



Day 3	 Read a nonfiction or informational book for 30 minutes (Your own book, Clever, MyOn, NewsELA, or use articles on website) Identify 4 new/unknown words. Use context clues, a glossary, or a dictionary to define each word. Draw a brief sketch to illustrate the word. Record examples of cause and effect in the text (organizer below)
Day 4	 Read a nonfiction or informational book for 30 minutes (Your own book, Clever, MyOn, NewsELA, or use articles on website) Identify 4 new/unknown words. Use context clues, a glossary, or a dictionary to define each word. Draw a brief sketch to illustrate the word. Complete an organizer to find the main idea and supporting details of the text. Then, write a short summary of the text.
Day 5	 Read a nonfiction or informational book for 30 minutes (Your own book, Clever, MyOn, NewsELA, or use articles on website) Identify 4 new/unknown words. Use context clues, a glossary, or a dictionary to define each word. Draw a brief sketch to illustrate the word.




