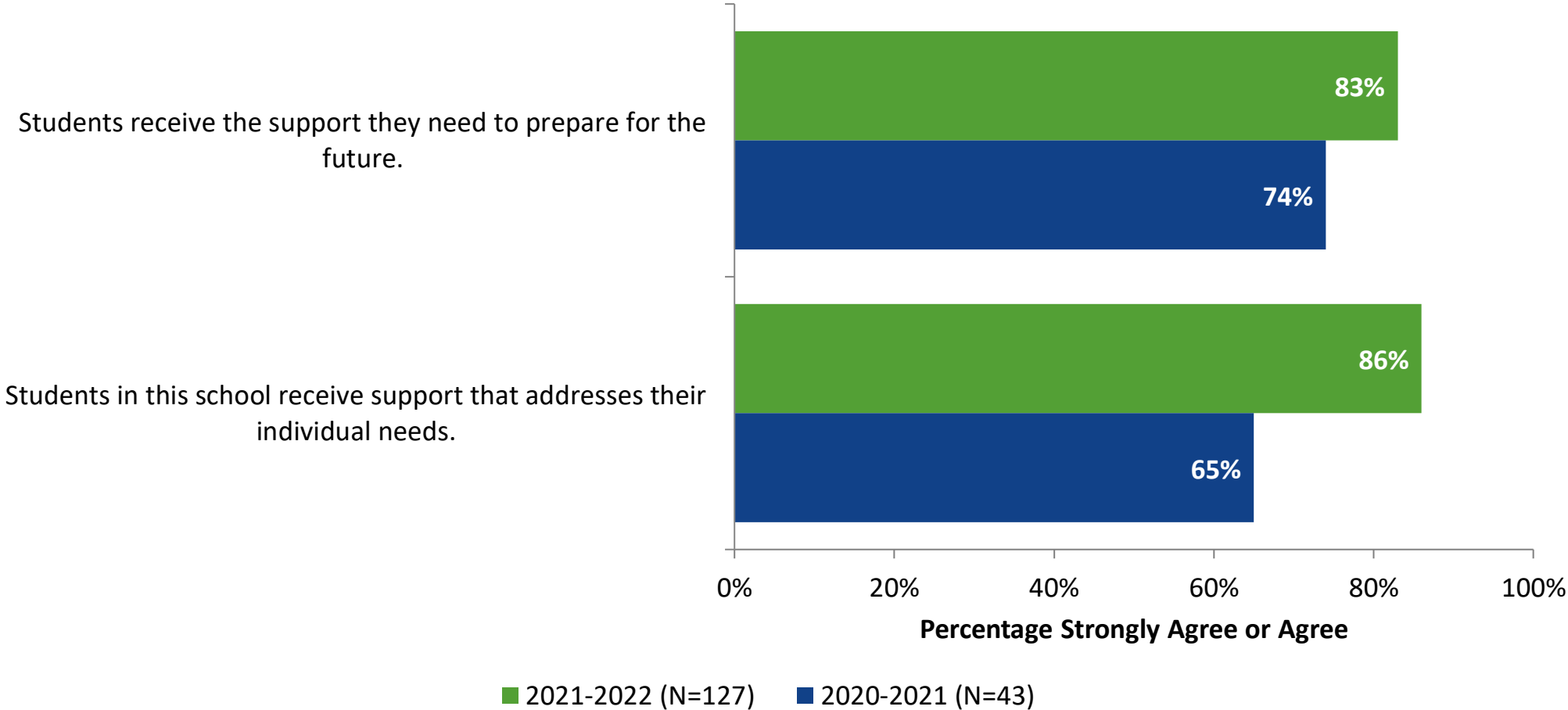

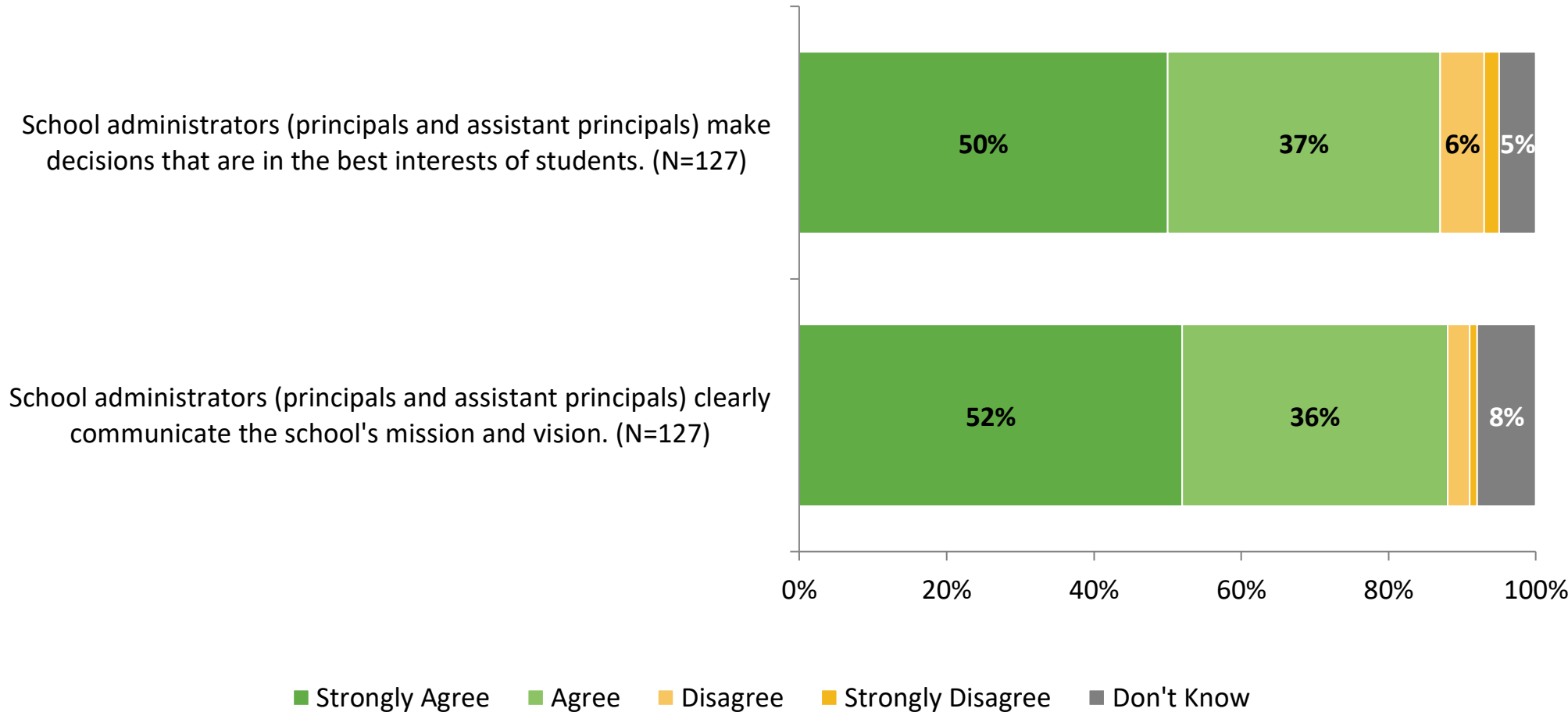

