Yom Kippur Wednesday, October 12, 2016 (Observance begins at sunset on Tuesday, October 11, 2016)

Sukkot Monday & Tuesday, October 17 - 18, 2016 (Observance begins at sunset on Sunday, October 16, 2016)

Shemini Atzeret Monday & Tuesday, October 24 - 25, 2016 (Observance begins at sunset on Sunday, October 23, 2016)

April 2017

Passover (First 2 days) Tuesday & Wednesday, April 11 - 12, 2017 (Observance begins at sunset on Monday, April 10, 2017)

Eastern Orthodox Holy Friday Friday, April 14, 2017

Good Friday Friday, April 14, 2017

Seventh & Eighth Day of Passover Monday & Tuesday, April 17 - 18, 2017

May/June 2017

Shavuot Wednesday & Thursday, May 31 - June 1, 2017 (Observance begins at sunset on Tuesday, May 30, 2017)

Eid-al-Fitr Monday, June 26, 2017
