#### School-Wide Instructional Focus

BCHS will increase <u>rigor</u> school-wide by enhancing academic discourse and planning engaging, standards-aligned instruction within the new 48-minute period.



#### 1. Plan for Academic Discourse

- Utilize Costa's Level of Thinking to generate Higher Order Thinking (HOT) questions for structured student talk routines and writing across subjects.
- Utilize AVID WICOR strategies to explicitly teach academic vocabulary and scaffold instruction to the appropriate level of rigor in standards.

#### 2. Implement "Sailing for 48 Minutes" Lesson Plan Framework

- Timely and relative bell-work tasks
- Parts of the lesson body Content Delivery, Extension of Learning and Differentiation
- Wrap-up activities that reinforce learning targets

#### 3. Conduct Regular PLC's and Instructional Walkthroughs

- Plan for HOT questions and academic discourse during weekly PLCs.
- Conduct walkthroughs utilizing Domain 1 of the Marzano Evaluation Form to monitor the implementation of academic discourse and lesson planning.