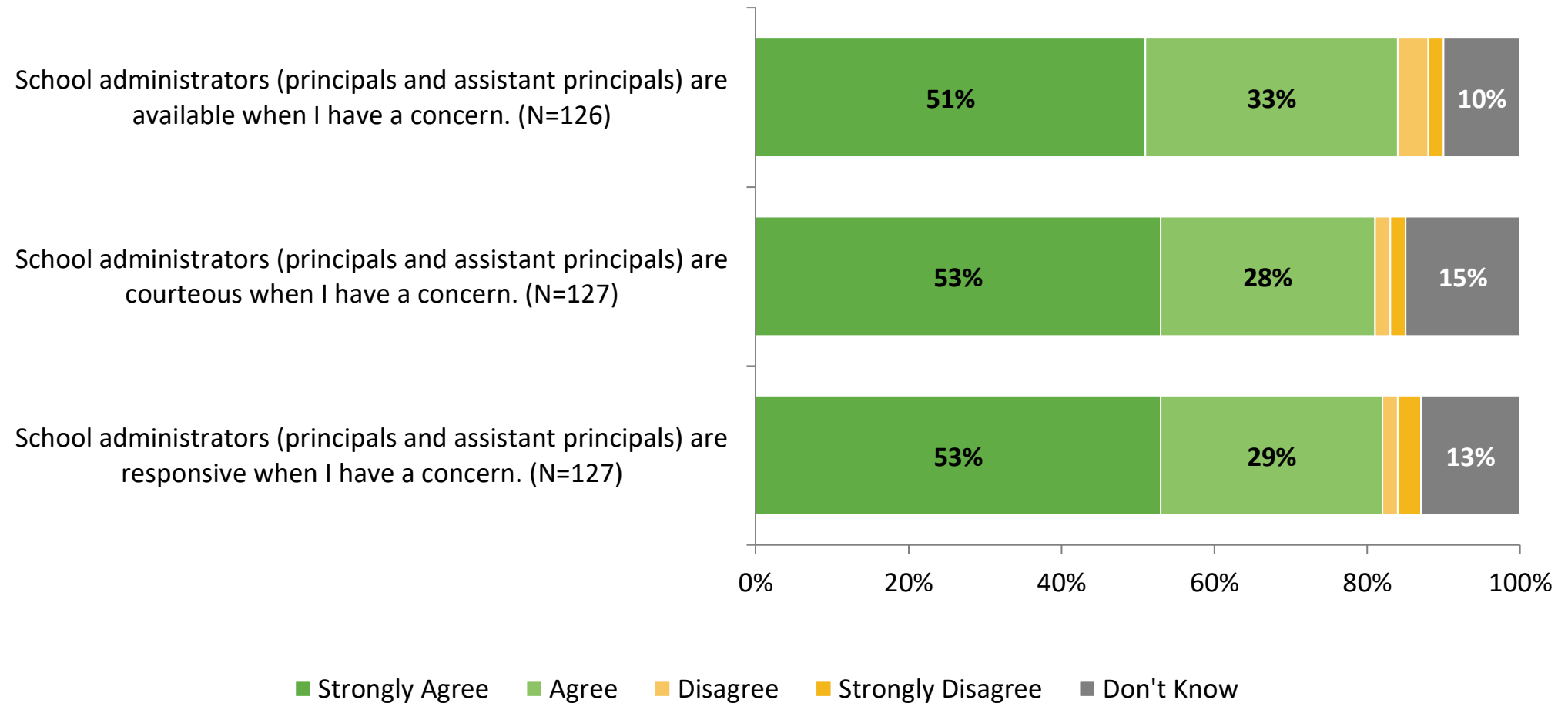

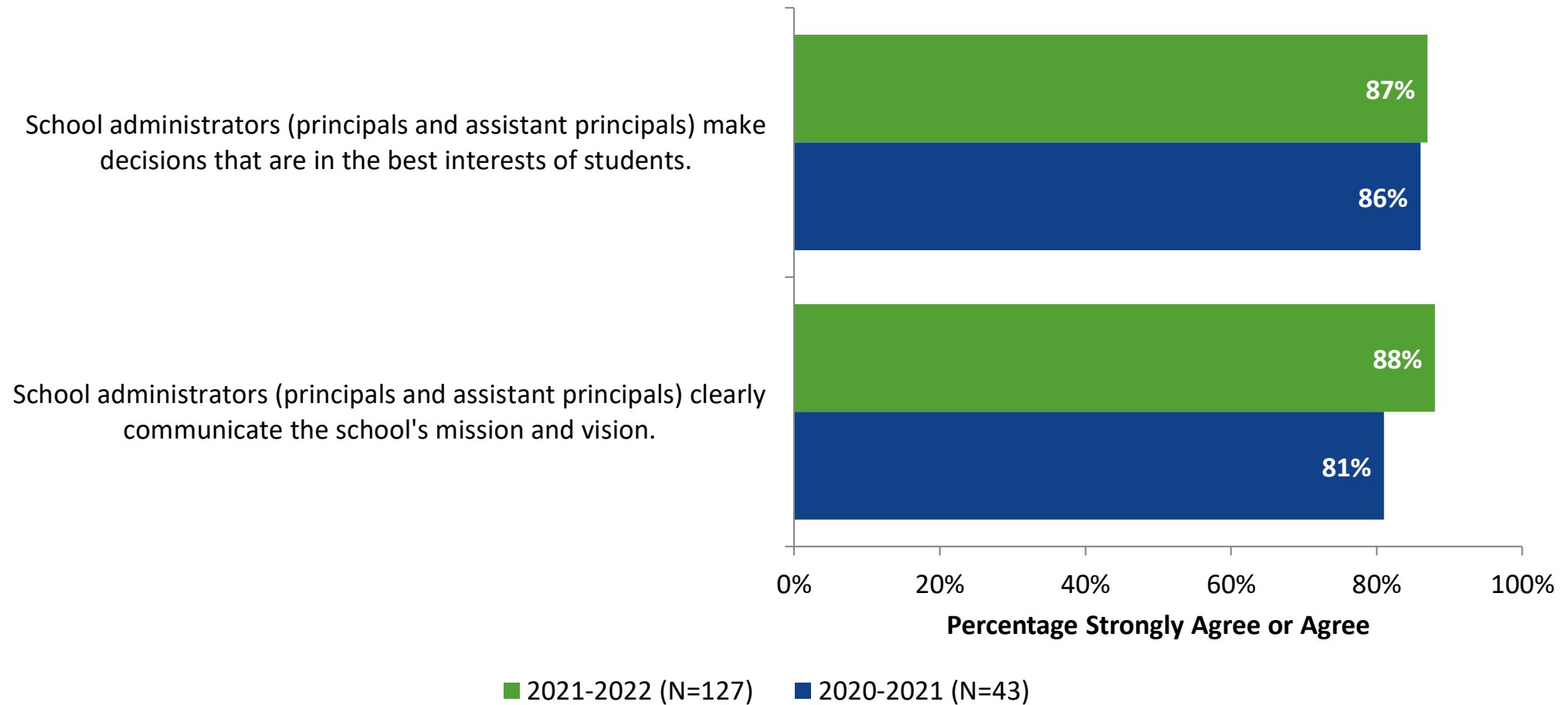

