The Grand Chapter of Florida, Order of the Eastern Star, Charitable Foundation, Inc. (Florida Eastern Star) has developed a program that permits funds to cover tuition for those accepted in an accredited college, university, community college or vocational institution. This grant is available to Florida high school seniors, including home schooled students, graduating in 2023 (the "Florida Eastern Star Grant Program").
