NATIONAL JUNIOR HONOR SOCIETY REQUIREMENTS

To qualify for NJHS, students must be presently enrolled in the 8th grade and meet each of the following criteria:

- Students must earn a 3.5 cumulative grade point average.
- A total of 20 community service hours will be required during the school year of membership.
- Regular attendance of the student at school (without regular tardiness)
- Active participation in school-related and/or extra-curricular activities and clubs
- No discipline referrals
- No incidences related to the bullying of other students.
- An observable commitment to inclusiveness, kindness and “doing one’s best”

Students accepted as members will formally join NJHS at the annual induction ceremony held in November. Members will participate in a variety of service and leadership activities (to be coordinated with the help of the NJHS Advisor) while a part of NJHS. As members, all students will be expected to continue to meet the standards (academic and otherwise) which served as the basis for their selection to the program. Annual dues of \$25 will be collected and required prior to induction.
