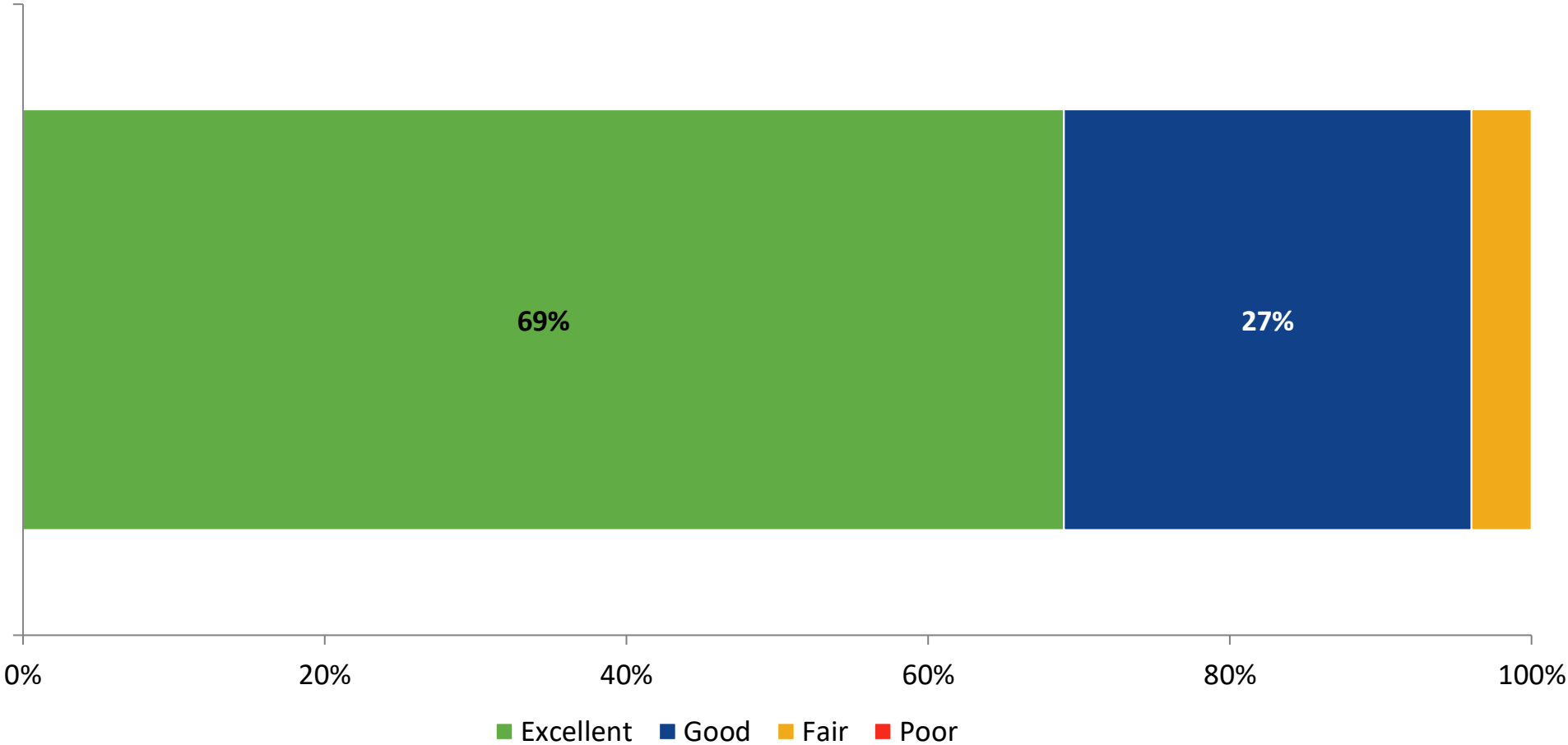

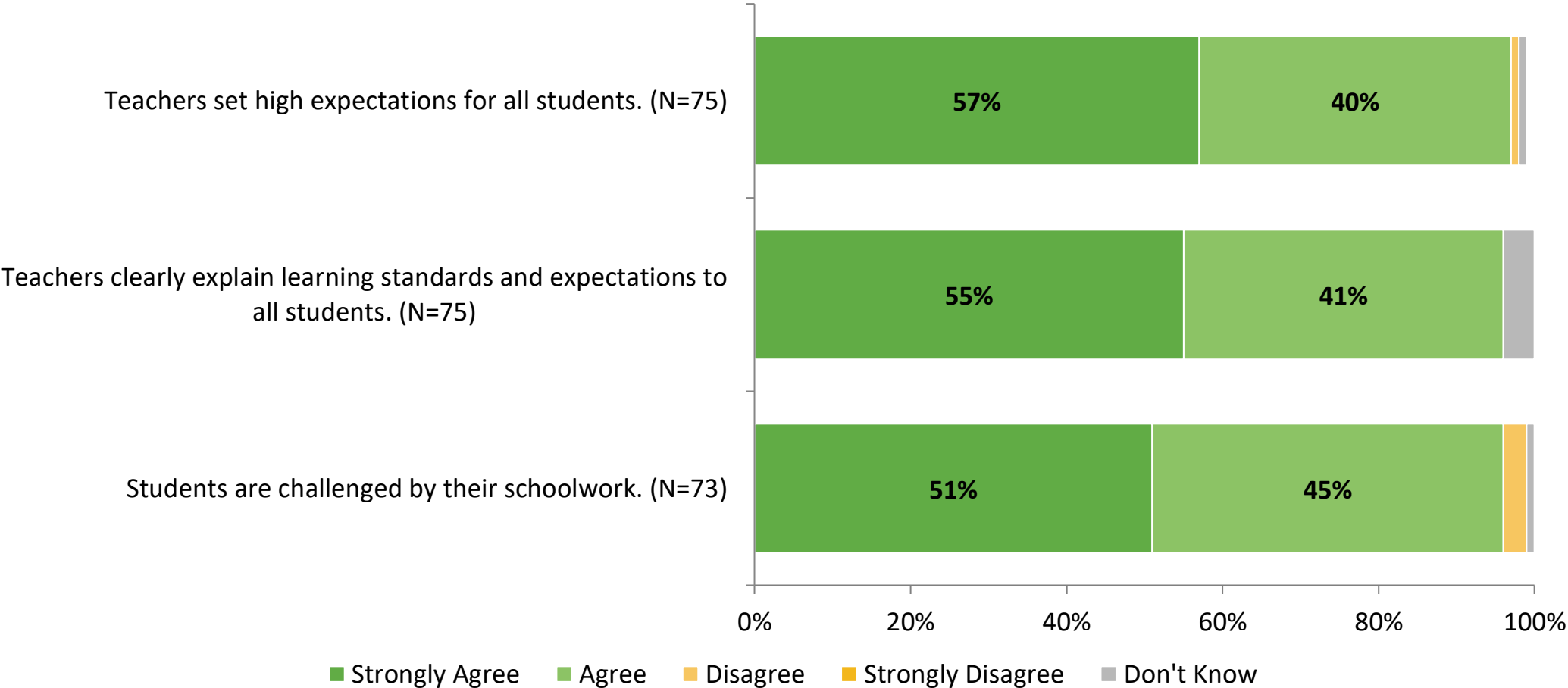

How would you rate the overall quality of the education at your child's school? (N=75)



