The 2020-2021 SPC tuition rate for Florida residents is \$122.70 per credit for upper division (3000/4000 level) courses and \$111.75 for lower division (1000/2000 level) courses. Approximate cost for a 3 credit on campus course is \$366. Online classes have an additional lab fee of \$15 per credit hour and all courses have a \$3 per credit access fee. Fees are charged per credit, per semester.
