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### Mrs. Keesee's Supply List



- 2 packs of number 2 pencils (Ticonderoga brand recommended, no mechanical pencils or personal sharpeners)
- Zipper pencil pouch
- 1 box of crayons

- Fine point expo markers (3 package any color)
