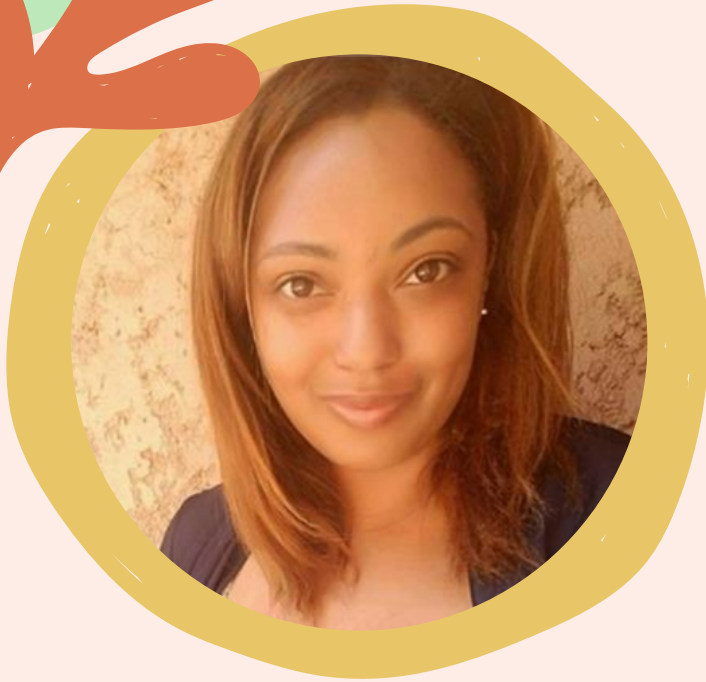


# MEET THE TEACHER
