



The Summer Reading Assignment:

Step 1: Read selected chapters from the book *Writing Tools* by Roy Peter Clark.

Access the book digitally on the CHS website under Academics --> Language Arts --> AICE Summer Reading

- Select 3 chapters to read in Part One: Nuts & Bolts
- Select 3 chapters to read in Part Two: Special Effects
- Select 3 chapters to read in Part Three: Blueprints
- Section 3 chapters to read in Part Four: Useful Habits

Step 2: Create a digital leaflet [flyer] that highlights the 12 writing tools you read about in each selected chapter. Include both written & visual components on your leaflet. Use a program like Canva or Word to create your leaflet & download it as a PDF for submission. [On Canva, select Share --> Download --> PDF]



Step 3: Create an original chapter to add to this book using the prompt below.

- You have been asked by the publisher of *Writing Tools* to add a chapter to the text, focusing on one more writing tool. Consider the writing instruction you've been exposed to over the years, and write an original chapter that focuses on one specific writing tool. Type the text for this chapter, using no more than 400 words. In your writing, give advice and capture a similar tone to the one in the book.



Step 4: Submit your completed work to Canvas by the due date provided.

- When school begins there will be 2 submission assignments on Canvas where you will upload your PDF of the leaflet and Word document for your original chapter.
