


Applicants who meet the criteria will be considered for the **PTCUP program:**

- A documented intellectual disability
- Exited K12 system At least 18 years old
- Good mobility on adult campus, including transportation to and from campus
- Display a level of social maturity conducive to an adult environment (*i.e. employment and educational setting*)
- Independently maintains self-care and personal hygiene
- Collaborative partnership between **PTCUP** program and parent/ guardian/ family
- Has a reliable means of communication (*Smartphone*)
- No discipline history and good attendance record
- Must work with a peer mentor