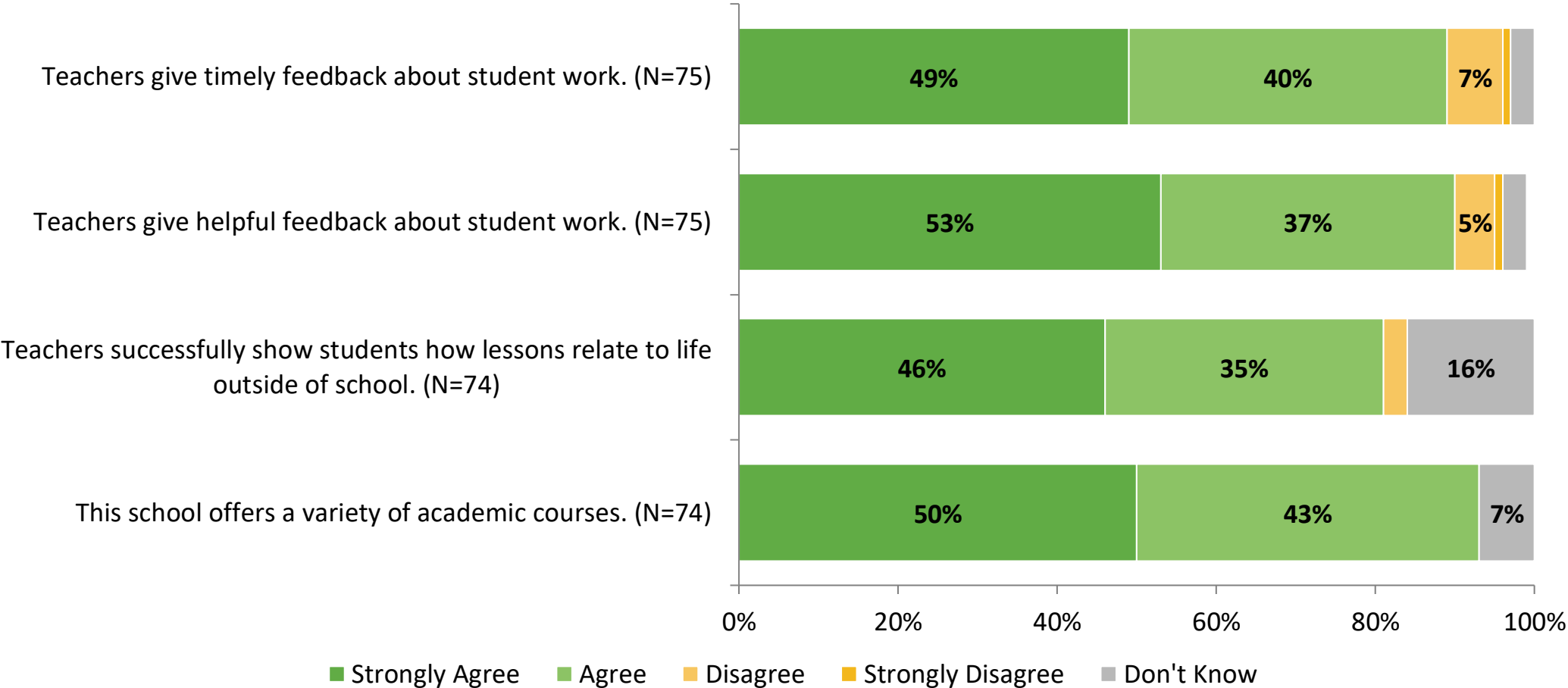

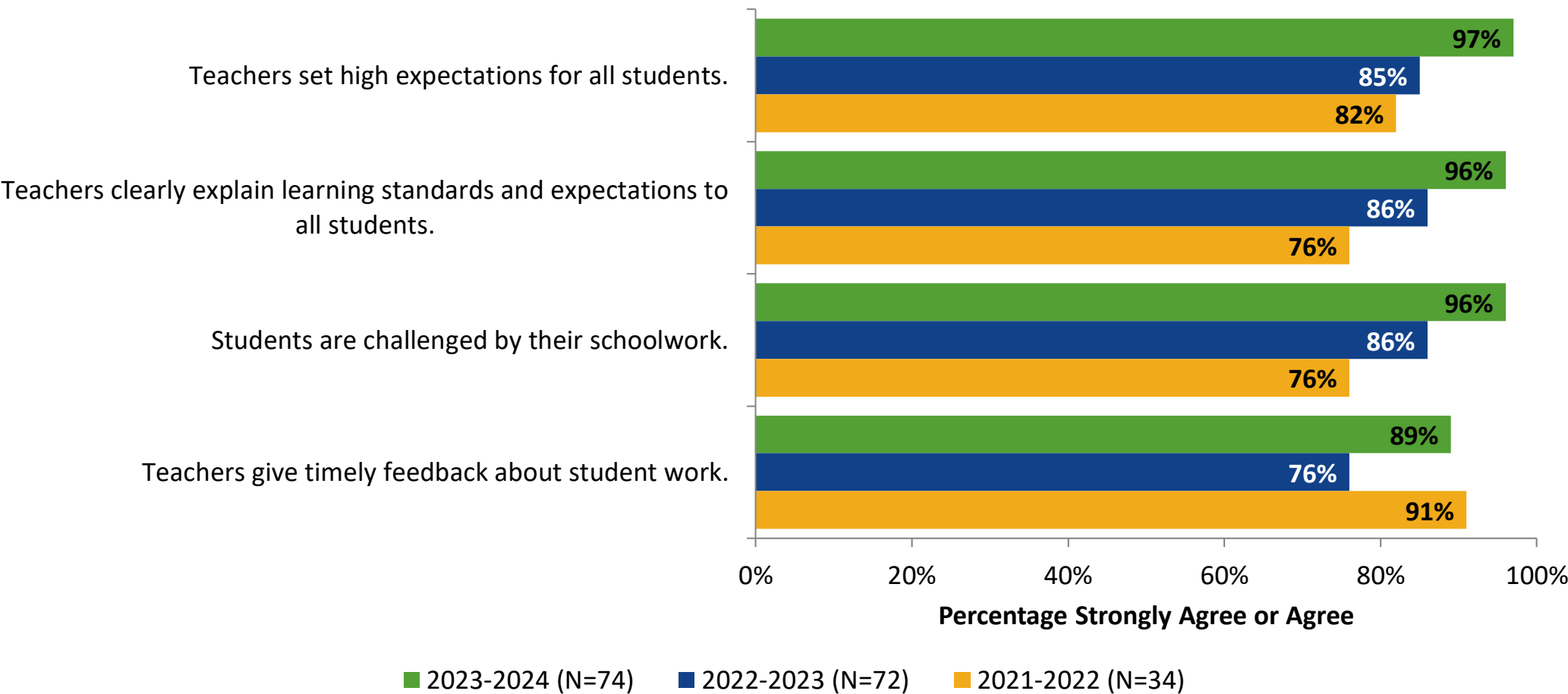

Academic Support: Comparison Over Time

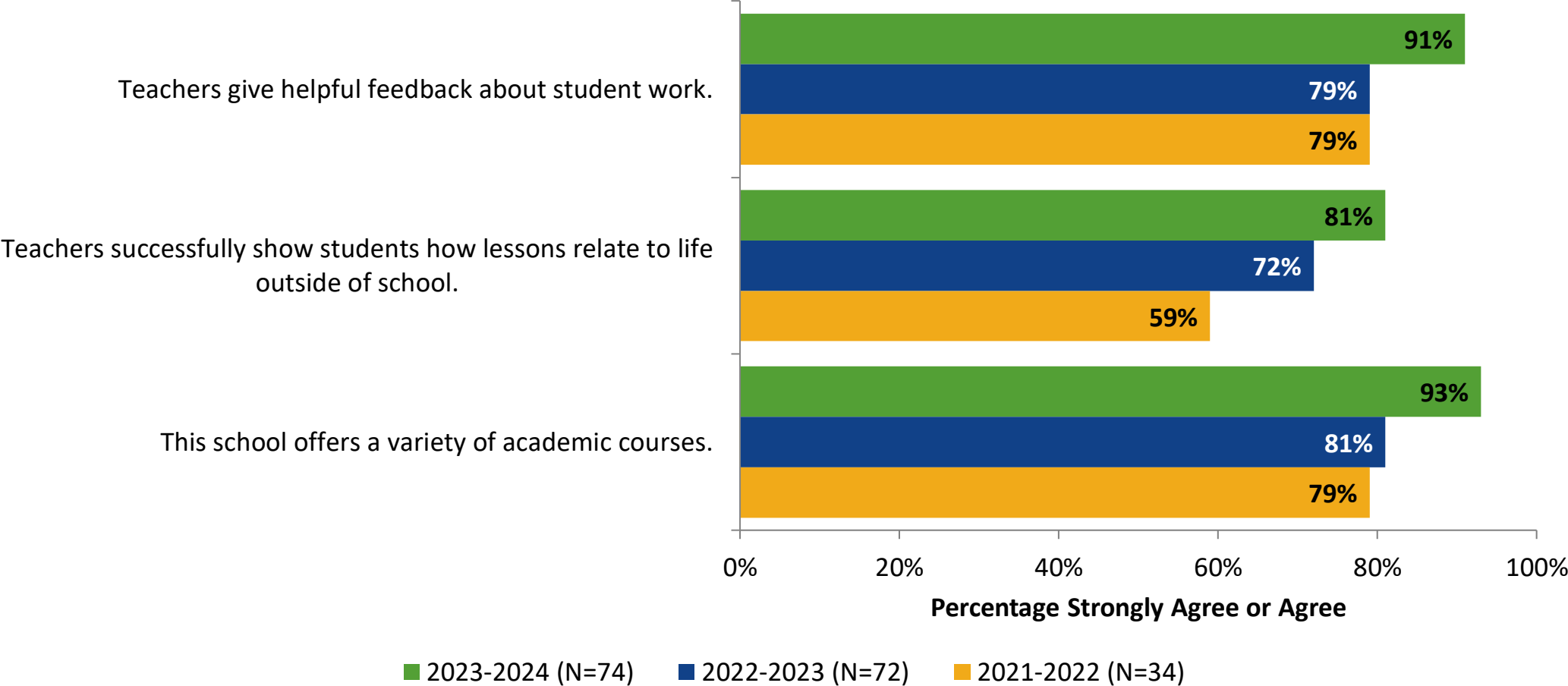

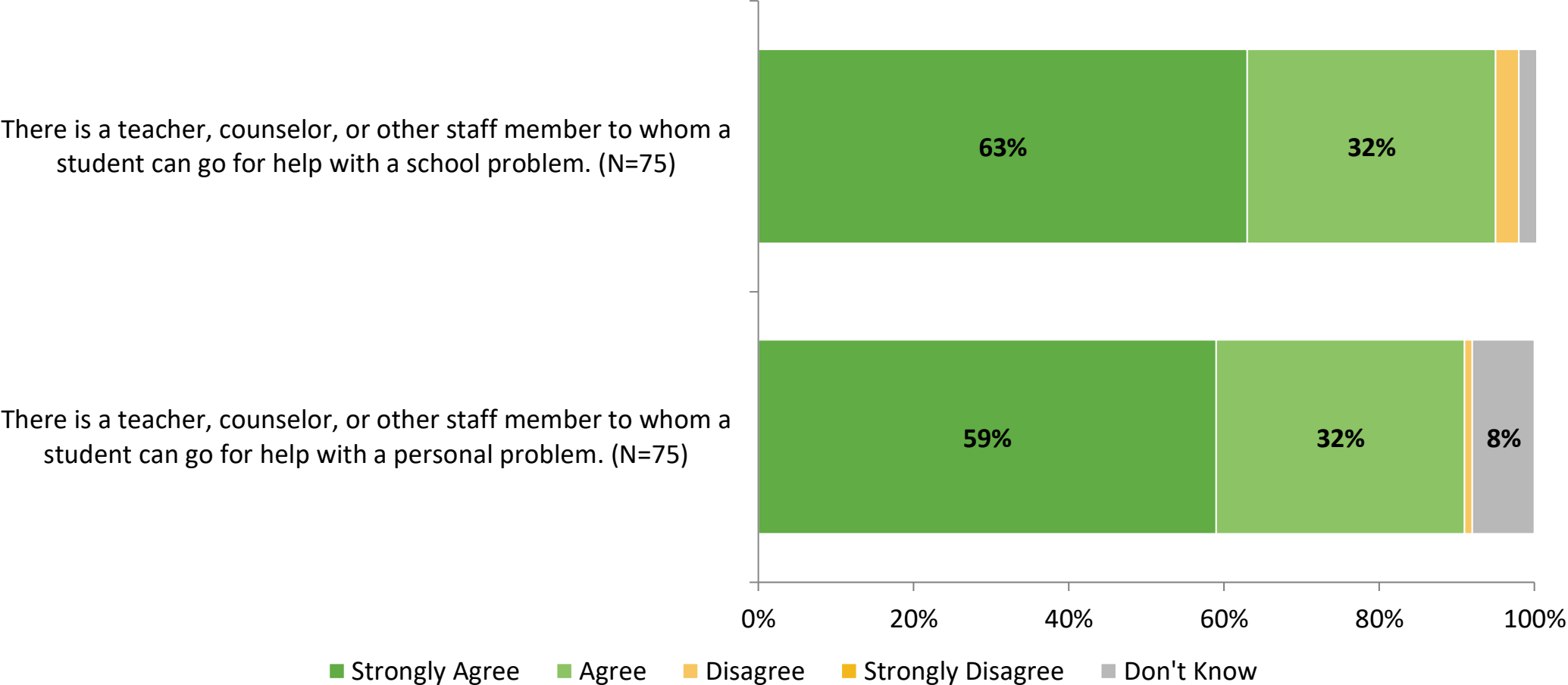

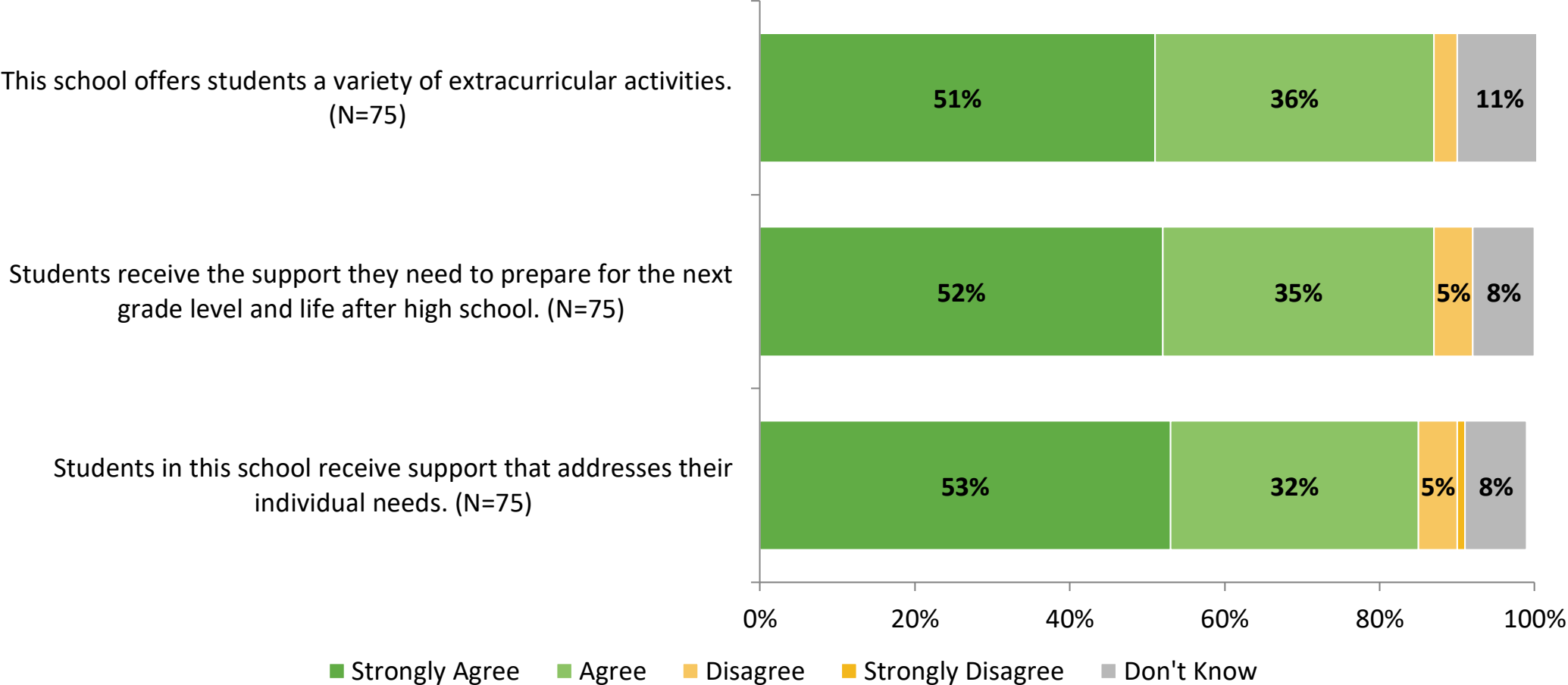

