## OPT-IN NOW

# NAMING PROCESS

The Pinellas County School Board is seeking suggestions from the community for naming the new K-8 school.

According to School Board Policy 7250:

- If a school is named by location, the name of the facility shall be descriptive and brief.
- If a school is named for a person, that person shall have been an outstanding civic or educational leader of local or national repute who has been deceased for one year or longer.

# TRANSPORTATION

Transportation will be provided to students who live in the Southern Oak - Walsingham Elementary zone.

If you live 2+ miles from the school, transportation will be provided.







# CONSTRUCTION

## Timeline:

- Renovation and remodeling will start over Spring Break and run through the summer.

## Remodeling will include:

- Turning 6 Southern Oak classrooms into 3 middle school science labs and demonstration areas.
- Transforming Walsingham's administrative office suites into classroom areas.







# SCHOOL POPULATION

Please note: This model is designed for students who have attended 4th and 5th grade at Southern Oak or Walsingham Elementary.

Unless space becomes available, middle school students newly moving into these zones will attend their zoned middle school.

Beginning in the 2025-26 school year, we will launch the new Walsingham Oaks K-8 with a sixth-grade class, adding one grade level each year until it becomes a full K-8 school.

All students currently enrolled at Southern Oak and Walsingham Elementary will have the opportunity to opt-in and continue at the new K-8 school.





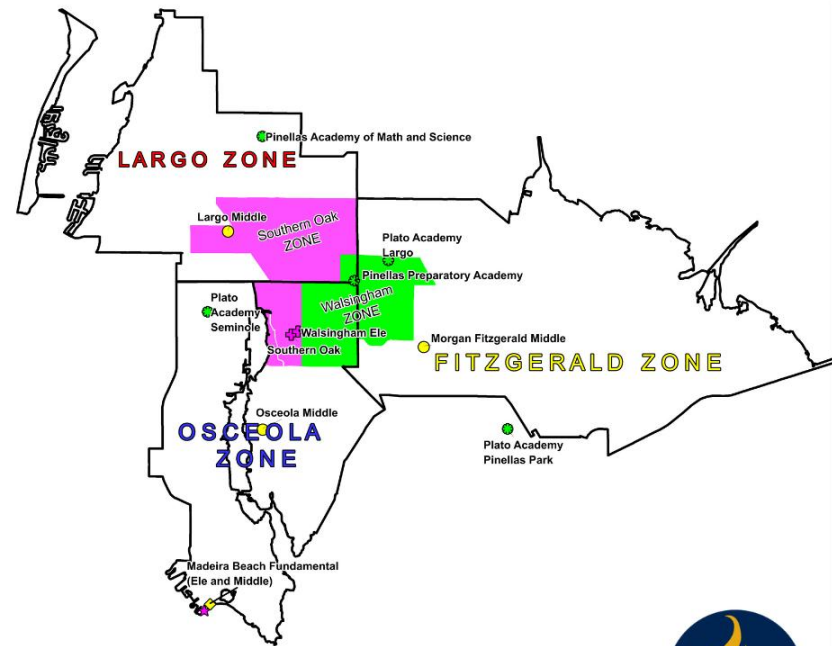
# ZONED K-8 OFFERING

## Southern Oak-Walsingham

There are no zoning changes needed. The current Southern Oak-Walsingham attendance zones for K-8 eligibility will be used.

You have choices:

- Elect to stay through middle school
- Attend your current zoned middle school
- Apply for a middle school magnet or fundamental program





# **ZONED K-8 OFFERING**

**Southern Oak Elementary + Walsingham Elementary = Walsingham Oaks K-8**

Rationale:

- K-8 is a highly desirable educational model
- There are currently a total of 1,591 scholars on wait lists for Sanderlin K-8 & Madeira Beach K-8