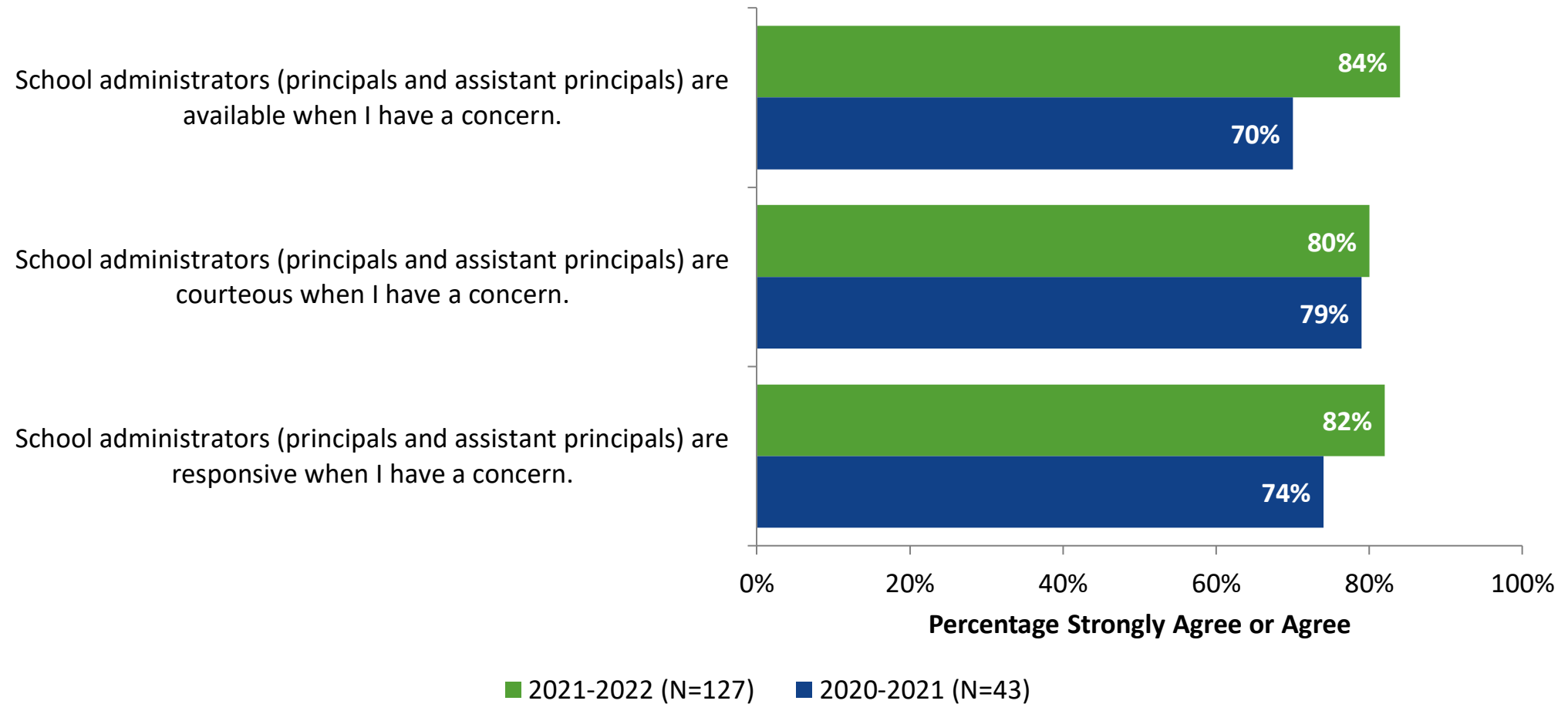

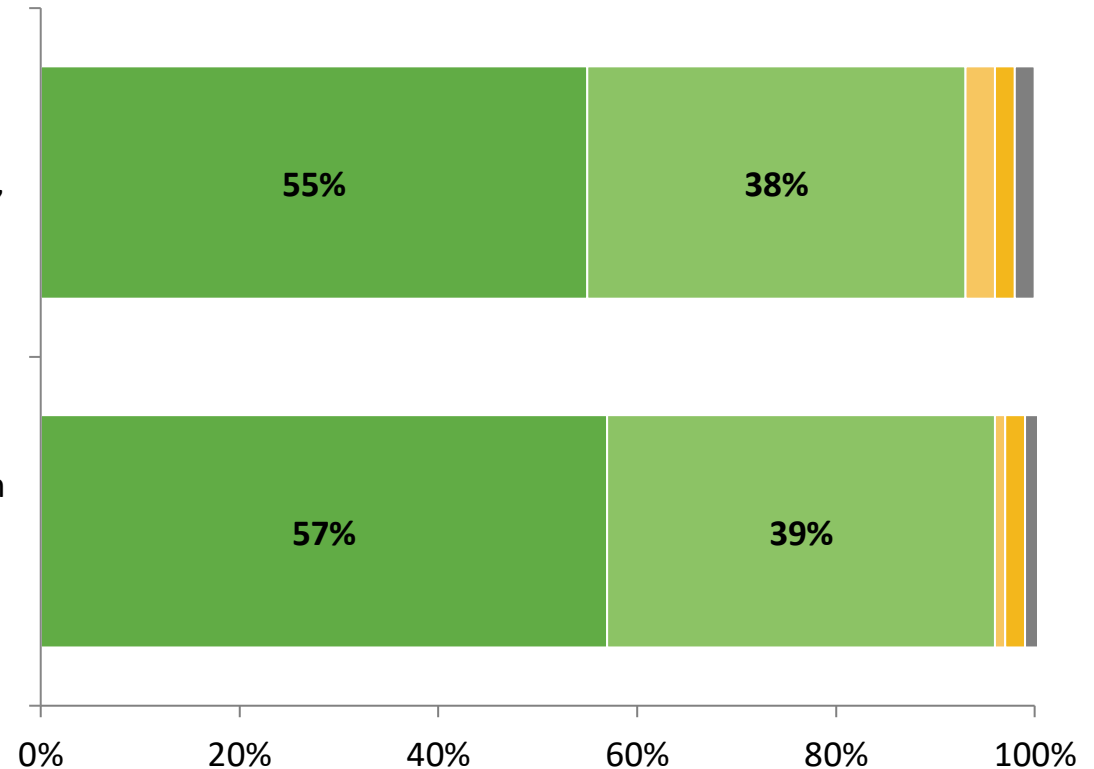

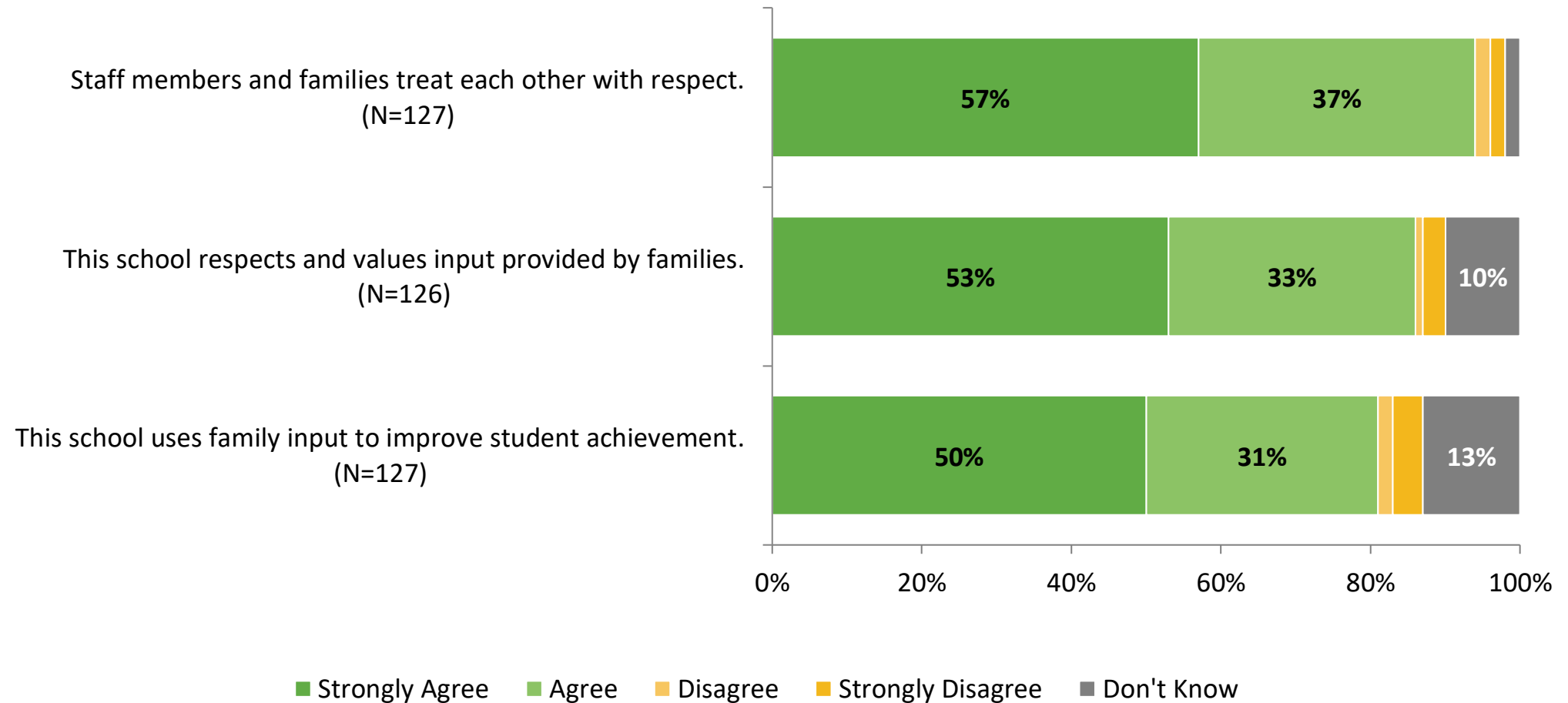