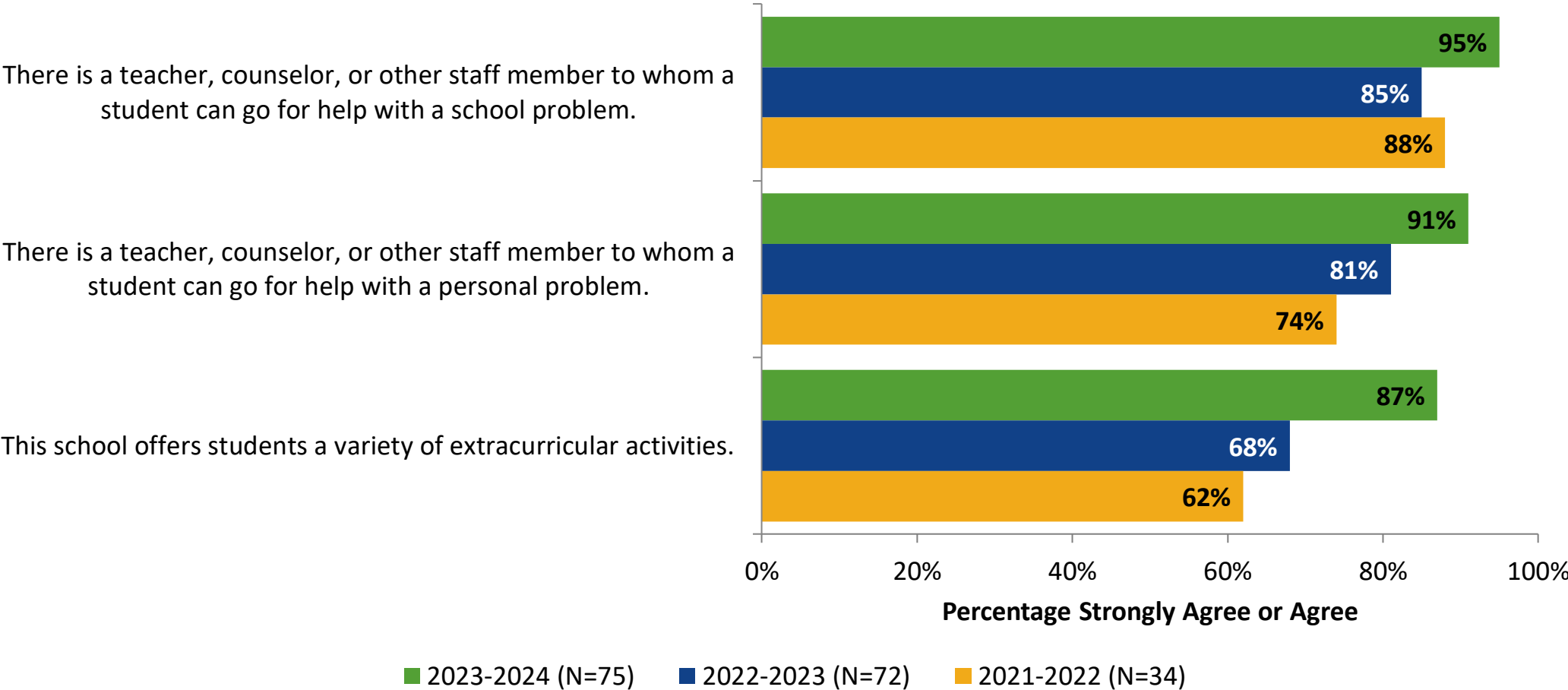

Student Support: Comparison Over Time

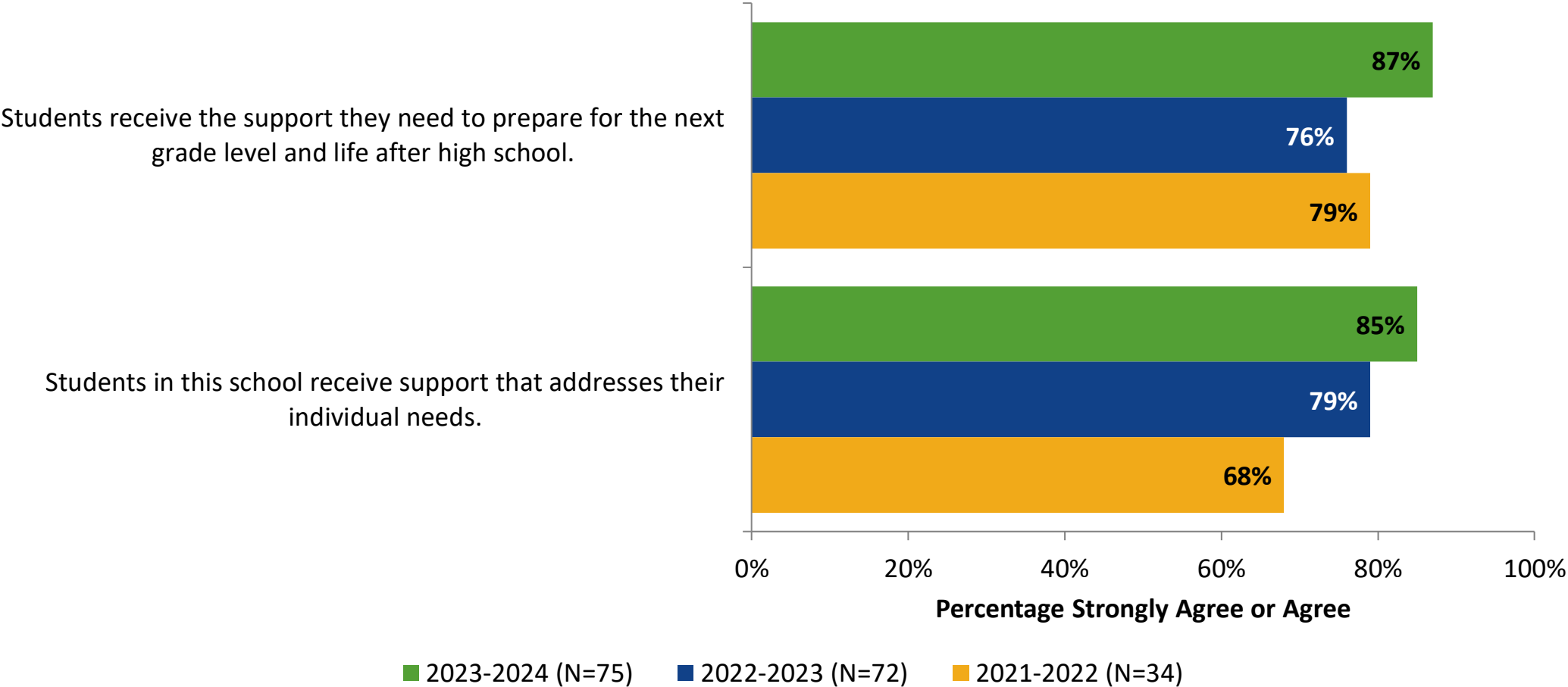

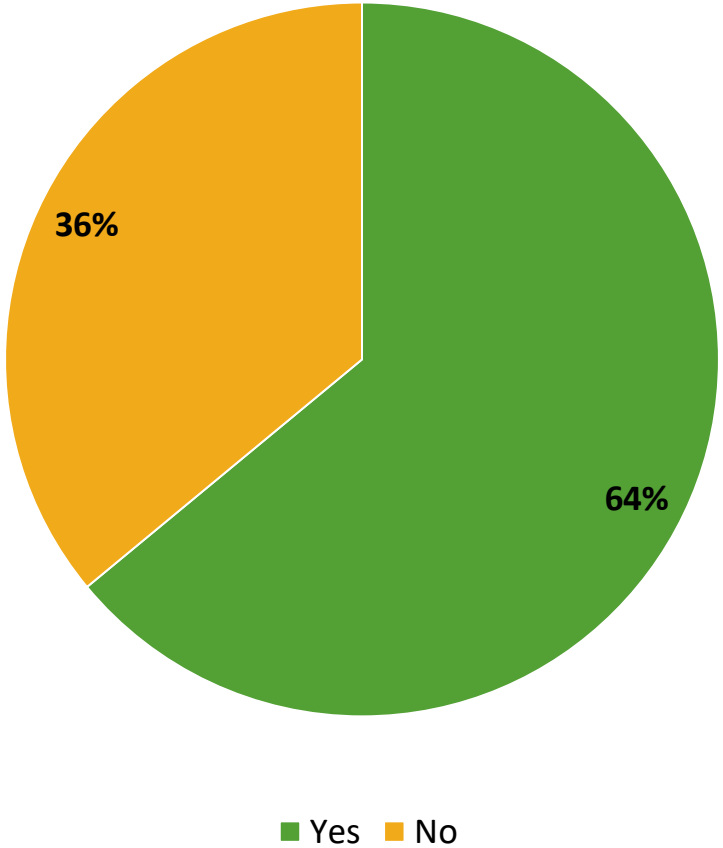

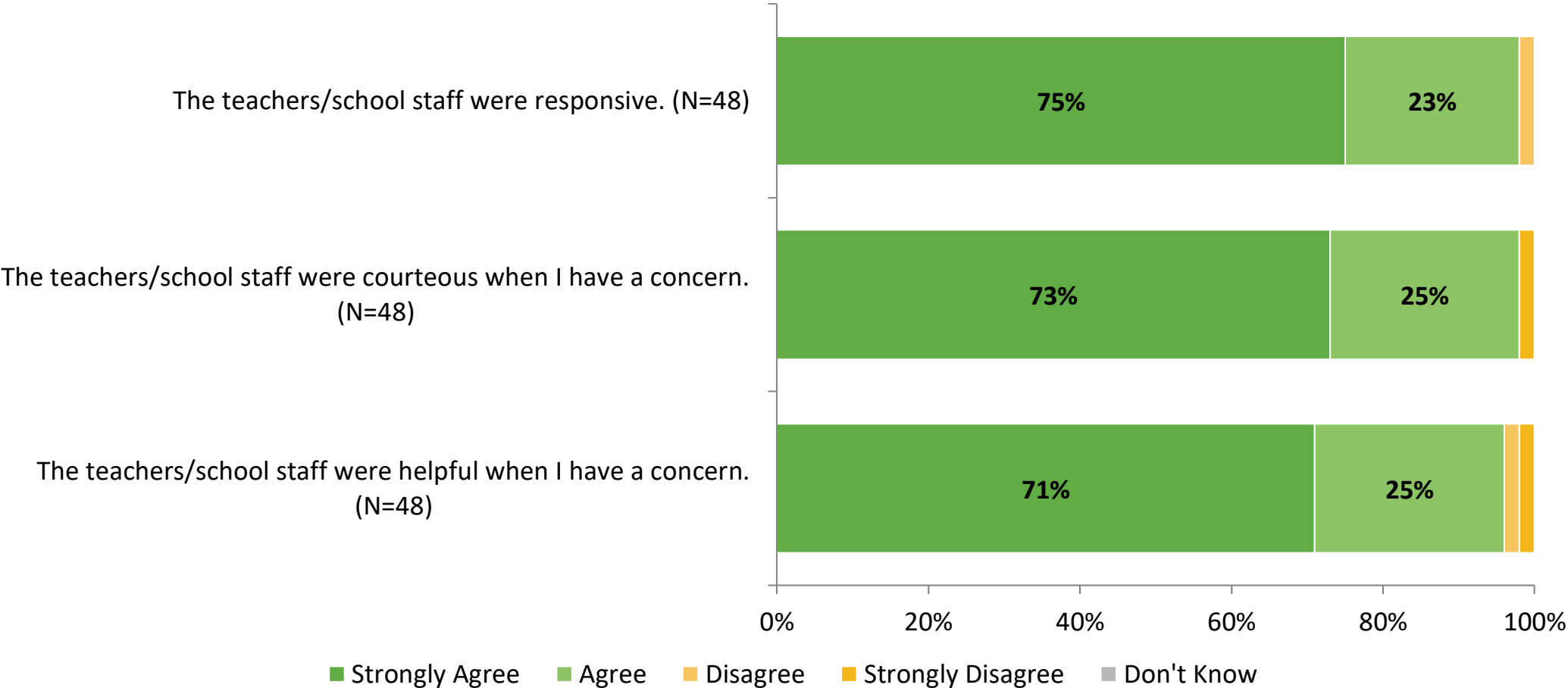

Perceptions of Communication with Teachers and School Staff

