I understand all sales are final and disqualification or cancellations may not result in a refund.

FIELD TRIP CRITERIA AND EXPECTATIONS

- ☞ Tickets are on a first come, first served basis (first 200 students with money and signed forms).
- ☞ Students who receive more than 2 detentions/ 1 referral after February 20th, 2024, will be reviewed by administration for eligibility to still attend the trip.
- ☞ Students must also have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 2.0 during the 3rd grading period.
- ☞ Students may not have more than 10 unexcused absences/tardies as of January 8, second semester.
- ☞ Students must attend and be registered at CFMS on May 10, 2024, as a normal school day in order to participate in the trip.
- ☞ Students must follow the dress code guidelines presented by CFMS and Universal Studios* during the entire trip.
- ☞ Students must meet regularly with their assigned CFMS faculty chaperone at designated times/locations.
- ☞ Students must move around the parks in groups of two or more. Students are not to travel alone.
- ☞ Parents are expected to pick up students at CFMS parking lot upon our return at 2:00 AM.
