**SUPERVISOR, FOOD SERVICES**  
**(TECHNICAL SERVICES)**

**MAJOR FUNCTION:**

Performs supervisory work in planning, organizing, coordinating, and monitoring the technical service functions within the Food Service Department.

**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Supervises the purchasing of kitchen equipment, kitchen design, equipment maintenance, asset transfers, recycling, and ware-washing
- Serves as liaison between Food Service, Facilities and Planning, and Architect's office for design of new and renovated kitchens
- Analyzes kitchen equipment needs and determines large and small equipment orders for new and existing schools
- Identifies obsolete kitchen equipment and oversees disposal following School Board Policy
- Coordinates all food service asset transfers between school cafeterias and central office
- Inventories all office equipment in the central office.
- Establishes a kitchen equipment replacement plan and coordinates it with the Maintenance Dept
- Coordinates emergency work with Maintenance Department
- Provides Food Safety training for all personnel
- Supervises, evaluates, trains and delegates work to assigned staff
- Coordinates staff development activities as needed
- Assists director and other supervisors with other Food Service duties, as needed
- Performs other related duties as required

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in Food and Nutrition, Hotel and Restaurant Management, or related area. Five (5) years of related professional experience to include two (2) years experience in a supervisory or coordinator capacity in a purchasing related function. Must show evidence of a working knowledge of the principles of quality management or commit to begin training in the area of quality within the first six (6) months of employment.

Master's degree in Institutional Food Management or Business Administration.