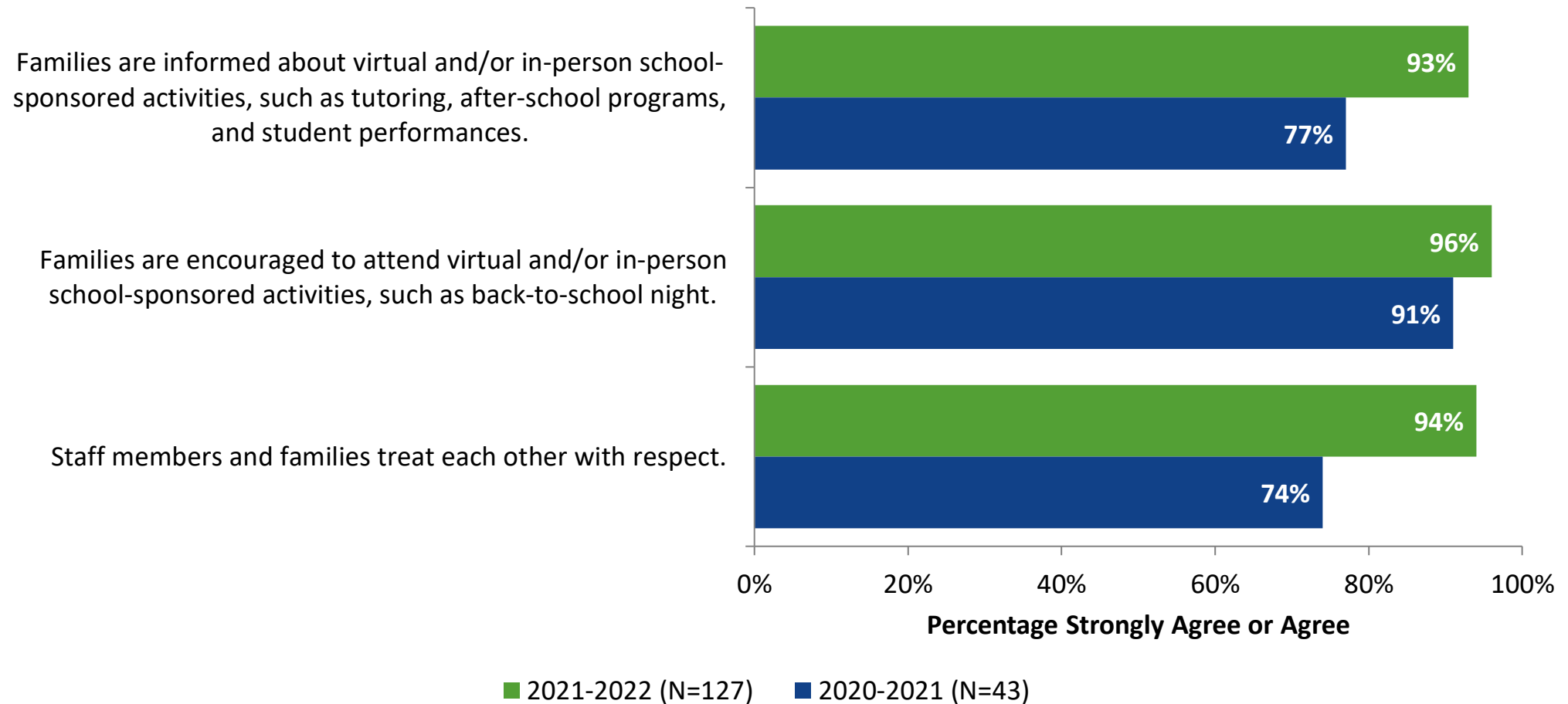

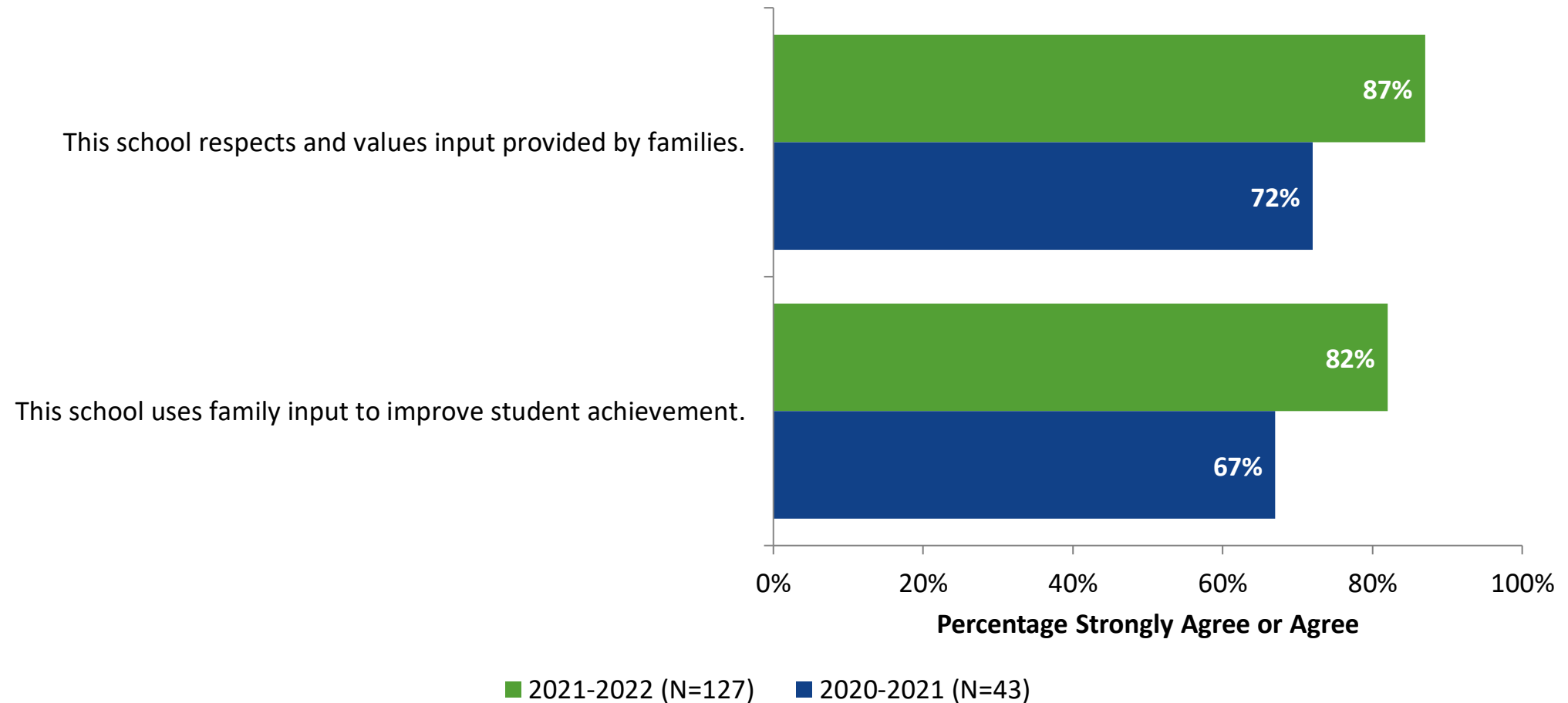