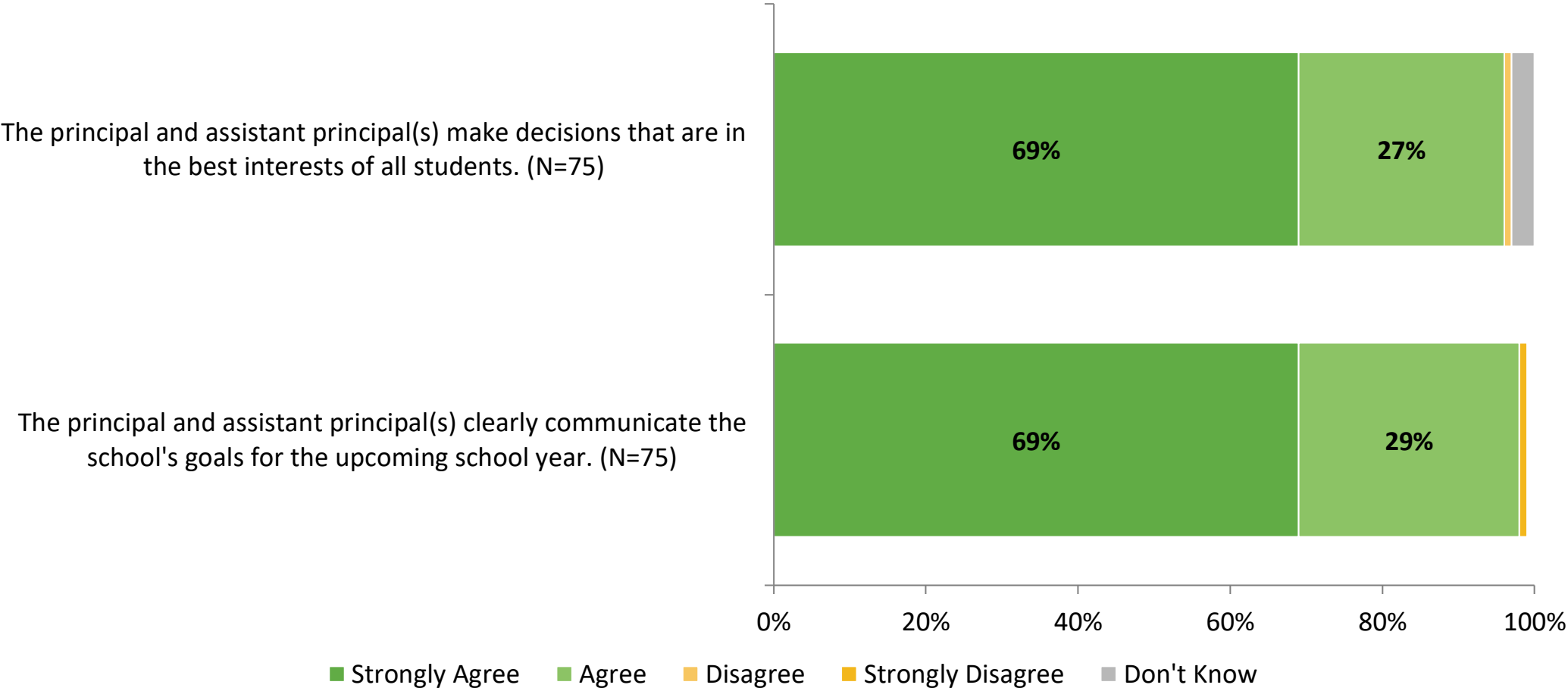

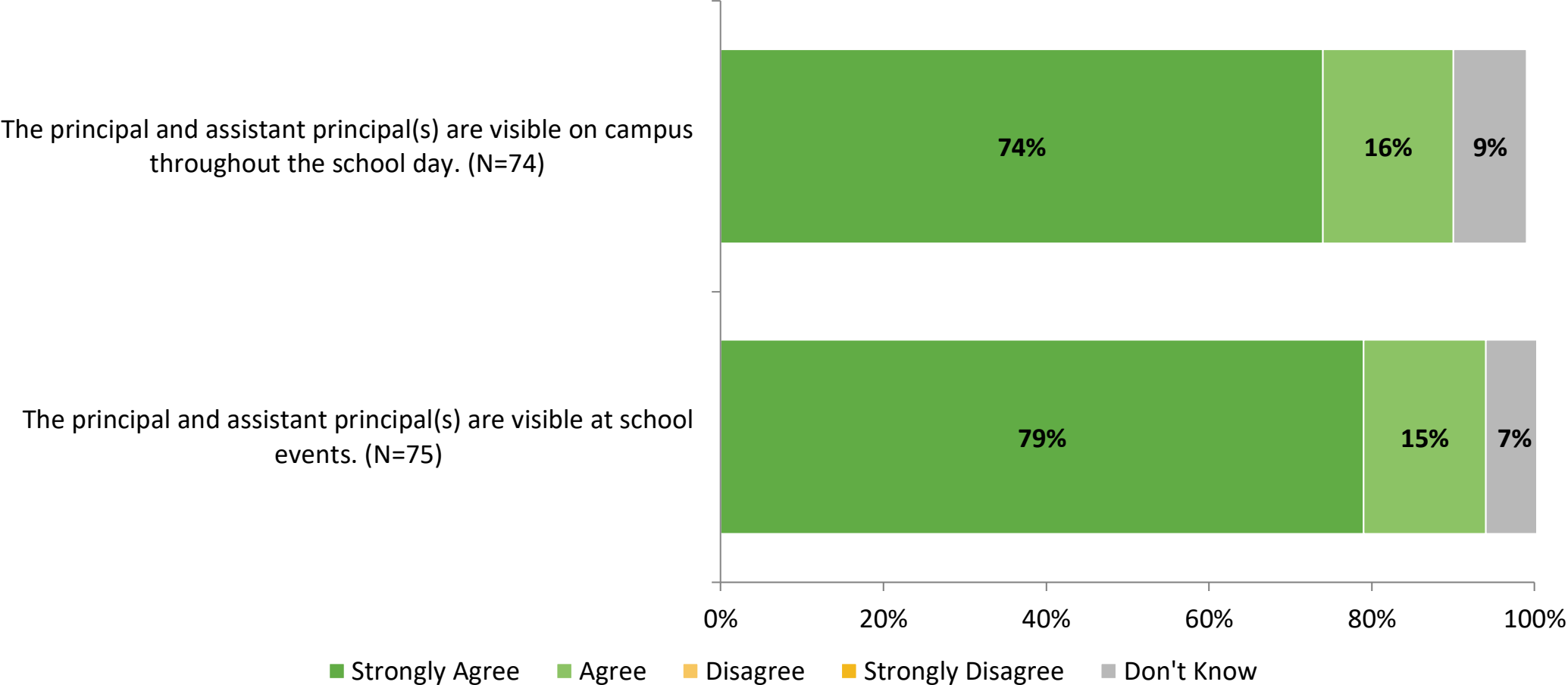

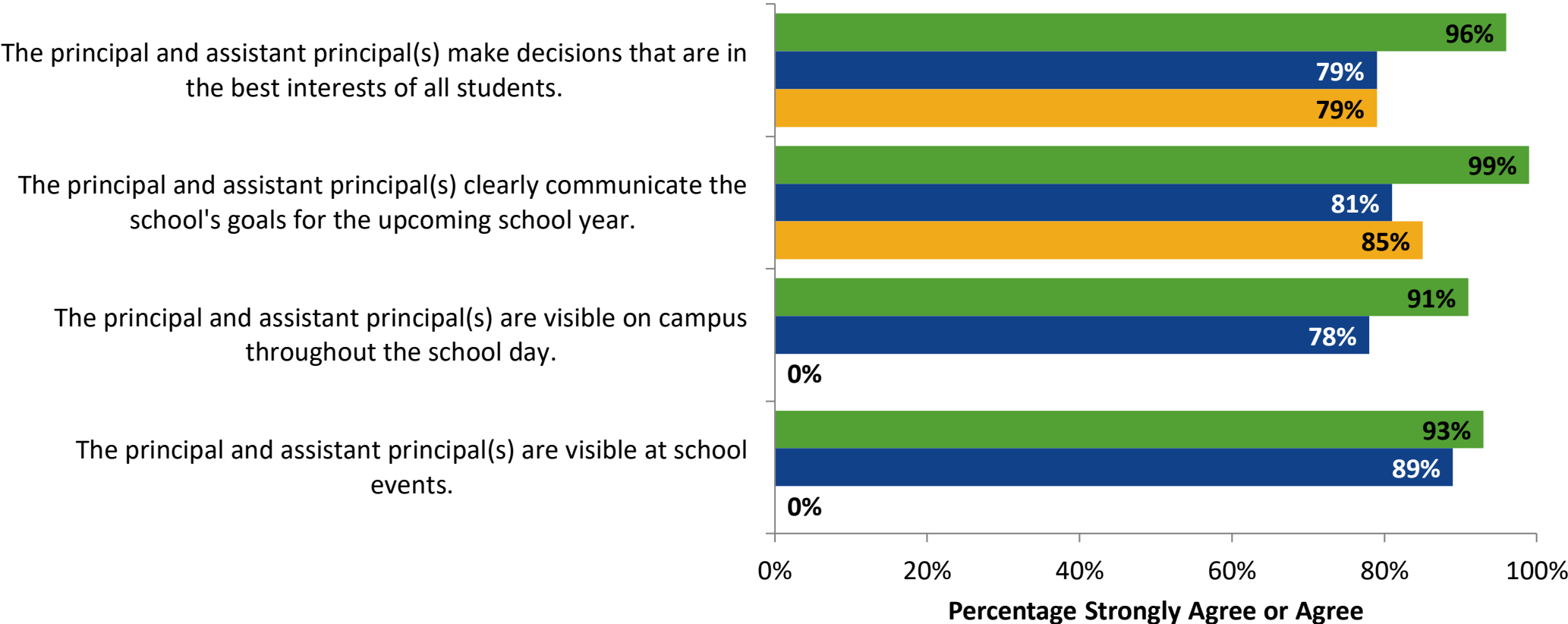

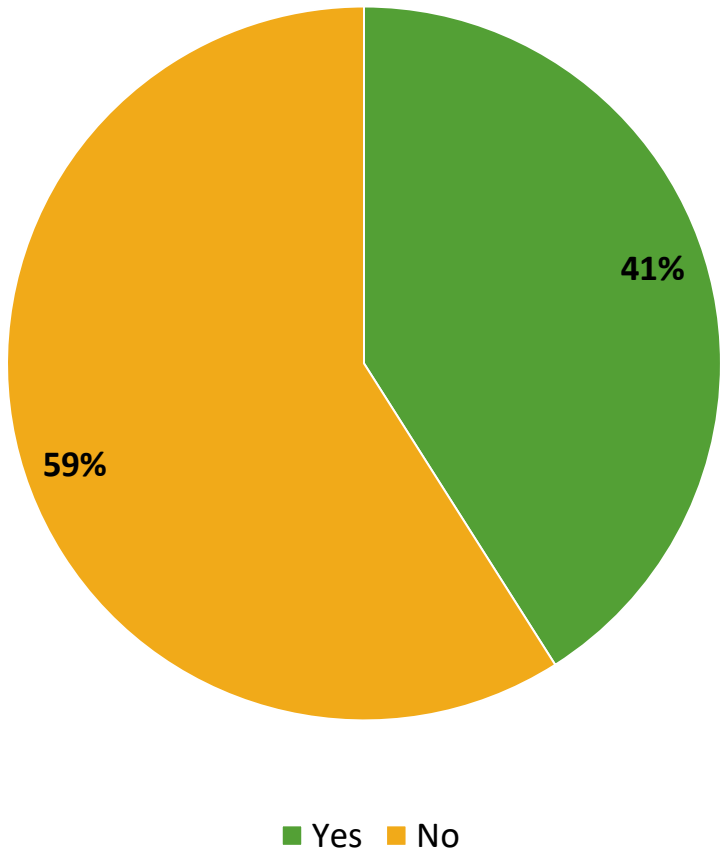

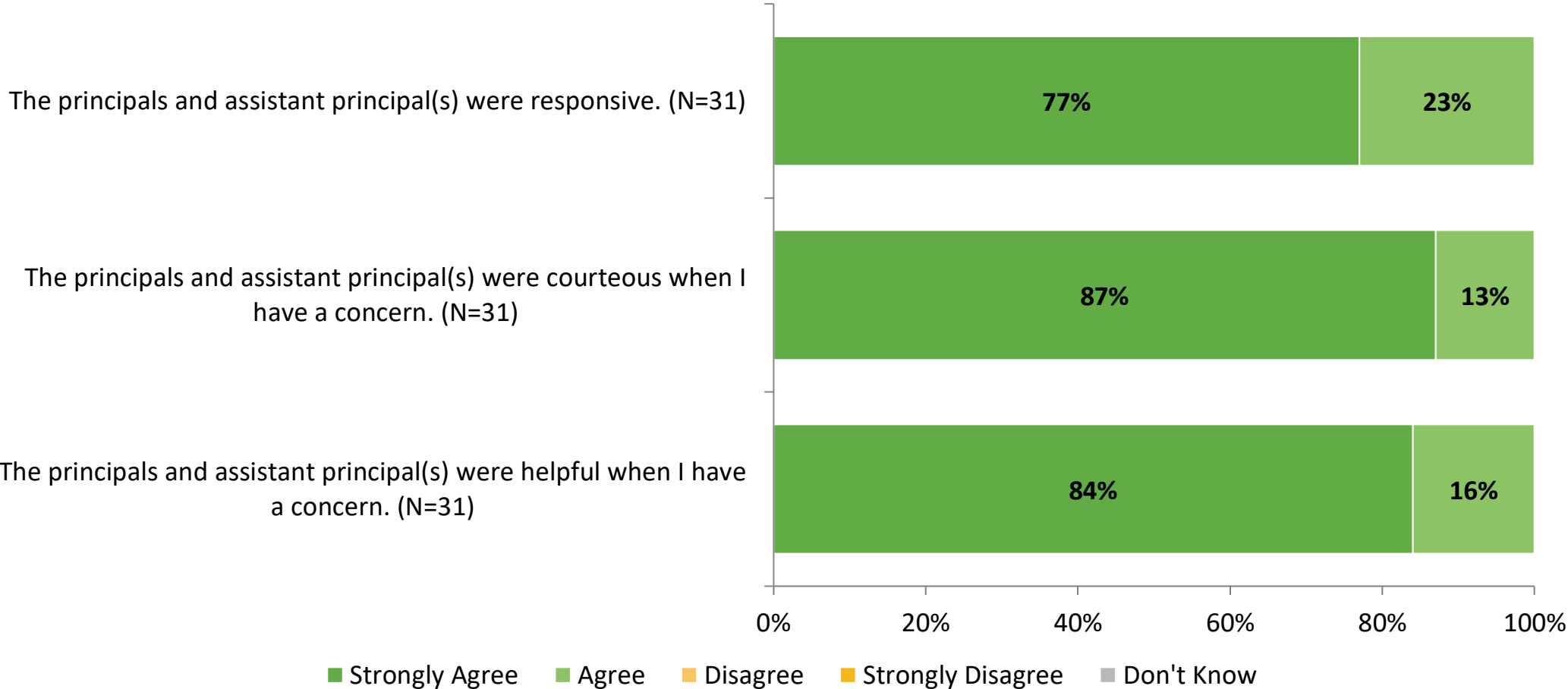

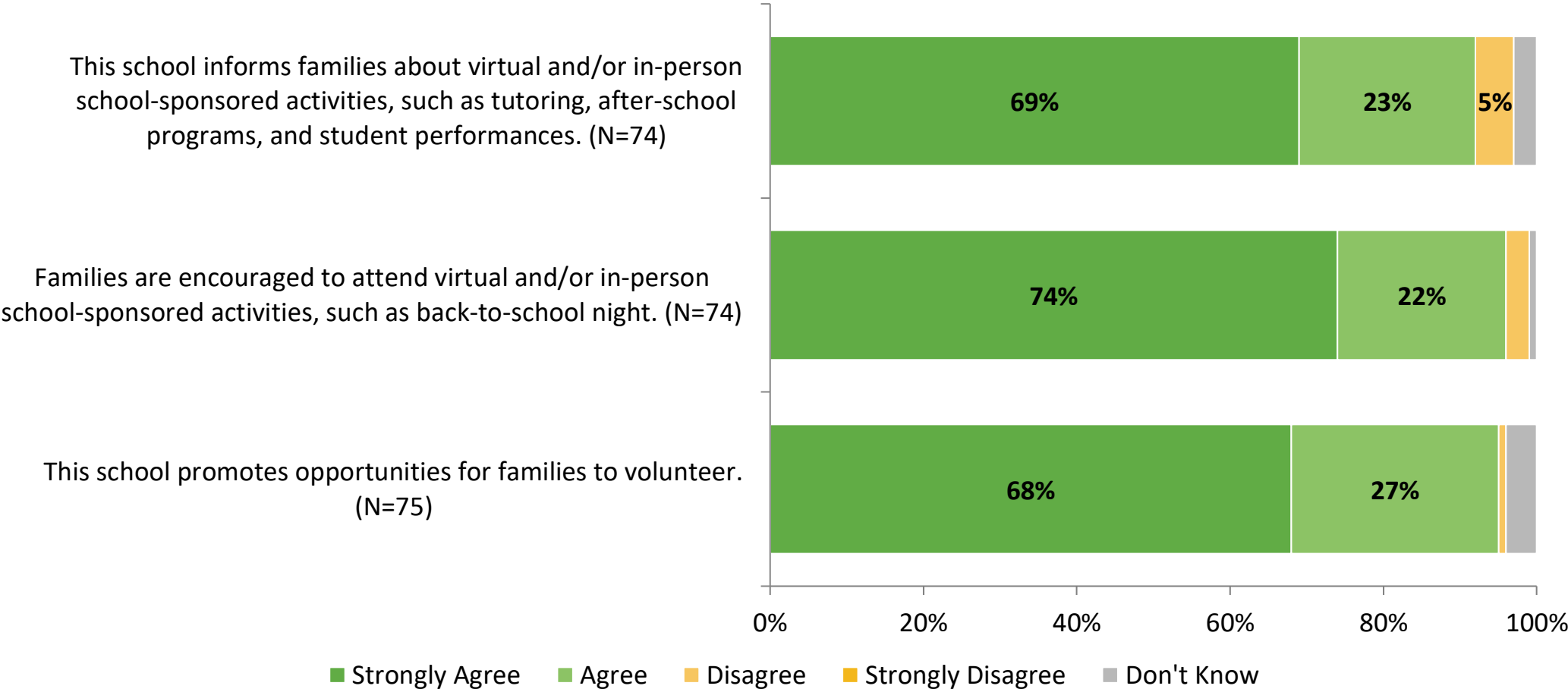

