



Criteria for Osceola Fundamental High School Hall of Fame

(To be reviewed annually by committee)

Hall of Fame Purpose

The purpose of the Osceola Fundamental High School Hall of Fame is to recognize and honor individuals who have reflected positively on Osceola Fundamental High School through their performance, service, or achievements, thus inspiring present and future students. Any individual who has been a part of the Osceola community since its inception in 1981 is eligible but must meet certain criteria.

Nominee Eligibility

Nominees shall have brought honor and/or recognition to Osceola Fundamental High School as a former student, distinguished alumni, faculty/staff member, coach, or contributor in some way.

Nomination Procedure

All nominations must be submitted no later than August 15th each year. The Hall of Fame committee will make its selections by September 15. Nominees will be notified in September and will be announced and introduced at a home game. The inductees will then be honored at a Hall of Fame dinner in February. Nominations shall be submitted through this form which will be located on the Hall of Fame page of the school website and shared on social media. Once nominated, a nominee's information will remain on file for 3 years and will be considered on a yearly basis. If a nominee is not chosen within the 3 years of initial submission, he or she can be nominated again. Names of these individuals will be kept confidential.

Nominee Categories and Criteria

1. Former Student (or team/group) - Athletics, Fine Arts (theater, music, band, visual arts), Clubs, etc.
 - Must have graduated from Osceola Fundamental High School and be at least 25 years old
 - Must have demonstrated leadership and outstanding character in school and in the community
 - Must have distinguished him/herself in the field of athletics, the arts, or academics while at Osceola
2. Distinguished Alumni
 - A distinguished alumni nominee becomes eligible on the first day following the 10th anniversary of his or her graduation
 - Must have shown significant success in his/her field or community after high school (examples include but are not limited to: career/business accomplishments, philanthropy/social contributions, military service, other honors, etc.)
3. Former Employee (Administration, Coach/Sponsor, Faculty, or Staff)
 - Must have been an employee with five or more years of service to Osceola
 - Becomes eligible on the first day following the 3rd anniversary of his or her retirement or resignation from Osceola
 - Must have made a significant impact on the Osceola Fundamental High School community in their respective position
4. Contributor
 - The candidate may or may not be a graduate or employee of Osceola (and not categorized above) but has made significant contributions to the Osceola community as a volunteer or supporter

NOTE: An individual who does not meet qualifying criteria may be declared eligible under exceptional circumstances at the discretion of the Hall of Fame Committee.