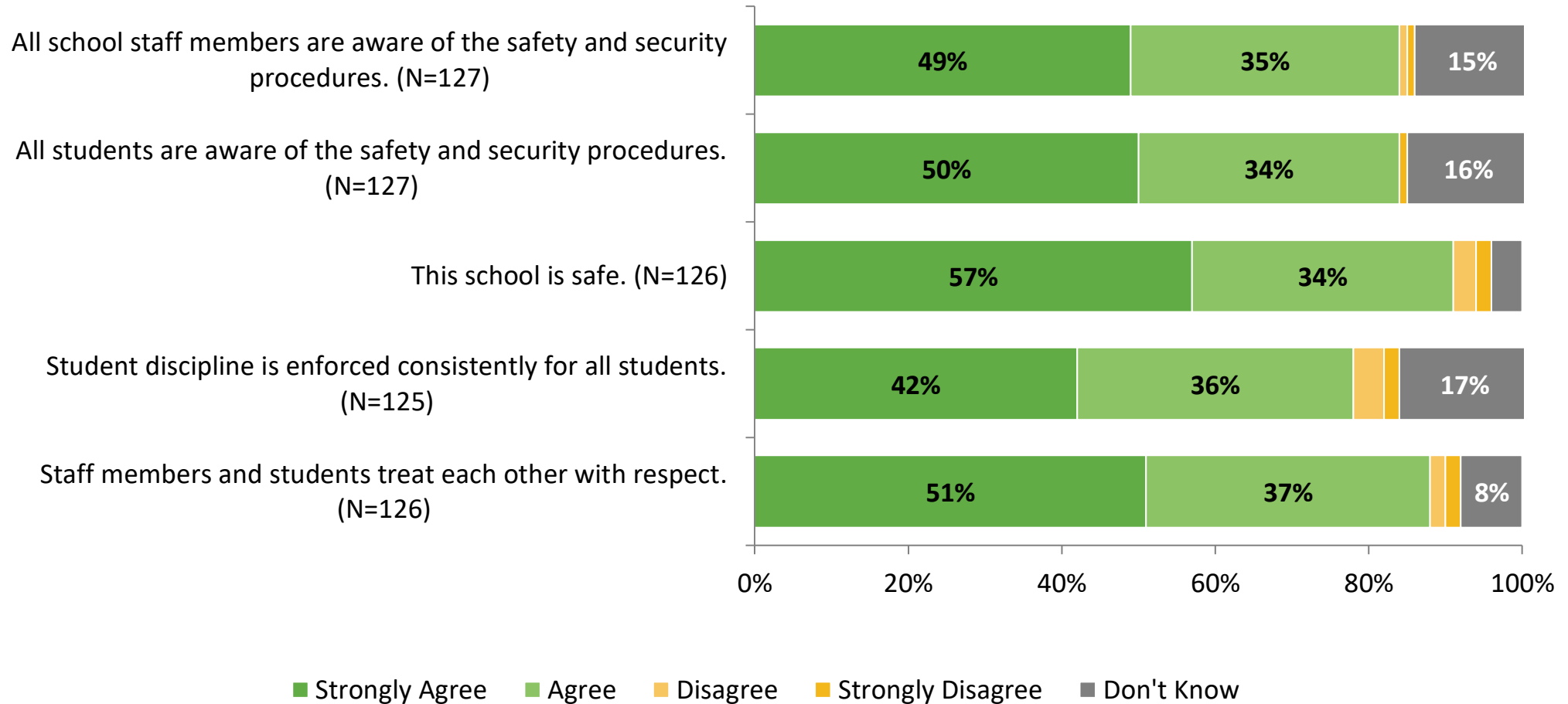

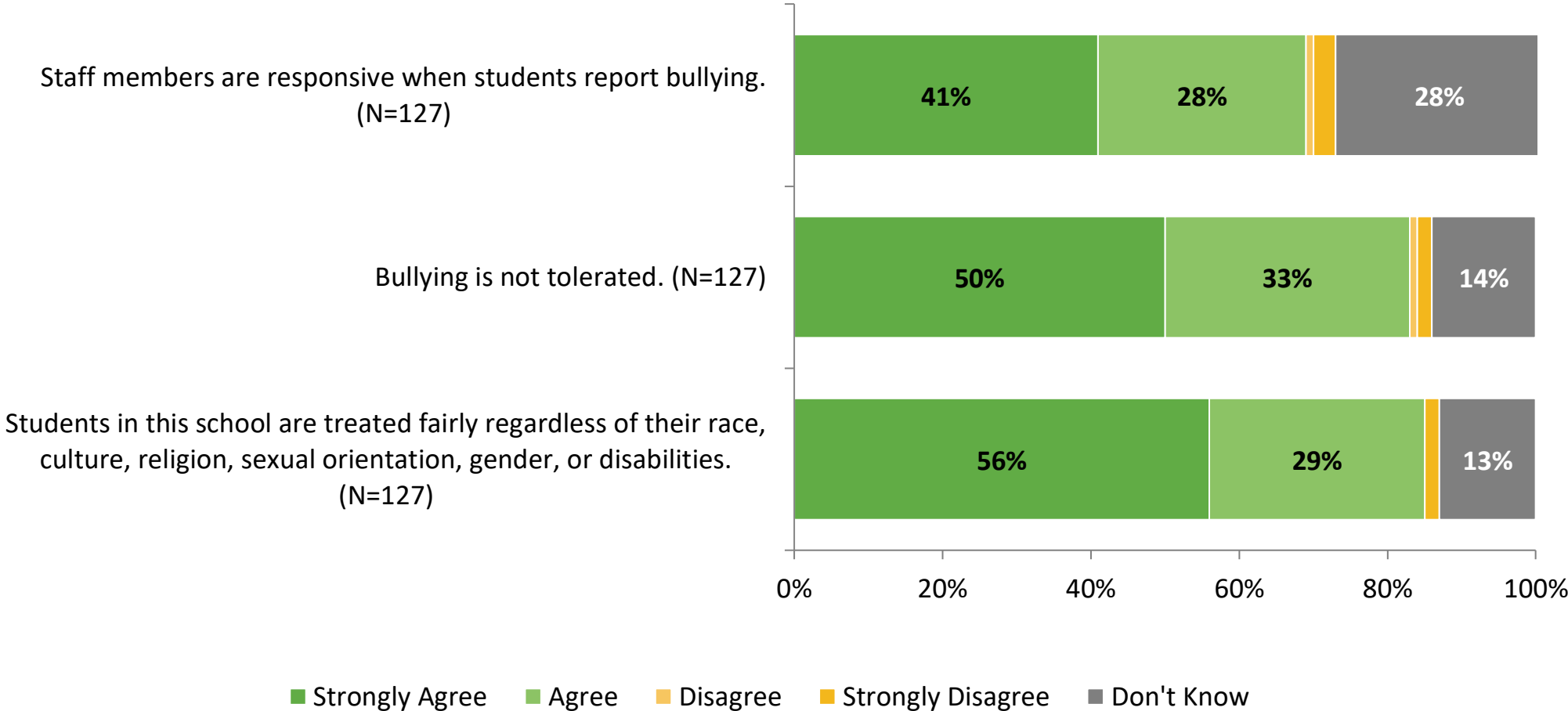