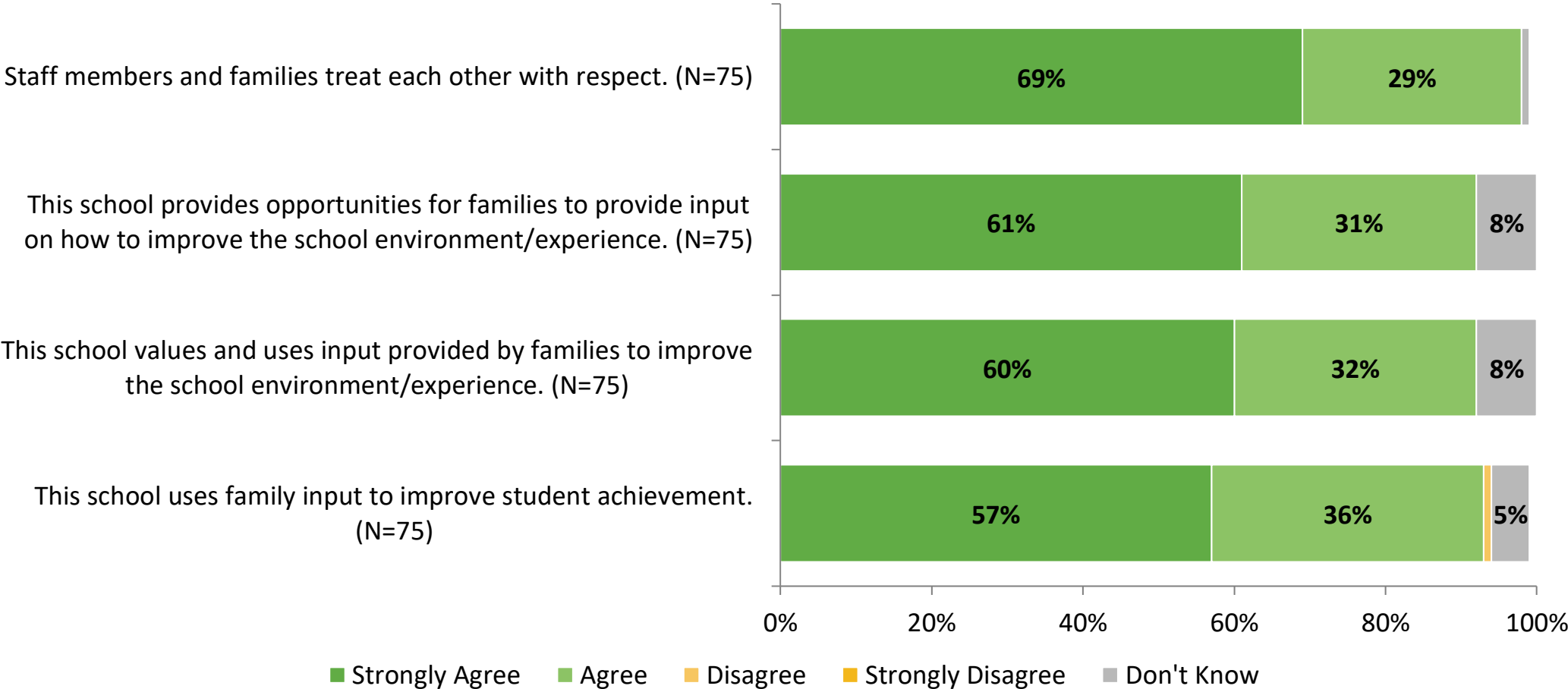

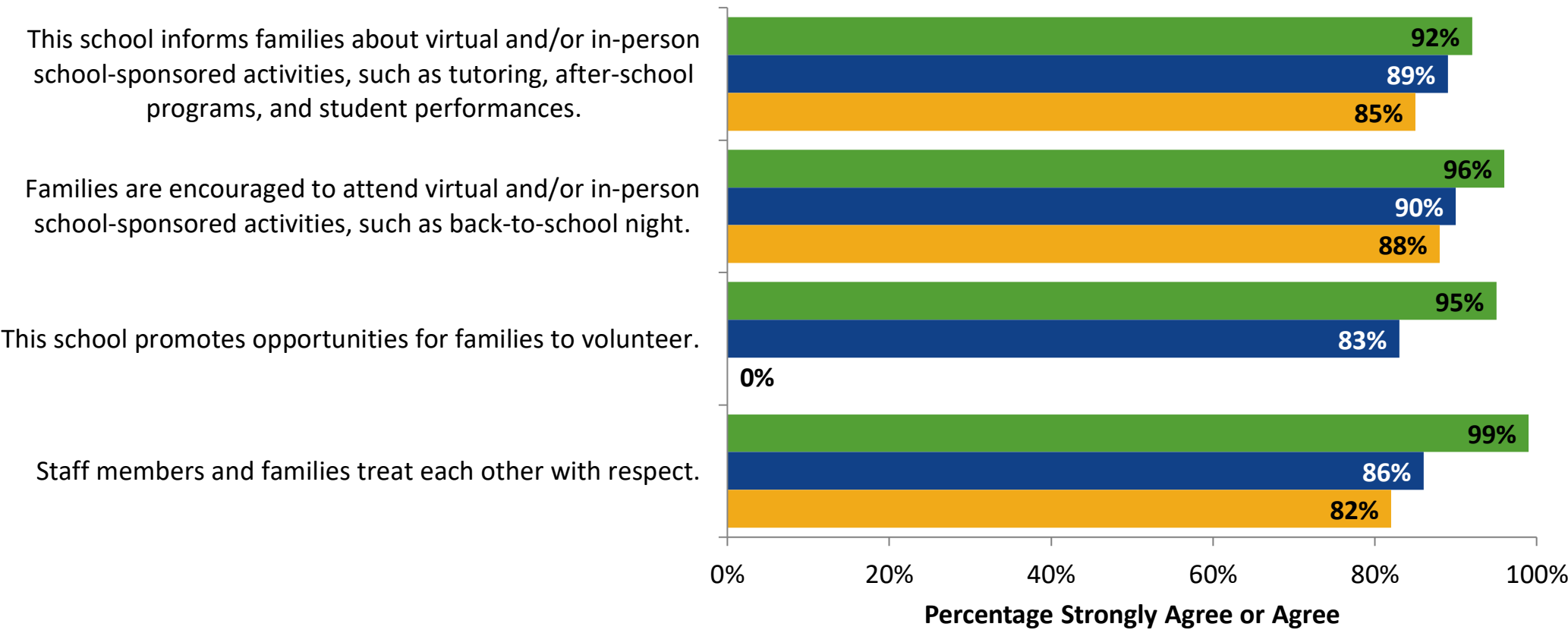

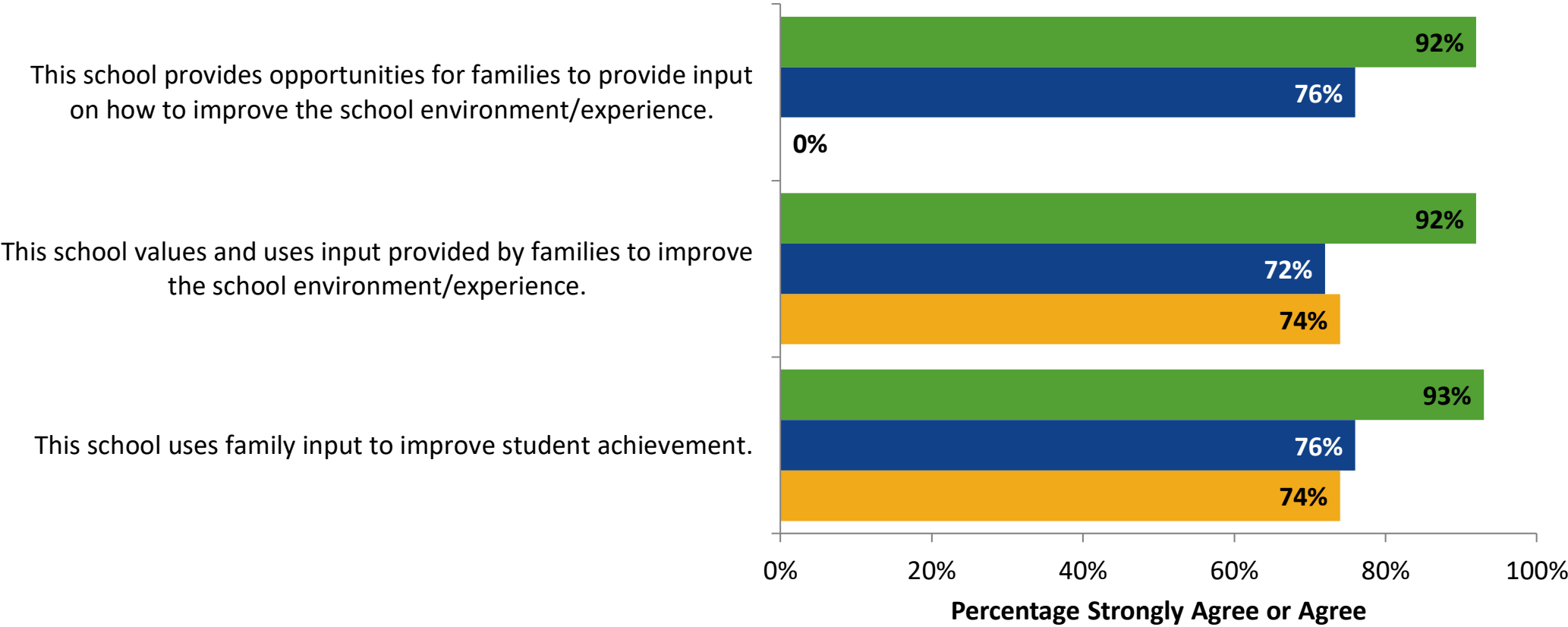

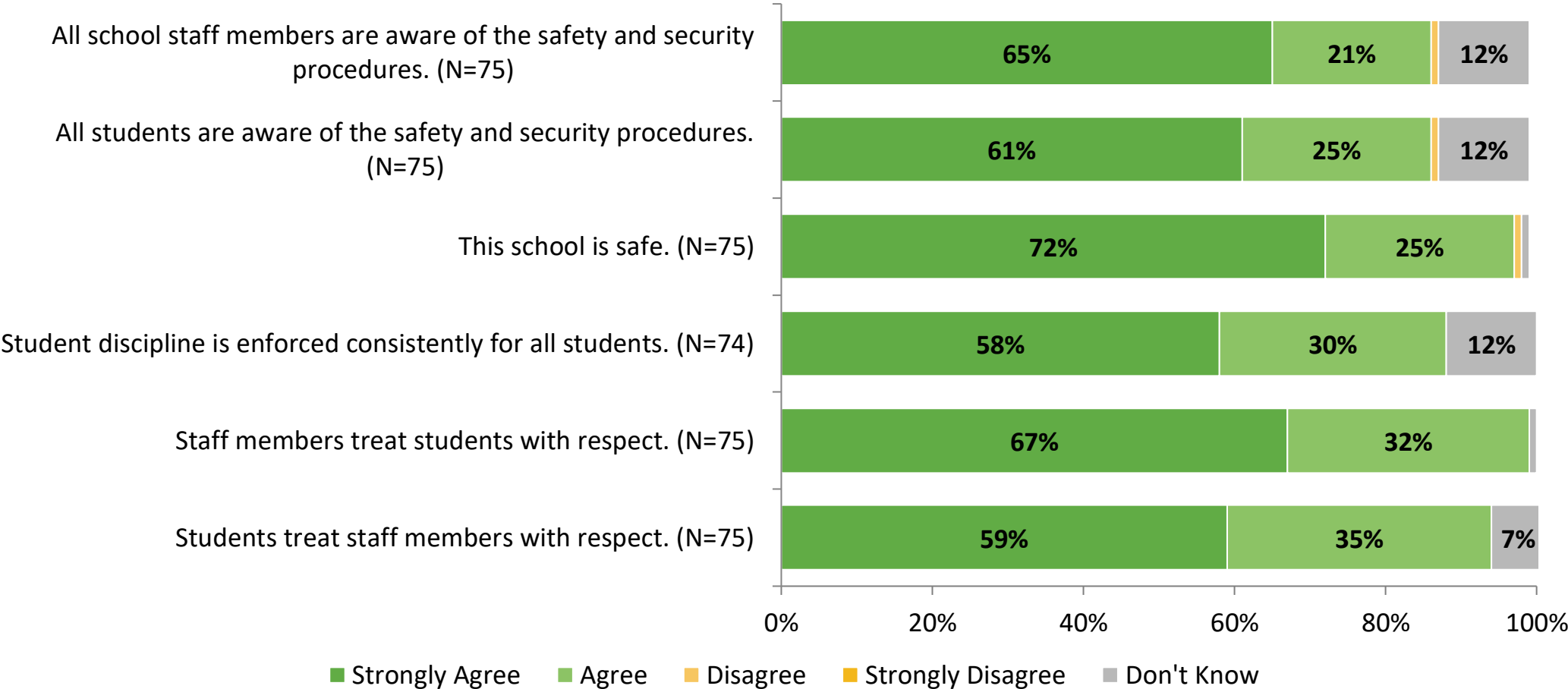

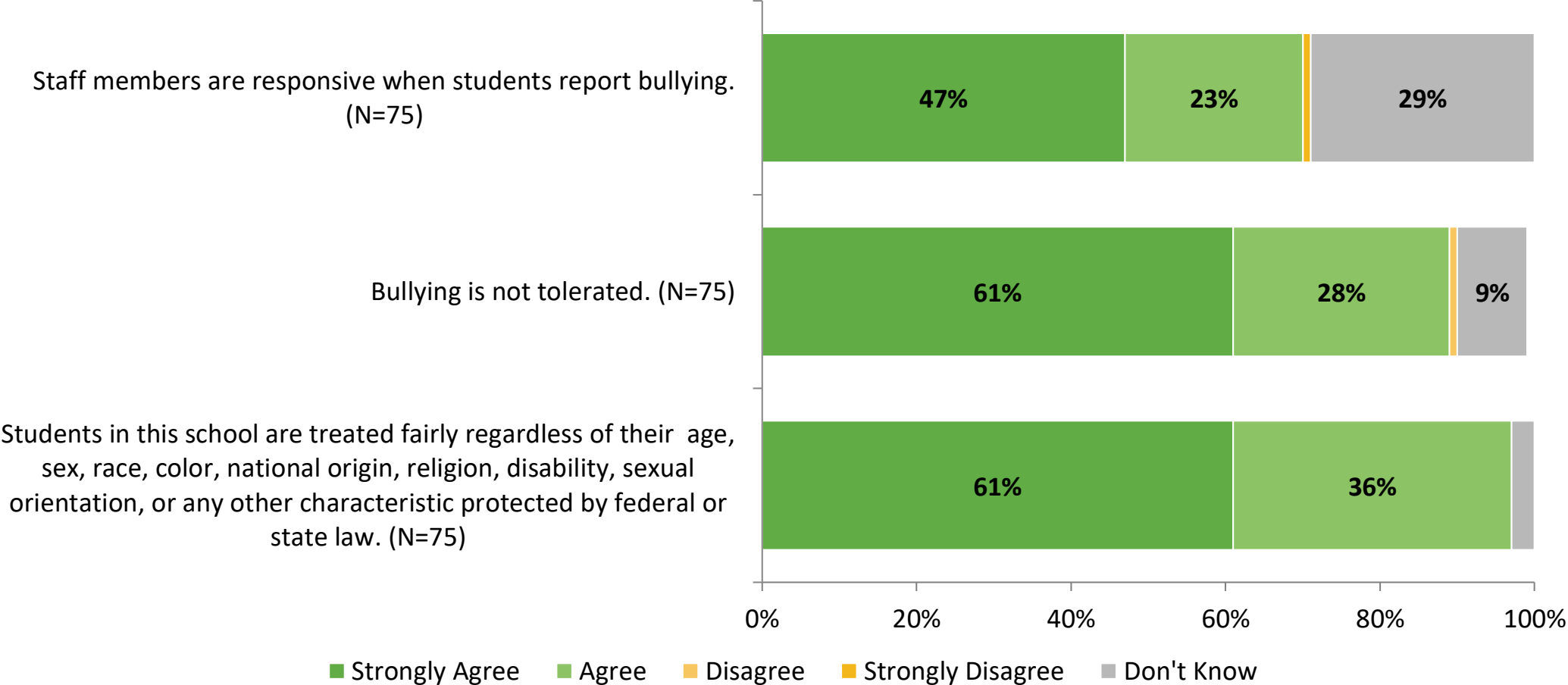

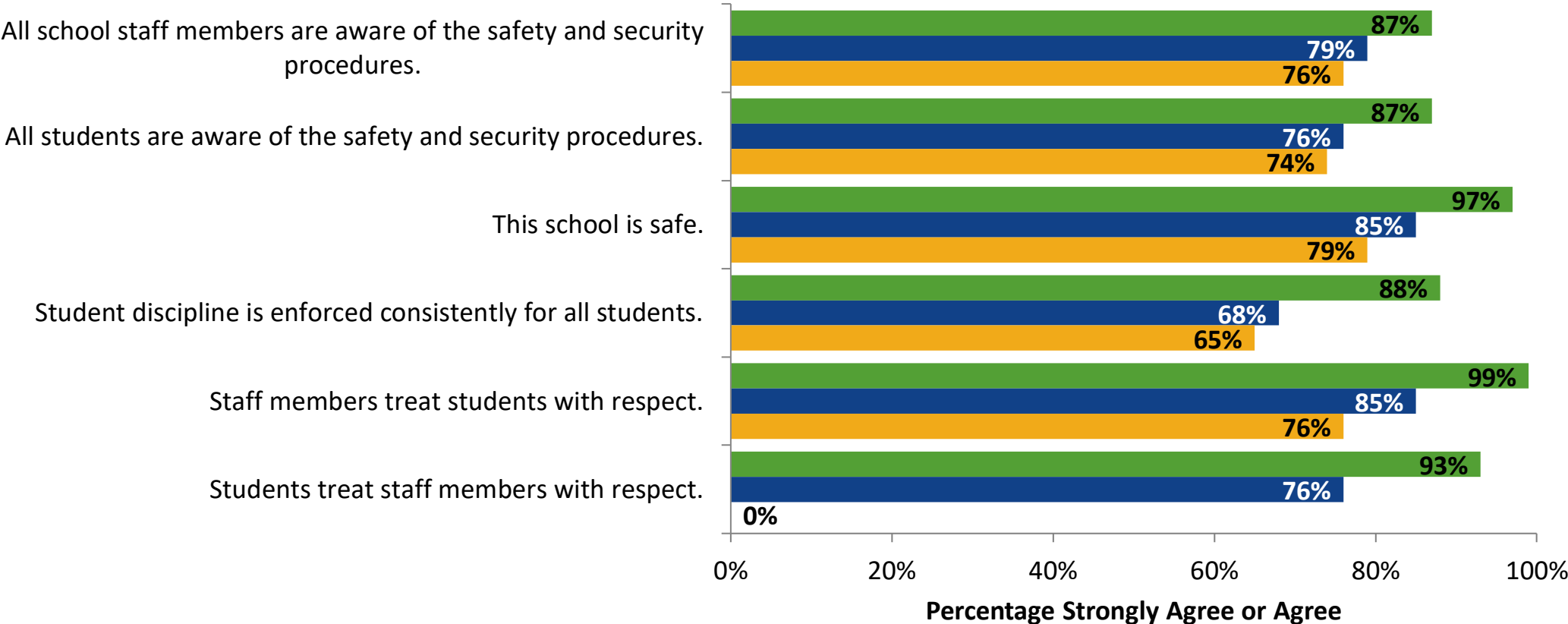

