SHORE ACRES ELEMENTARY SIP 2013-14 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Shore Acres Elementary School has 802 students grades Prek to 5th, two administrators, 57 teachers, and 10 staff members. The mission of Shore Acres Elementary is to provide a rigorous educational program to prepare students to be lifelong learners and productive citizens.

To accomplish this mission, Shore Acres has 5 Goals:

- 1) 77% of our students will receive a Level 3 or above on the Reading FCAT.
- 2) 90% of our students will receive a Level 3.5 or above on the Writing FCAT.
- 3) 74% of our students will receive a Level 3 or above on the Math FCAT.
- 4) 67% of our 5th Grade students will meet or exceed expectations on the Science FCAT.
- 5) 100% of our Black/Afric.Am students reach the identified AMO Target from each subject area goal.

The core instructional strategies included in our action plans are: Teachers will participate in PLCs that will evaluate data and formative assessments to determine instructional needs. Monthly PLCs will focus on subject area strategies derived in a lesson study format, targeting specific areas in the Common Core Standards that will yield gains for all students.

The professional development efforts include the use of the Leading the Learning Cadre, the Literacy Team and the Literacy Coach. This professional development will increase the understanding and implementation of identified skills in each content area.

The parent involvement efforts will continue since Shore Acres Elementary has great parent involvement with monthly after school and evening activities for the parents to get involved in. Most evening parent events had an average of 200 parents in attendance.
