Performs semi-skilled work in assisting in the installation, repair, and maintenance of a variety of work involving the use of acetylene and /or electric arc welding equipment to face or cut metallic articles, parts or materials. Assists Welder-Journeyman in most projects to learn all phases of the job. Work is performed under direct supervision and is reviewed in progress and upon completion.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assists Welder-Journeyman with preheating and cleaning metals; lays out, cuts, and fits materials for welding. • Does cutting and welding on such items of machinery and equipment as steam and plumbing systems, pump and engine parts, trailer parts, heavy construction equipment, and similar machinery and apparatus; does flat vertical and horizontal welding on braces, angle brackets and similar items. • Maintains and makes minor repairs to welding equipment; lifts heavy objects on a routine basis. • Performs related work as required.