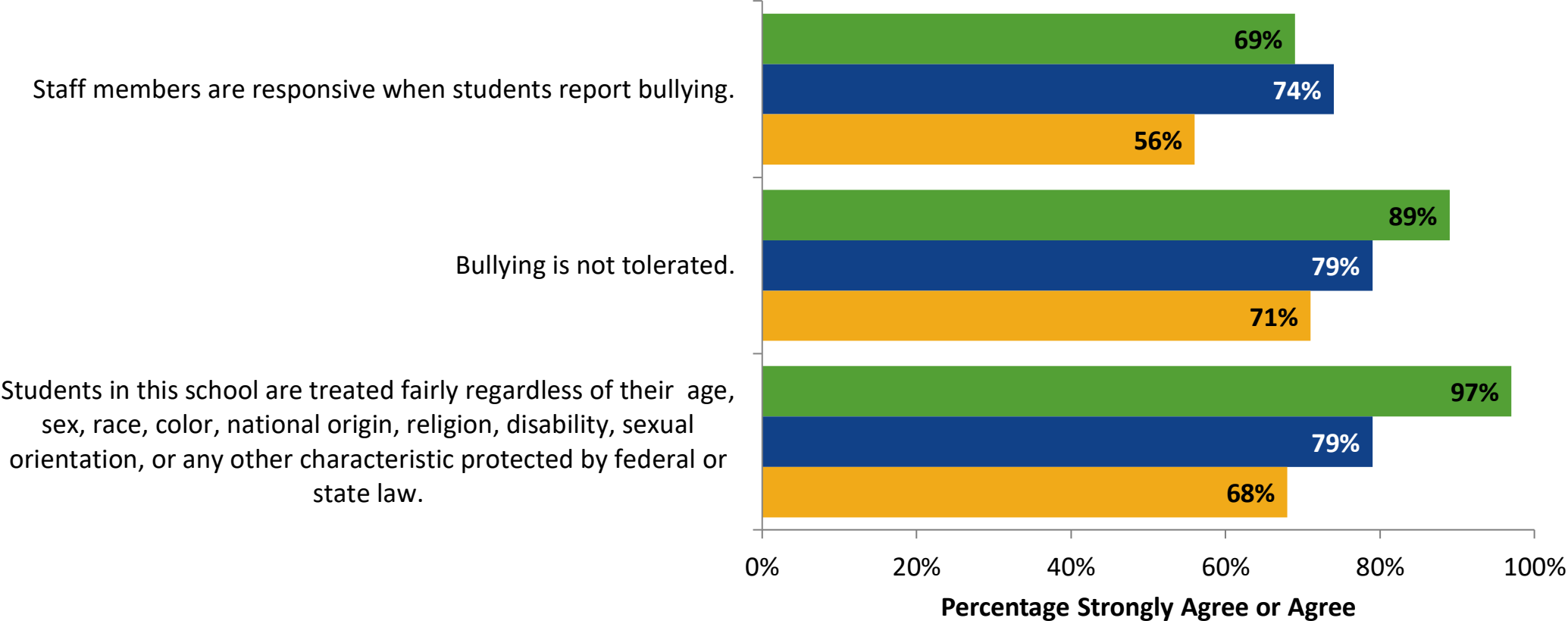

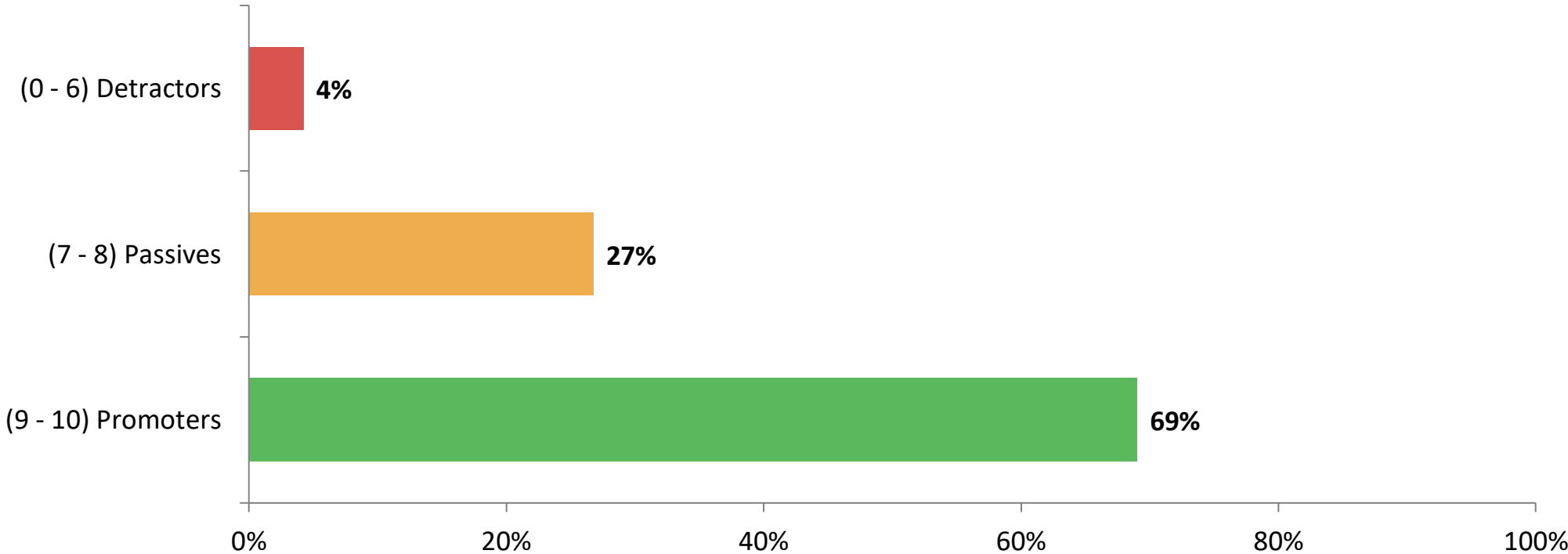

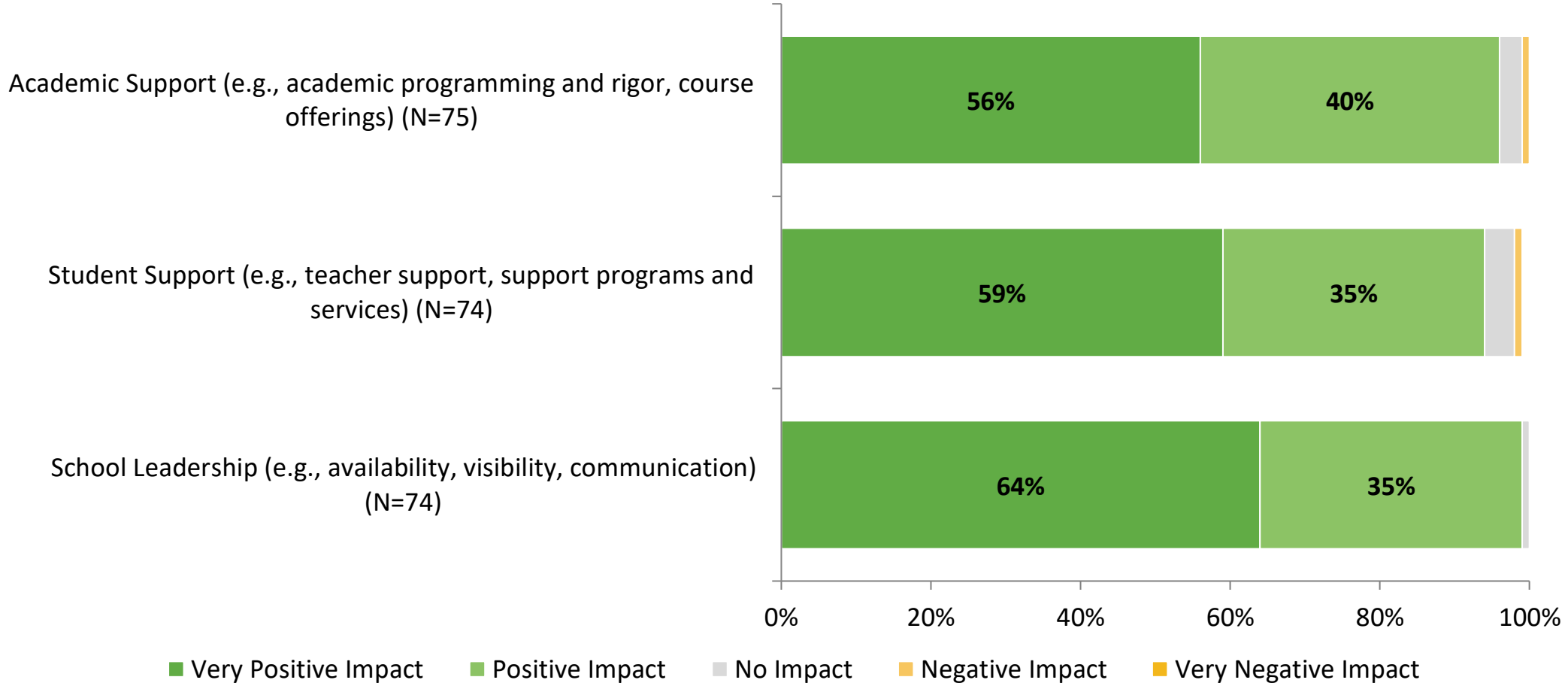
If you had a family member or friend moving to the area, how likely are you to recommend they send their child to your child's school?

