The Basics

- Follow CHARGE expectations. Set the example!
- Begin arriving on campus at 8:15.
- Pick your student up on time for dismissal.
- Inform the office when you have a new phone number or new address.
- Partner/support the school. We are all on the same team!



The Basics

- Ensure your student is engaging in learning. Be willing to support when needed.

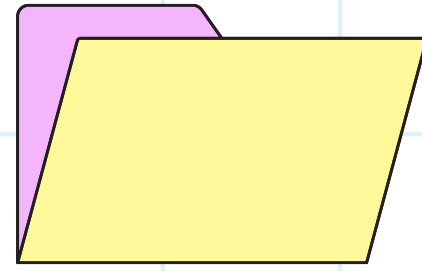
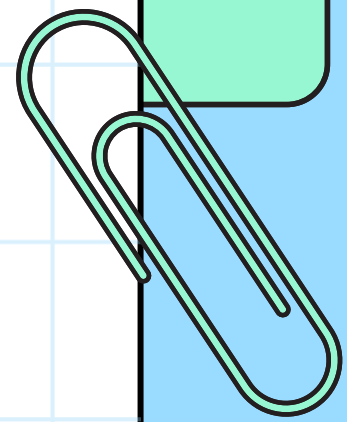
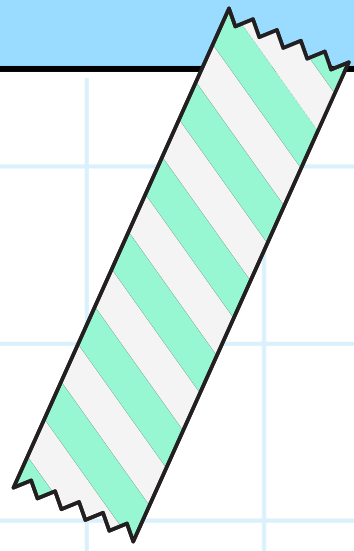
PCE ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY

ALL electronic devices are to be turned off and put away while on campus, unless contacting home after dismissal bell regarding transportation.

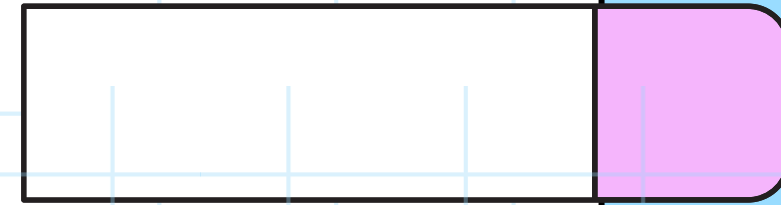
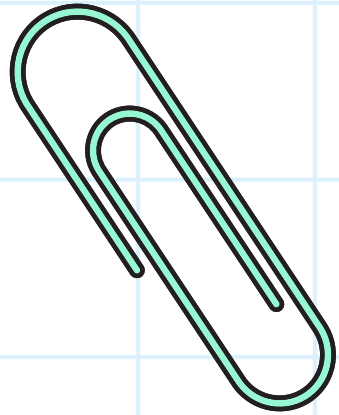
Permission must be given from staff.

