High School Diploma or possession of a GED. Five (5) years or more experience as a Bus Driver. Must possess and maintain a valid Florida Class "B" commercial driver's license with passenger and school bus endorsements. Must hold a current State Medical Examiner's Certificate issued by a Pinellas County School Board-approved physician. Must satisfactorily complete the School Bus Driver Trainer Certification Course conducted by the State Department of Education within one (1) year of being placed in the position. Must satisfactorily complete the CDL Third Party Examiner Certification Course administered by the Florida Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles within six (6) months after being placed in the position.

MAJOR FUNCTION

Develop a safe and effective driver workforce and efficient pupil transport system through applicable training programs.

ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Maintains oversight of Transportation Instructors.
- Organizes, plans and implements training projects to successful completion.
- Communicates effectively with a variety of audiences, orally and in writing.
- Organizes, prioritizes, and manages work assignments.
- Establishes and maintains collaborative working relationships with all stakeholders.
- Trains new school bus drivers for the Pinellas County Schools Transportation Department in accordance with the requirements of the Florida Department of Education Basic School Bus Driver Training Curriculum.
- Prepares school bus driver trainees to take the on-the-road driving examinations required to obtain a commercial driver's license (CDL) and administers the CDL Skill Tests to trainees in accordance with procedures and requirements of the Florida Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles.
- Conducts training of current school bus drivers for annual re-certification to transport students as required by the Florida Department of Education.
- Conducts training for current school bus drivers when it has been determined they have been involved in an atfault/preventable vehicle accident/crash, in accordance with the requirements of the Pinellas County School Board's Safe Driver Plan.
- Performs "check rides" with all current school bus drivers to monitor driving skills and proficiency.
- Conducts training to correct deficiencies noted through the "check ride" process.
- Transports students to and from public schools and facilities during periods of driver shortages, and performs all other duties required of regular school bus drivers.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.