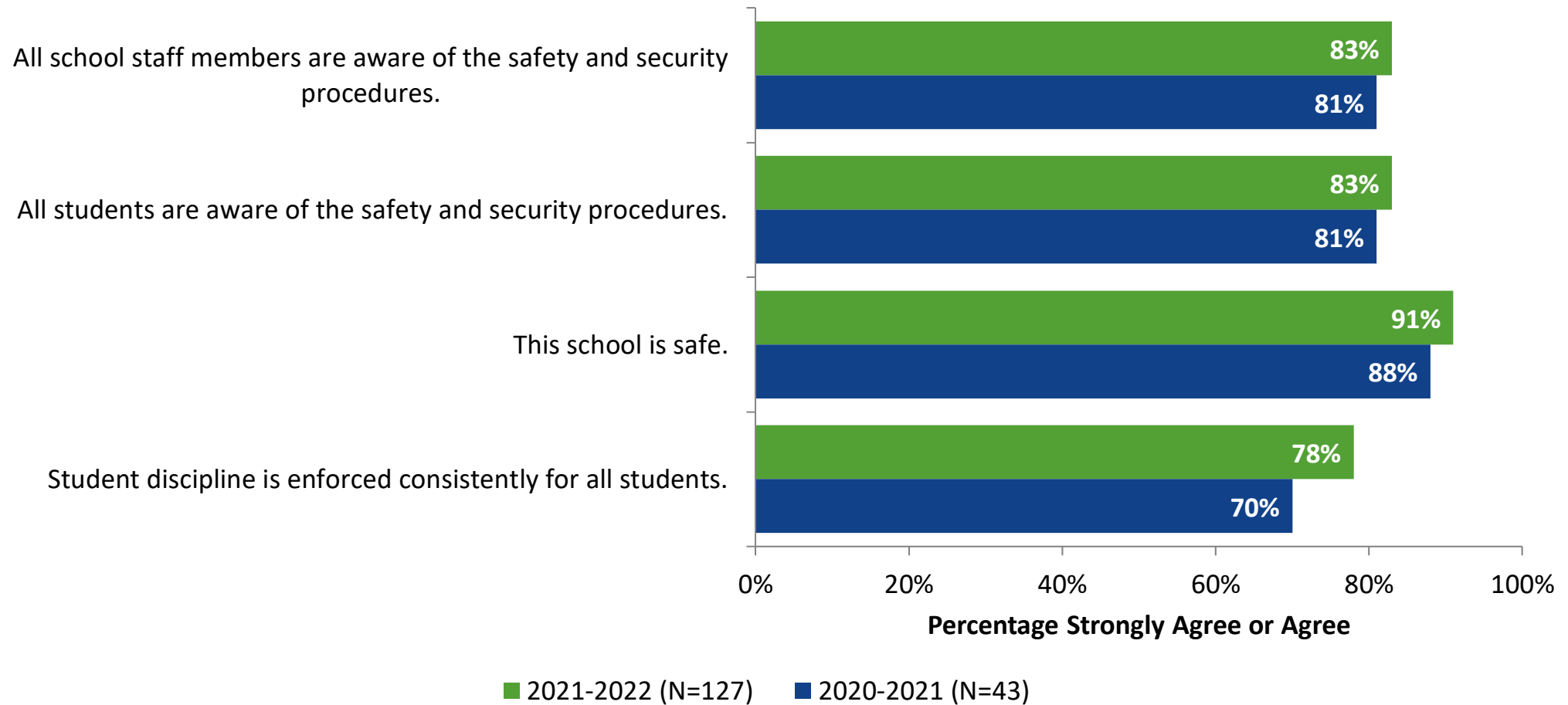

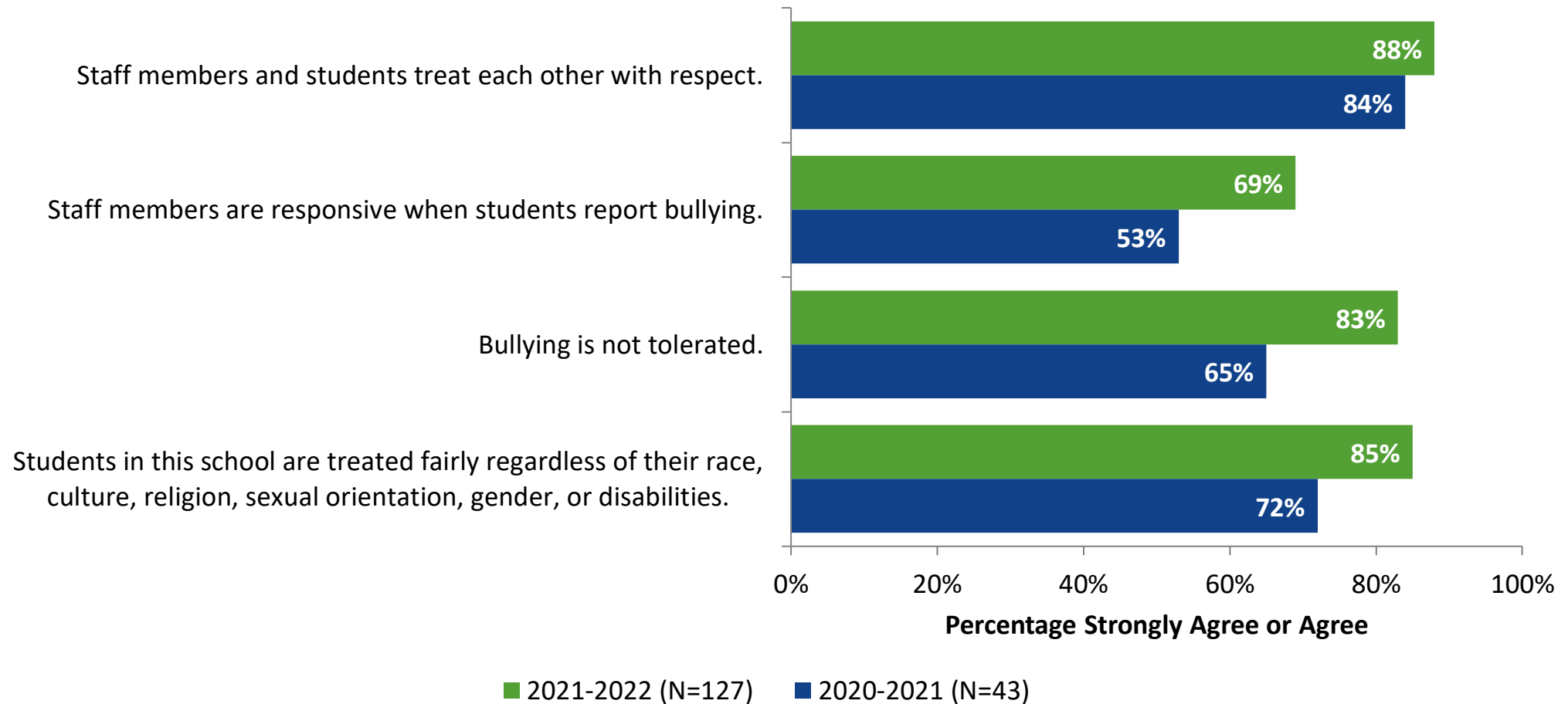

