## Bay Vista Fundamental 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Supply List

- 1 zip-up pencil bag (Please no pencil boxes, they are too large for the desks)
- 2 packs of number 2 pencils (Ticonderoga brand recommended, no mechanical pencils or personal sharpeners)
- 1 packs of crayons
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 four-pack of large glue sticks
- \*1 three ring binder (any color) 1-inch, clear pocket on front with pockets on inside (you may want to buy one extra while prices are low, these tend to wear out quickly)
- 1 package of rectangle erasers
- \*2 three-prong, two-pocket folders 1 black, 1 any color
- \*4 composition books, wide ruled (one red, blue, green, and yellow composition book)
- At least 1 pair headphones or ear buds that we will keep in the classroom for computer use (I recommend 2, as they can break quite easily).
- Backpack (no wheels)
