

2020 Horatio Alger Career & Technical Scholarship Application Information

The Horatio Alger Association seeks to assist students who have demonstrated integrity, perseverance in overcoming adversity, strength of character, financial need, commitment to pursue career or technical certification/degree, and a desire to contribute to society.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be considered eligible for Horatio Alger Career & Technical Scholarship Program, applicants must:

- Have completed high school or earned a high school equivalency degree by Spring 2020
- Will be enrolled in eligible program in Fall 2020
- Exhibit a strong commitment to pursue and complete a career or technical program (up to 2 years) at an accredited non-profit post-secondary institution in the United States
- Demonstrated critical financial need (must be eligible to receive the Federal Pell grant as determined by completion of the FAFSA)
- Demonstrated perseverance in overcoming adversity
- Be under the age of 30
- Be a United States citizen

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

To apply for the Career & Technical Scholarship Program, the following items must be completed by April 15, 2020:

- An online application at application.horatioalger.org.
- A copy of the full **Student Aid Report (SAR)**. **Income documentation must be submitted online.**
- Proof of citizenship (if not born in the United States).

Applications submitted after April 15 will be reviewed on a rolling basis and awards are contingent on availability.
