Nomination Criteria

1. Athlete:

An athlete may be eligible for nomination into the CHS Athletic Hall of Fame after five years following graduation from CHS.

Athletes must meet three of the following:

- a. Holds a school record in his or her sport
- b. Selected as first team All-Conference or All Bay Area
- c. Selected as Team MVP
- d. Selected as Pinellas County Player of the Year for their sport
- e. Selected to an All-State Team (3rd team or higher)
- f. Member of a state champion team or an individual state champion
- g. Selected as a High School All American
- h. Earned a college scholarship
- i. Played a collegiate sport
- j. Drafted by a professional team
- k. Played a professional sport
- l. Brought recognition to CHS in areas other than their sport
- m. Displayed good sportsmanship

2. Coach:

The coach may be eligible for nomination after having coached at CHS and being retired from coaching for at least five years.

Coaches must meet three of the following:

- a. Served as a coach for a minimum of five years at CHS
- b. Have a positive win/loss record
- c. Coached a conference, district, regional and/or state championship team or coached an individual state qualifier
- d. Displayed good sportsmanship
- e. Brought positive recognition to CHS through accomplishments in areas other than their sport
- f. Recognized as County Coach of the Year

3. Team:

The team must meet all requirements.

- a. Must be a State Champion Team or recognized as the State Champion
- b. Eligible for nomination into the CHS Hall of Fame after five years

4. Distinguished Service:

An individual or group who has helped to develop and foster growth of athletics in the CHS athletic community. They would have displayed good sportsmanship and would have brought positive recognition to CHS.

Examples

- a. School administrators
- b. Athletic director
- c. Journalists
- d. Volunteers
- e. Team assistants

Special Nominees

1. Under unique circumstances, the Hall of Fame Committee has the ability to waive the number of years requirement and/or graduation requirement with a $\frac{2}{3}$ majority vote of the committee.
2. The following athletes, coaches, teams and sports contributors candidates shall be eligible for nomination:
 - a. Selected into a National Hall of Fame
 - b. Achieved a world record
 - c. Has participated in the Olympics, World Games, representing the United States
 - d. Played for or won an amateur national championship or professional championship on a team or as an individual
