QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from high school or possession of a GED, plus four (4) years progressively responsible work experience in the roofing trade. The successful completion of up to two (2) years of verifiable formal training in the trade (vocational, military or indentured apprentice school) may be substituted for a like amount of the experience requirement. Possession of a valid state of Florida Class “E” non-commercial driver’s license.
MAJOR FUNCTION
Performs lead, skilled journeyman level work involving application and repair of various types of roofing. Leads assigned team members and is responsible for satisfactory completion of tasks. Work is performed under general direction with much independence and is reviewed upon completion for conformity with established standards.
ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Leads and trains assigned team members; applies alternate layers of roofing paper, hot tar and coal tar to a surface of gravel to build up a roof surface; sets flashing and expansion joints; cuts roofing paper, asphalt shingles and other roofing materials to fit roof corners, pipes, etc. Uses asphalt and commercial compounds on overlapping joints; applies and fastens tile, terra cotta and materials of roofs. Lays out and applies wooden shingles to roof sheathing; rigs and erects scaffolding. Inspects and determines leaks on all types of roofs; estimates costs, repairs needed and necessary materials; works from blueprints and sketches. Lifts objects and works at high elevations on a routine basis. Applies thorough knowledge of standard practices, methods, processes, materials, machines and tools of the trade, use of scaffolding, as well as occupational hazards and safety precautions. Performs other related duties as assigned.
