In 2023 we are pleased to offer three scholarships to both incoming and returning FSU students!

(1) \$ 1500 Pinellas Seminole Club Legacy Endowed Scholarship through the FSU Foundation for an incoming freshmen

(1) \$1500 Scholarship from Ferg's (College of Education)

(1) \$1000 Pinellas Seminole Club Scholarship for an incoming freshman

(1) \$500 Pinellas Seminole Club Scholarship for a returning undergraduate FSU student

Scholarship Requirements: Due by April 19, 2023

ELIGIBILITY:

Pinellas County Graduates, including high school seniors entering as Freshmen AND returning undergraduate students at Florida State University, are eligible for Pinellas Seminole Club scholarships.

TO APPLY:

2023: Three ways to apply!

1. To apply for the Pinellas Seminole Club Legacy Endowed Scholarship, applications must be submitted through the Academic Works (FS4U) website.
 - a. This option is open only to incoming freshmen accepted and committed to attending Florida State University.
 - b. Other submission methods must be used for returning undergraduate student applications.
2. To apply for either the Pinellas Seminole Club incoming freshman OR returning undergraduate scholarships, applications may be submitted via email.
 - a. Download and complete the scholarship application found here.
 - b. Applicants must complete the application, including an essay response and official transcripts, to be considered. (Must include all requirements)
 - c. If you are an incoming freshman and choose to submit your application via the Academic Works (FS4U) website for the Legacy Endowed Scholarship, there is no

need to apply separately via email. Your application will be considered for both scholarships!

3. To apply for either the Pinellas Seminole Club incoming freshman OR returning undergraduate scholarships, applications may be submitted via mail.
 - a. Print and complete the scholarship application found here.
 - b. Applicants must complete the application, including an essay response and official transcripts, to be considered.
 - c. If you are an incoming freshman and choose to submit your application via the Academic Works (FS4U) website for the Legacy Endowed Scholarship, there is no need to apply separately via mail. Your application will be considered for both scholarships!

DEADLINE:

All applications must be received via Academic Works, email, or postmarked by April 19th, 2023.
