QUALIFICATIONS:

High School Diploma or possession of a GED. Two years' experience working with K-12 students. Five (5) or more years licensed driving experience and an excellent driving record. Must possess and maintain a valid Florida class "E" driver's license. Must hold a current State Medical Examiner's Certificate issued by a Pinellas County School Board-approved physician. Must pass drug test and state-mandated dexterity test. Must satisfactorily complete eight (8) hours of district preservice instruction and behind-the-wheel training before transporting students. Valid and current American Red Cross Adult and Pediatric First Aid/Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)/Automated External Defibrillator (AED).

MAJOR FUNCTION

Responsible for the safe and efficient delivery of students to and from schools or other destinations in accordance with the laws of the state of Florida, rules of the State Board of Education, and procedures of the Pinellas County School Board. This position includes working with exceptional education students. Must be flexible, able to adjust hours and geographic area according to immediate needs, and willing to assist on any route. Must be able to operate any non-CDL vehicle used by the district for transporting students, including but not limited to, Multipurpose passenger vehicles, Passenger Cars, Type A School Buses, etc.

ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Follows a designated route and an established time schedule while picking up and dropping off students at specific locations on a route.
- Observes all state, city and local traffic laws and regulations along with the District Safe Driver Plan, uses all signals, and ensures that all traffic is stopped before loading and unloading students.
- Instructs students on proper safety methods to load and unload from the assigned vehicle and sees that instructions are carefully followed.
- Maintains order on vehicle at all times and stops any disruptive behavior by following district policies, procedures and protocols.
- Reports to the school principal repeated/serious misconduct on the part of any student while in the vehicle or under the driver's immediate supervision.
- Reports bullying or harassing students to the proper authorities immediately.
- Attends and participates in all required department training, safety sessions and employee meetings.
- Must be flexible and able to adjust work hours based on daily needs.
- Must be willing to work in any geographic area within the county based on daily needs.
- Must be willing to ride the school bus as an assistant from your assigned compounds as needed.
- Performs daily pre-trip inspection of assigned vehicle and reports any defect affecting safety or economy of operation immediately to supervisor.
- Performs post-trip inspection and checks the assigned vehicle after the morning and afternoon runs are complete to ensure no student or non-essential equipment remains onboard.
- Performs student checks at each school in the morning and afternoon.
- Reports all accidents immediately to the appropriate Transportation official.
- Ensures assigned vehicle meets regular maintenance schedule and report mechanical or safety equipment failure, malfunction or discrepancy with the vehicle to the vehicle maintenance department.

- Completes various forms and records, including, but not limited to, update route sheets, time sheets, field trip forms, incident reports and accident reports.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.