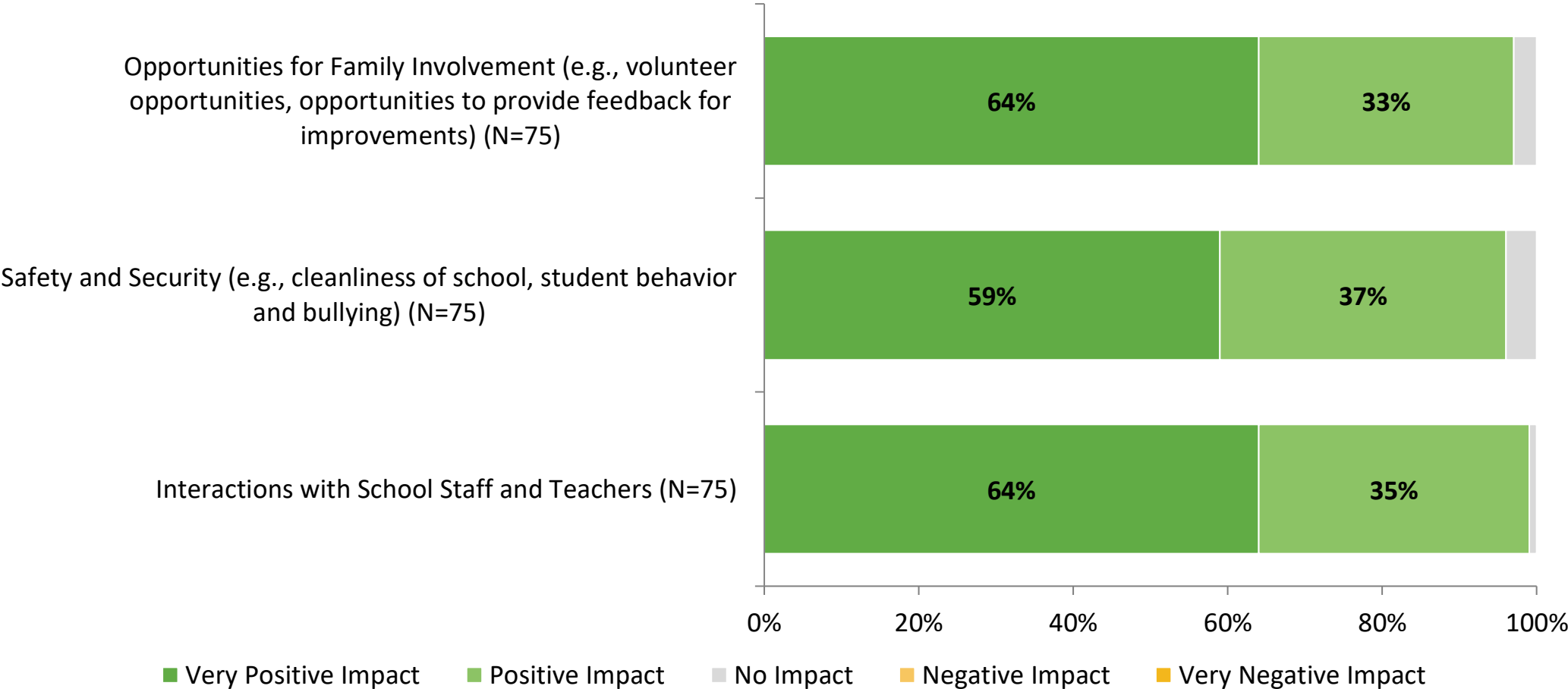

How do the following areas impact your rating of your child's school?



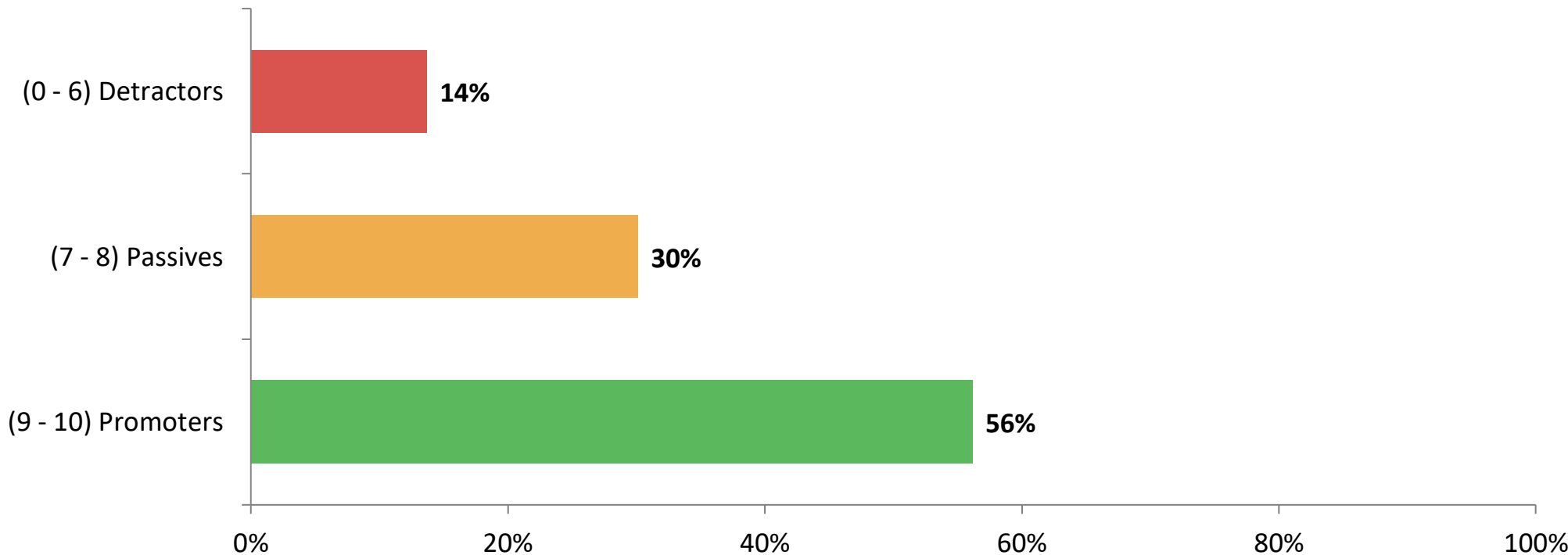

District-level Net Promoter Score

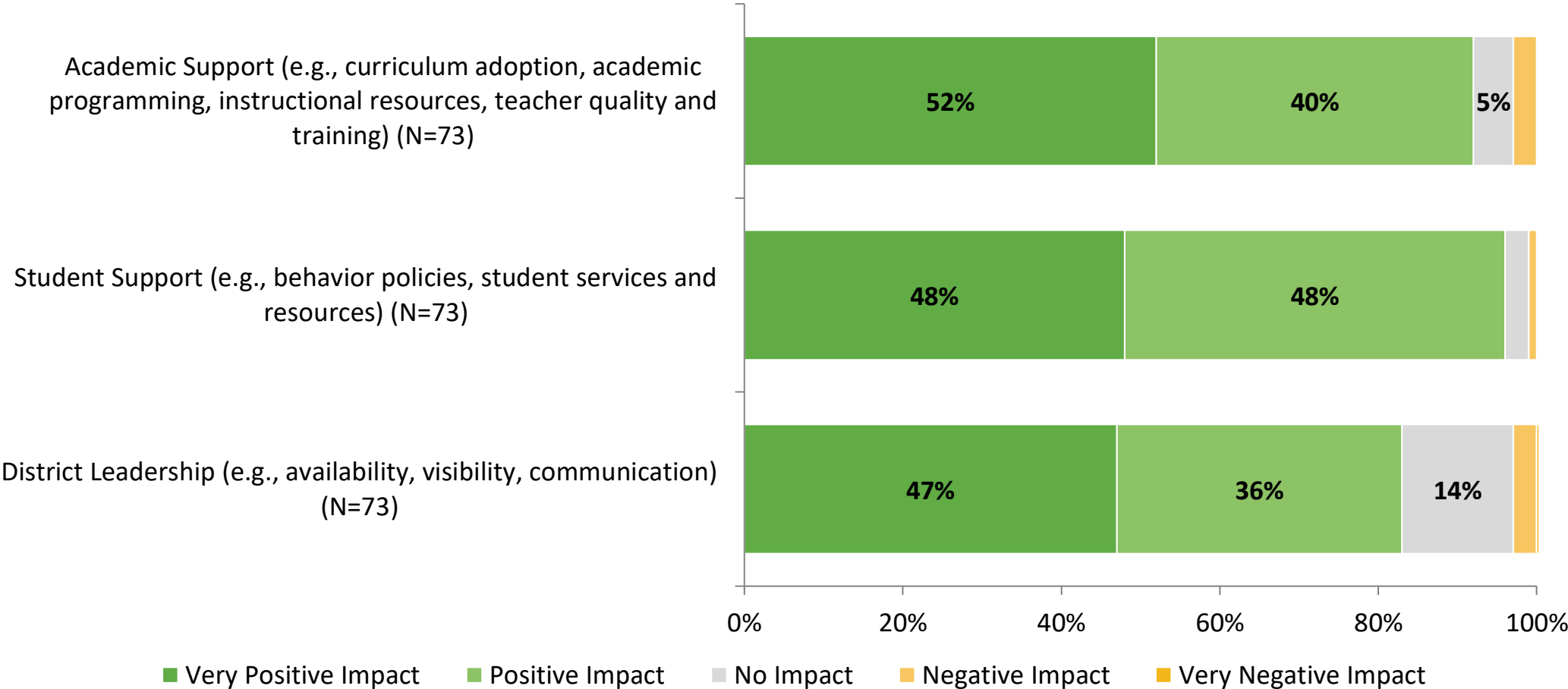
If you had a family member or friend moving to the area, how likely are you to recommend Pinellas County Schools? (N=73)

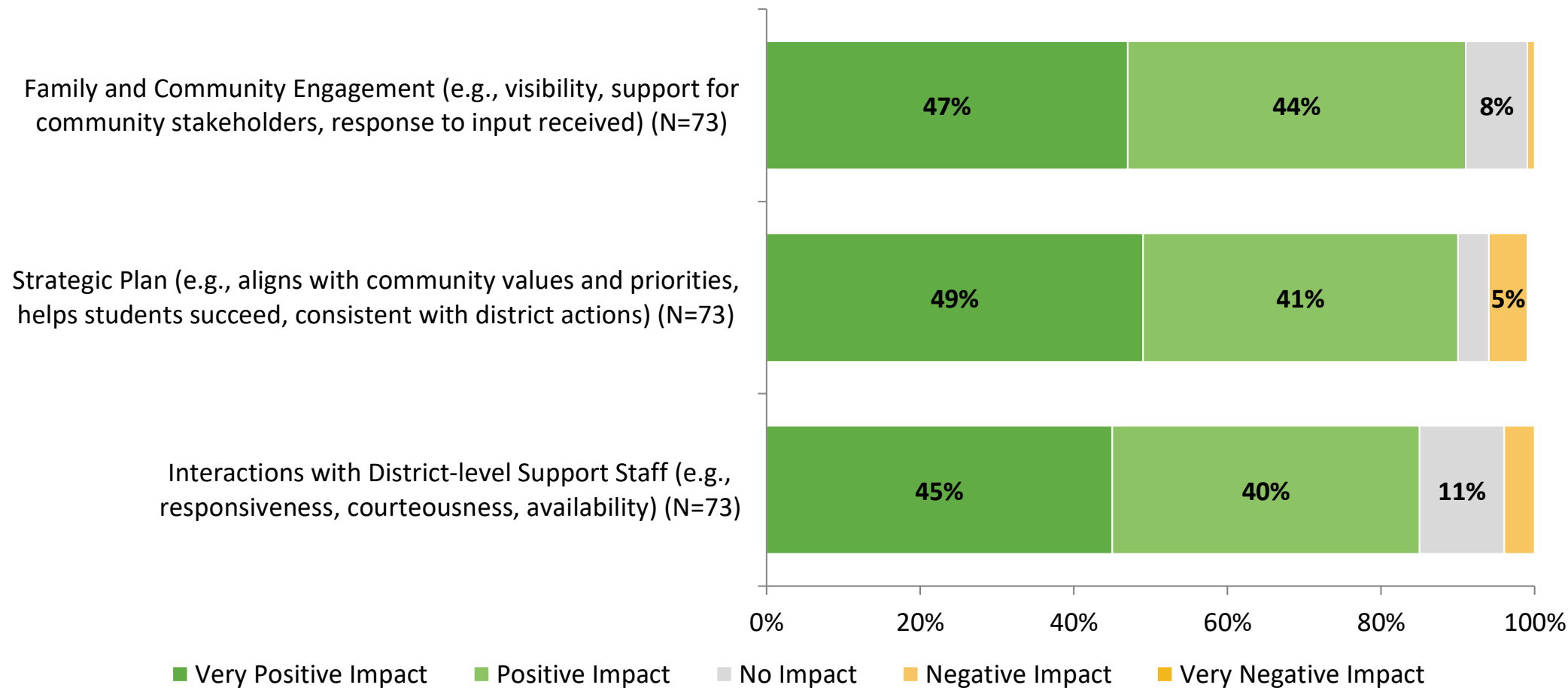
Factors Driving District NPS

How do the following areas impact your rating of Pinellas County Schools?



