<b>QUALIFICATIONS:</b> High School Diploma or possession of GED and experience in automotive body painting and repair work. Must possess and maintain a valid Florida Class "B" Commercial Driver's License (CDL) to include "air brake" and "passenger" qualifications. Must possess or obtain within one hundred and twenty (120) days of hire, and maintain, any DEP or EPA certifications as required by local, state and federal regulations.
<b>MAJOR FUNCTION</b>
Performs work in the repair, conditioning and painting of automotive and bus bodies, cabs, fenders, and other auto parts using specialized tools. General instructions regarding jobs are given, allowing considerable latitude for planning and implementation of assignments. Work is reviewed during progress and at completion by a superior.
<b>ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rebuilds, replaces and repairs automotive, bus, trucks and construction equipment bodies, grills and frames.</li> <li>• Removes dents and straightens door panels, quarter panels, fenders and hoods with hammer and fender irons.</li> <li>• Straightens frames and wheels with presses and other equipment.</li> <li>• Cleans, sands, masks and brushes or spray paints automotive and equipment, including trucks, cars, road rollers, compressors and other construction and maintenance equipment.</li> <li>• Welds breaks and fractures in sheet metal and frames; does lettering and numbering on vehicles and equipment; installs accessory equipment.</li> <li>• Applies knowledge of tools, materials, methods and practices used in auto body repair and painting trade.</li> <li>• Uses and maintains hand and power tools of the trade; mixes and matches paints, lacquers and enamels; estimates time and material.</li> <li>• Locates and corrects structural defects in automotive equipment.</li> <li>• Utilizes welding machines to replace parts.</li> <li>• Refinishes vehicles to prepare for painting.</li> <li>• Works on interior and exterior of all related vehicles.</li> <li>• Maintains timely and accurate information regarding inventory records of assigned vehicle service needed.</li> <li>• Attends safety and other related training to keep abreast of current technology relevant to this trade.</li> <li>• Responds to work order requests to repair vehicles and equipment in a timely and thorough manner.</li> <li>• Performs other related duties as assigned.</li> </ul>
