(Check <u>here</u> or talk to your counselor to see if your state has a state aid form you can submit.) Log in to BigFuture. Confirm your qualification for drawing on the dashboard. Verify that you completed the FAFSA, submitted a state aid form, or are legally ineligible to submit both the FAFSA and a state aid form. After verifying that any of these apply to you, you'll be automatically entered into monthly drawings for \$500 and \$40,000 unless you opt out of participation.
