

Hassan Jones

Hassan was a four year letterman and 3 year starter at Clearwater High. During his football career he broke the school record for total receiving yards in a season and earned all County first team honors in 1980 and 1981, State of Florida first team honors in 1980 and 1981 and All American honors in 1981. He also played basketball and was a member of the State Champion Boys Basketball team in 1981. His two year record on the varsity basketball team was 58 wins and 7 losses. He made the All Conference, All County, All state, All southern and AllAmerican teams in basketball. Hassan was named the Suncoast Player of the Year and Prep Athlete of the year in the State of Florida in 1982. He was named the Most Outstanding and Best All Around Senior Athlete at Clearwater High School in 1982

He was recruited by Florida State University to play football in 1982 as a wide receiver under Coach Bobby Bowden. At FSU he made 1st Team All American Freshman, All South Independent 1st Team and Associated Press All American Honorable Mention. He had 3 100 yard receiving games and finished my career there with 98 receptions and 1764 yards and 17 touchdowns. He graduated from FSU with a degree in Criminology.

He spent 8 seasons in the NFL as a Wide Receiver. He was drafted by the MN Vikings in 1986 where he played for 7 years and my final year in the NFL he played for the Kansas City Chiefs before retiring. His NFL stats were 229 receptions, 3,824 receiving yards and 24 touchdowns.