5. Progressive discipline if violation continues.

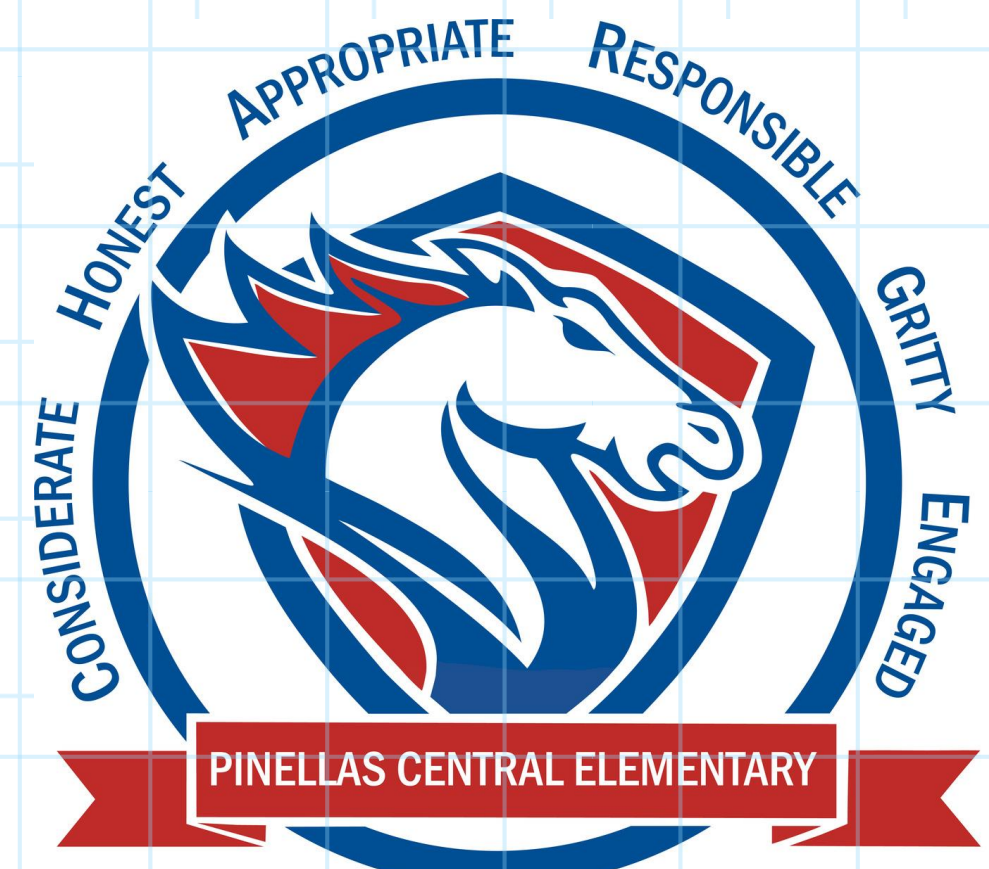
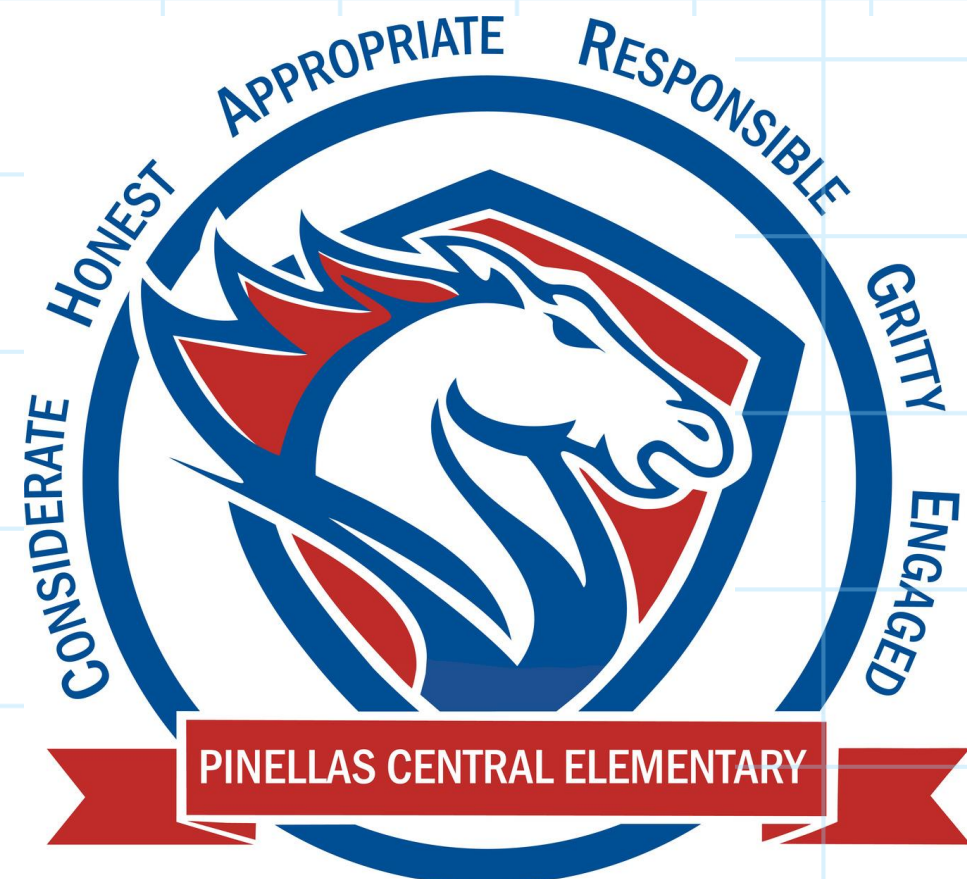