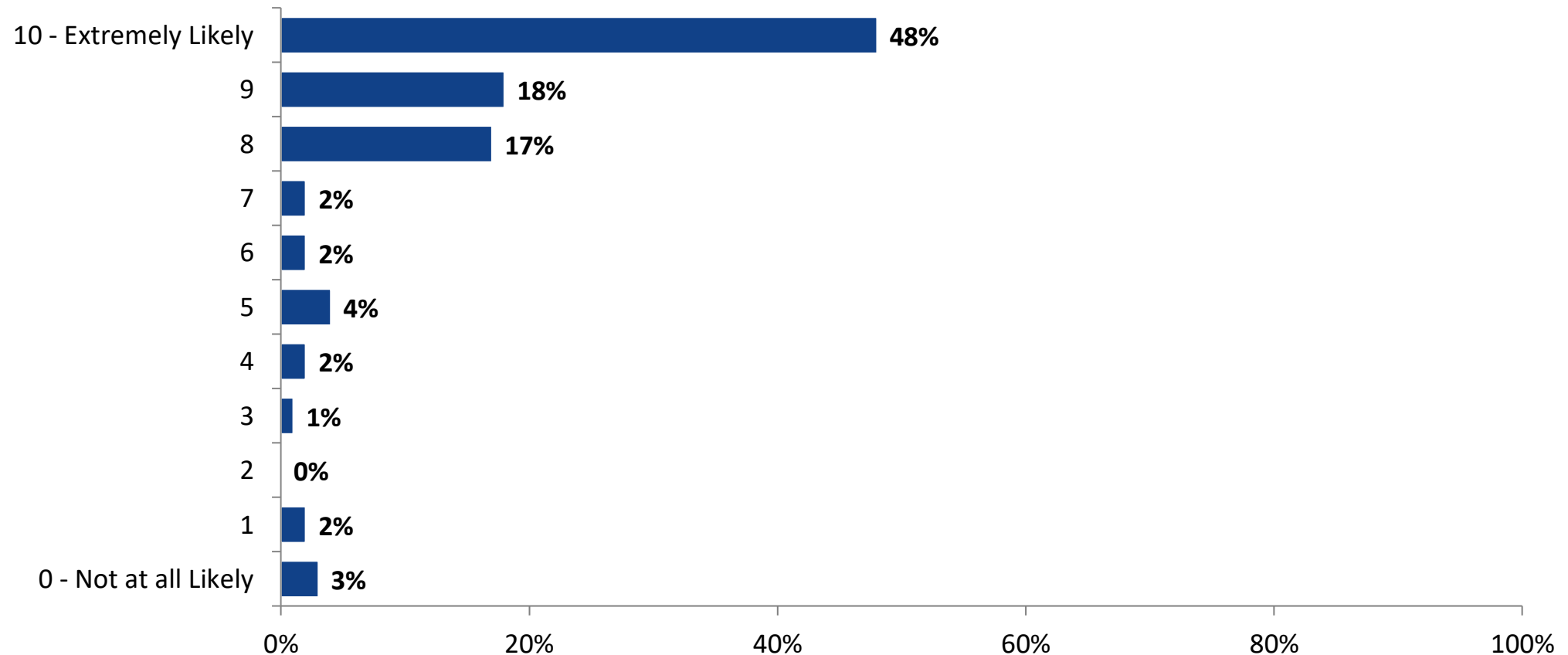

# Net Promoter Score - School

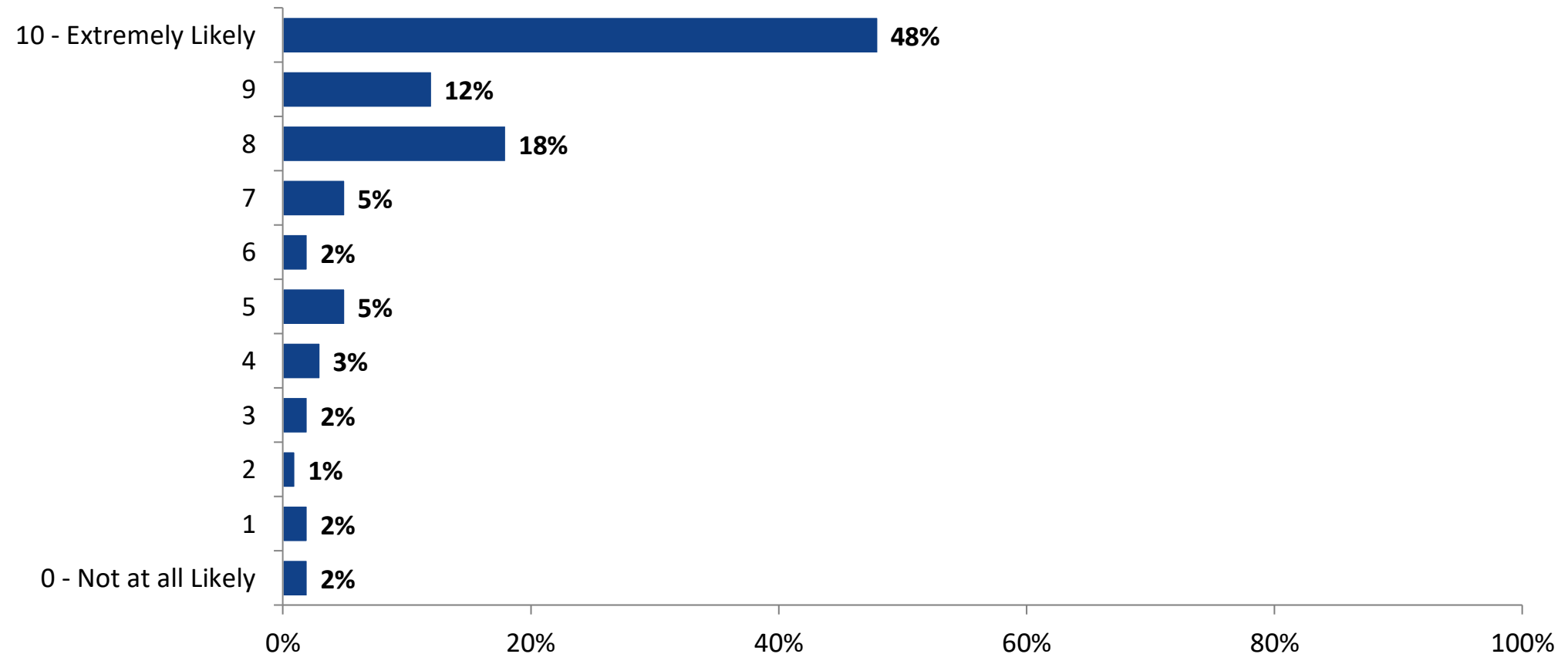
How likely are you to recommend your child's school to a family member or friend? (N=126)
