


iReady and Elevate

What is iReady?



- iReady is an online program that provides your child with individualized reading & vocabulary lessons.
- These lessons target your child's greatest areas of need to reach grade-level reading comprehension.

## How does i-Ready know what type of lessons my child needs?



The i-Ready Diagnostic is an adaptive assessment that adjusts its questions to suit your child's needs. Each question that a student sees is individualized based on his/her answer to the previous question.

\* For example: a series of correct answers will result in slightly harder questions a series of incorrect answers will yield slightly easier questions

At the end of the Diagnostic, your child's overall reading level is revealed as a 3-digit number.

Students also receive individual scores for their vocabulary, for their comprehension of informational text, and for their comprehension of literature. The purpose of the i-Ready Diagnostic is to determine the best way to support your child's learning in the classroom.

When do students take the Diagnostic?




Students in all Reading classes take the iReady Diagnostic 3 times per year

Diagnostic 1- Taken in August 2022

Diagnostic 2- January 2023 (after our return from Winter Break)

Diagnostic 3- April/May 2023

# Supporting your child during the Diagnostic



Students who meet their i-Ready Diagnostic "stretch growth goal" and score a Level 3 on the FAST will be removed from Reading at the end of the school year.

This will provide your child with the opportunity to take an additional elective of his/her choice.

## Assessment

The best way to meet the i-Ready "stretch growth goal" is to practice and to complete i-Ready computer lessons.

Teacher-led small group in your child's Reading class provides him/her with the reading skills and the strategies that can be applied when taking the FAST.

#### **Typical Growth**


Typical Growth: The average annual growth for a student at this grade and placement level on their baseline Diagnostic. (i)

Stretch Growth: An ambitious, but attainable, level of annual growth that puts students who are below grade level on a path toward proficiency.


# Stretch Goal

You and your student can monitor progress by clicking on **My Progress** in the bottom navigation bar.



### On the My Progress page, you will be able to see:

- Time-On-Task: The number of minutes your student has spent this week (Monday–Sunday) on i-Ready Personalized Instruction
- Lessons Passed: The total number of lessons your student has passed this school year
- Lesson Streak: How many lessons your student has passed in a row
- Completed Work: The name and quiz score for each lesson your student has taken



## How do I log in?

## On an iPad®:

- Download the free i-Ready Connect<sup>™</sup> for Students
   app from the App Store®. iPad must be compatible
   with iOS® 13 or above, such as the iPad Air® 2, iPad Air 3
   (2019), iPad 5th Generation (2017), or iPad Pro®.
- If your student's district/school:
  - Uses Clever®, download the Clever app, log in using their district's/school's portal credentials, and click on the i-Ready icon
  - Uses a portal that is NOT Clever, students should open the Safari® browser, enter their district's/school's portal URL and log in, and click on the i-Ready icon
  - Does not use a portal, they should open the
     i-Ready Connect for Students app and log in to i-Ready
     using the credentials provided by their teacher(s)

# From a Computer:

- If your student's district/school:
  - Uses a portal, your student should log in using their district's/school's portal credentials and then click on the i-Ready icon
  - Does NOT use a portal, your student should visit <u>i-ReadyConnect.com</u> and log in to *i-Ready* directly on a computer using the credentials provided by their teacher(s)
