The Selection Committee for this solicitation met March 31, 2023, for the purpose of shortlisting a minimum of (3) Construction Firms for Construction Management services of the Seminole High School Remodel project.

Of the original (10) applicant firms, (4) firms were shortlisted and invited to interview with the Committee. Those interviews were conducted on April 28, 2023. At the conclusion of the interviews of the shortlisted firms, (2) of the shortlisted firms were tied in the final scoring. The Districts policy for resolving tied bids gives preference to firms based in Pinellas County. One of the two companies was based in Hillsborough County. The following firm is based in Pinellas County and is recommended for award.
