FAST Assessments

12/4- PM 2 Math assessment. Please ensure that your student charges their computer the night before.

12-12- PM Reading Assessment.

A few important things to remember:

ADAPTIVE- Assessment is adaptive, so the next batch of questions students get are determined by whether students get the questions correct or incorrect. With that, it's absolutely vital that students give each question their best first attempt (don't skip & return to answer later)- going back & changing the answer later won't impact their overall score.

- TIMING- The FAST MATH & ELA assessment is not timed. With that, students can use the entire school day to take the assessment if needed, so they should not rush.
- BRAIN DUMP

 Students should use their scratch paper for their brain dump.
- PREP FOR PM3– Students will begin the FAST MATH & ELA PM2 at the level that they scored from testing in September. Their FAST ELA PM2 assessment score will dictate where they start the final FAST assessment (PM3) in May. With that, it's vital that they take their time & put their best effort forth on testing this month, for a higher starting point in May.
