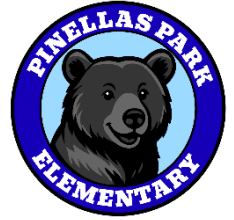

Dress Code

Pinellas Park Elementary will be following the Pinellas County School Board Dress Code Found in the Student Code of Conduct. Below are parts of the dress code summarized:

Shirts:

All shirts and blouses must be appropriately sized and securely fastened. All shirts, tops, and dresses shall have sleeves and cover the shoulders. Shirts must be long enough to completely cover the midriff. No see-through or revealing shirts are allowed. Any shirt graphics must be school appropriate.

Pants:

All pants, shorts, skirts must be in good condition. No rips, tears, or holes in clothing are allowed above mid-thigh. Form fitting leotard/spandex type clothing is not allowed unless proper outer garments cover it to mid-thigh length or longer.

Footwear:

Shoes must be closed toe and have a heel strap or a closed back. NO FLIP FLOPS, SLIDERS, or SANDALS without a back strap are allowed. Shoes meeting PE requirements must be worn on PE designated days.

Head Gear:

No Hats, No Caps, No Hoodies up, no bandanas, no sweatbands, and/or no sunglasses allowed on indoors.

Other Requirements:

No toys shall be brought to school unless specifically allowed by teacher.

Failure to abide by dress code may result in the following:

- Parent contact
- Student required to change clothing
- Repeated offenses can result in discipline including in-school suspensions