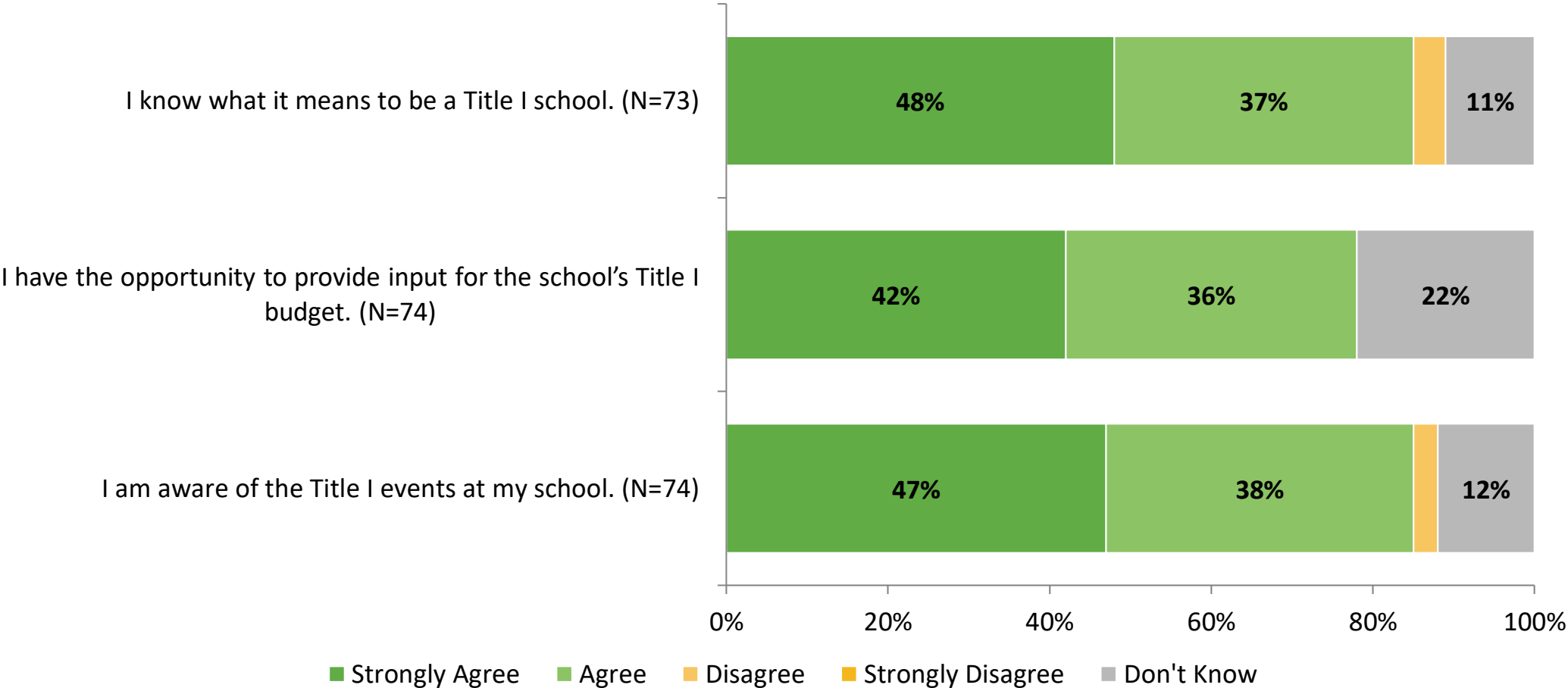

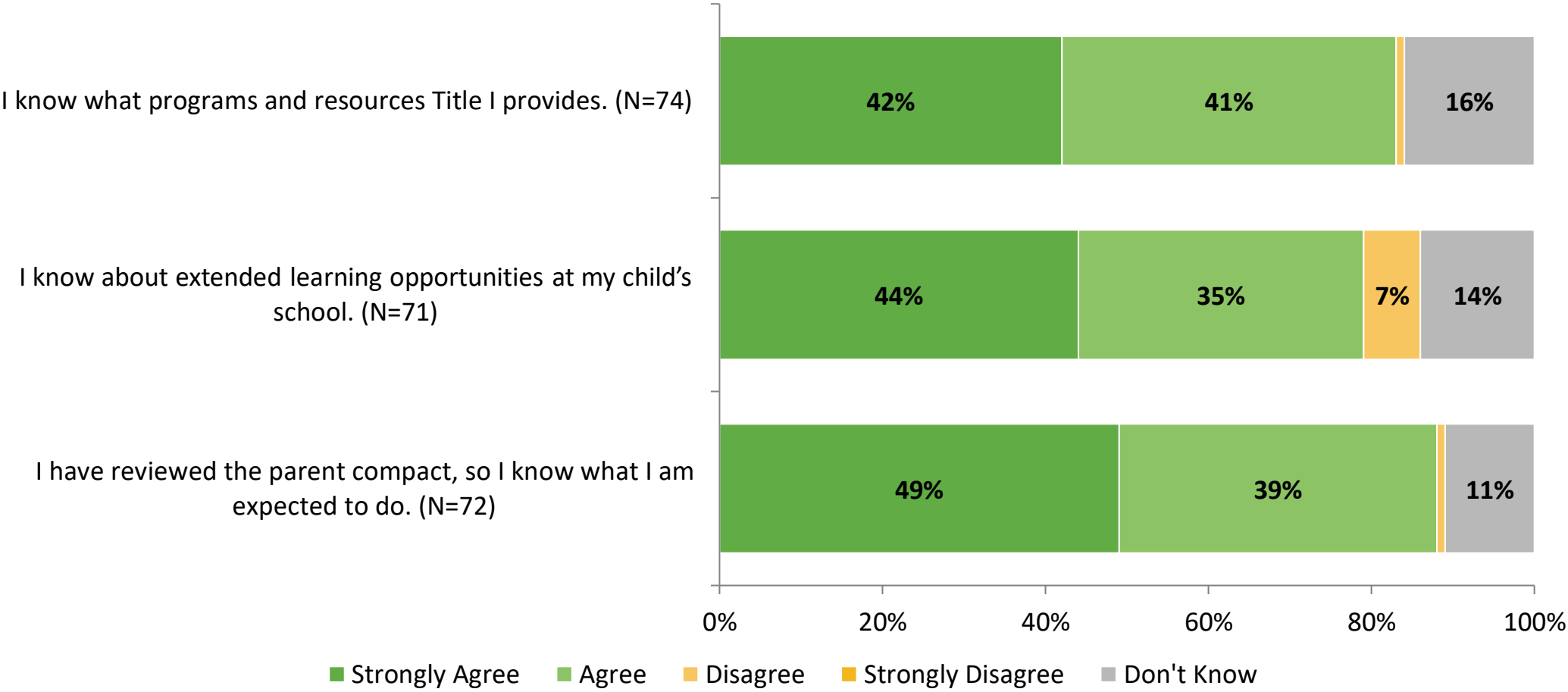

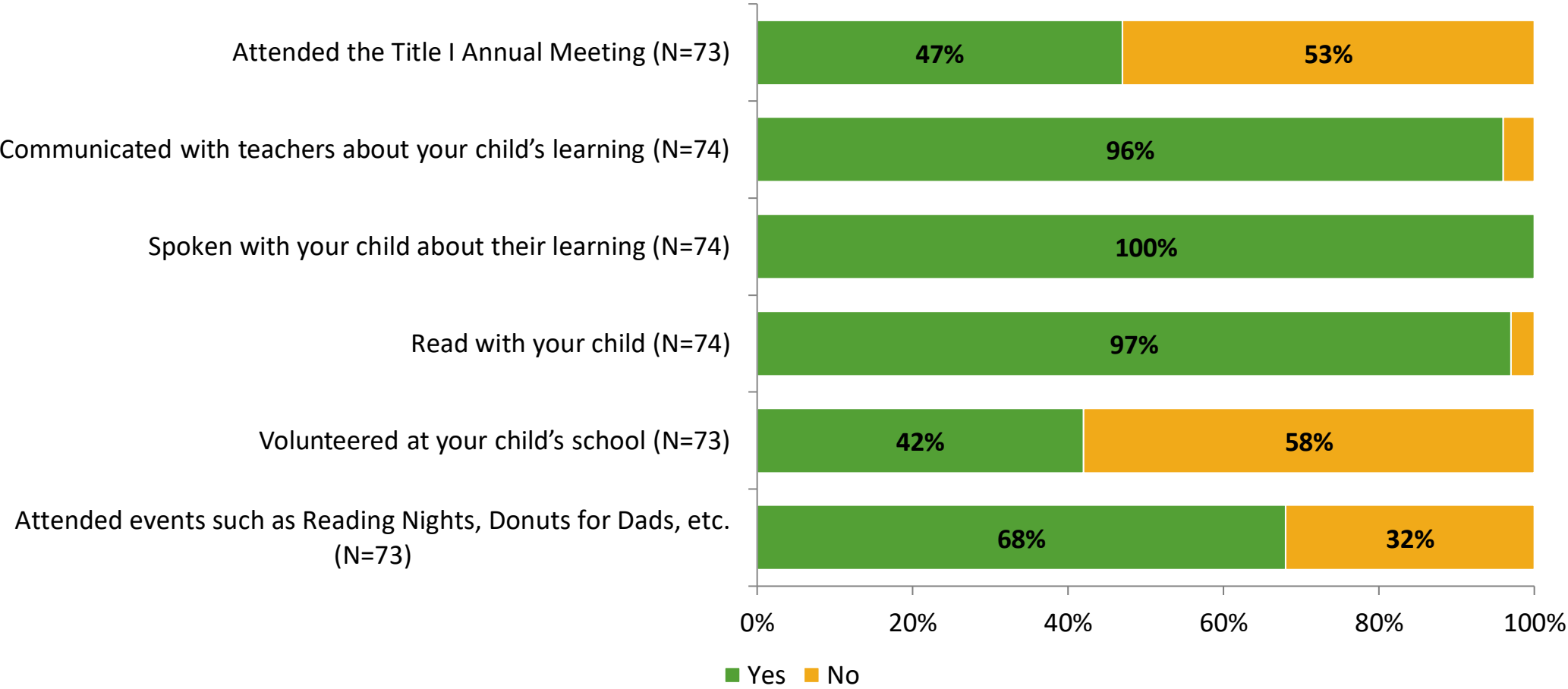

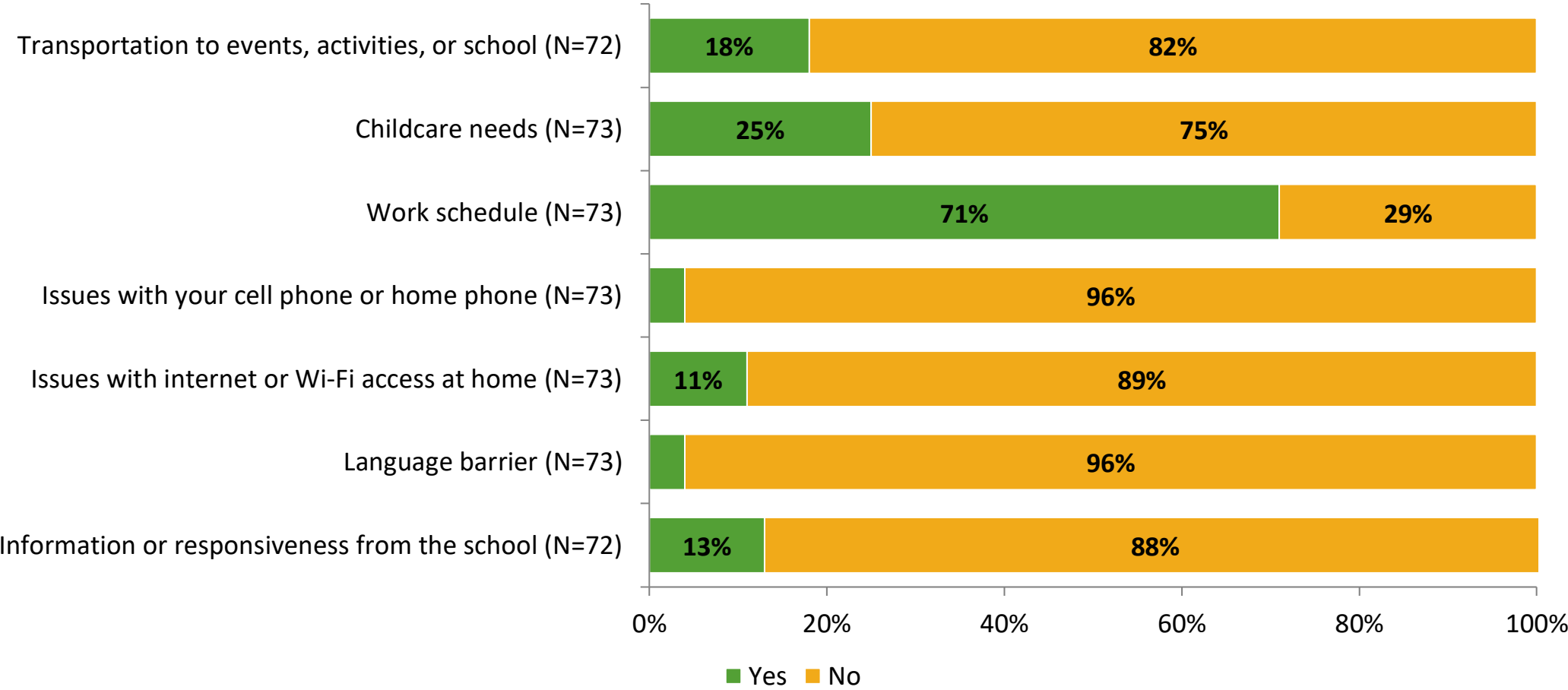
