ELMS INSTRUMENTAL ENSEMBLES

Instrumental Music is open to all students at East Lake Middle School. Students will be placed in ensembles based on their grade level and/or experience as assessed by the director using the PCSB curriculum guide. Students will focus on instrumental technique, fundamentals of music theory, history, rehearsal and concert techniques, as well as learning to work together as a group.

CLASS MATERIALS

STUDENTS WILL NEED THE FOLLOWING MATERIALS EVERY DAY:

Pencil - you may not write on music in ink

Instrument in good working order – please see additional information about securing a musical instrument Music/Method Book – please see additional information about securing music/method book

Necessary Supplies (reeds, oils, etc. – determined by instrument played)

** Students will be held responsible for these materials. Lost or damaged items will be replaced at the student's expense.

INSTRUMENTS

Most students are expected to provide their own instrument; however, a limited number of school-owned instruments are available. The director will send out information regarding school instruments available for rental. Percussion students are required to provide the disposable items that the director requests, as well as fill out a county instrument rental form and pay the appropriate fee. If a school instrument is used, both parent and student must sign and return the county rental agreement, with the appropriate fee. Any damage or breakage of school instruments must be reported immediately to the director, and a fee may be accessed. If there is a financial concern, please discuss with the director – and arrangements can be made.

**All students will have a dedicated instrument for them to use. No sharing of instruments will occur.

GRADING POLICY

Grading for instrumental music will work on a points system:

DAILY CLASS PARTICIPATION

25 points/day

Every student will earn 25 points a day when PREPARED FOR CLASS & FULLY PARTICIPATING IN THE REHEARSAL. If you do not meet these expectations, then you will not receive the full points for the day. Participation, from EVERY player is EVERYTHING in an instrumental musical ensemble.

QUIZZES / TESTS / PLAYING PASS OFFS

50-100 points

There will be quizzes/tests/playing pass offs in each grading period covering music studied, theory, instrumental techniques, and other areas of musical study.

*CONCERT PERFORMANCES

300+ points

Instrumental music is a performing arts program; therefore, students are expected to attend ALL performances. These concerts are REQUIRED. Failure to perform results in a grade of zero. An unexcused TARDY to a performance or misconduct will lower the concert grade. An alternative assignment must be requested, completed and turned in by the set due date for credit to be given to raise the zero grade. If an absence is unavoidable, the director must be notified **in advance in writing** from the parent or guardian. Students are still required to do the alternate assignment to remove the zero grade. A list of all instrumental events will be posted on the ELMS Performing Arts Webpage.

*Until large group events can resume, we will be looking at different alternatives for concerts.

UNIFORMS

The ELMS Instrumental Music groups will be in uniform, which are provided by each student. The cost for items ordered through the director will be kept as low as possible.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENT:**

SILVER BEAT BAND: ELMS Band Polo, Black pants/long black skirt, black shoes and black socks/tights/hose

SILVER STRINGS: Ladies: Black dress shirt/blouse, Black pants/long black skirt, black shoes and black socks/tights/hose; **Gentlemen**: White long-sleeved dress shirt, black pants, black shoes and black socks. Will wear a tie for dressier performances.

CADET BAND/CADET STRINGS: White Shirt (plain), Black pants/long black skirt, black shoes and black socks/hose/tights

**Due to Covid 19, we will be looking at delaying students getting uniforms until we can safely schedule concerts.

VOLUNTEERS AND CHAPERONES

Parent volunteers are essential for growing and maintaining an award-winning Music Department. Parents are needed for transportation, fundraising, refreshments, and preparation for events. Please contribute to our student's success by volunteering. Parents/Guardians will need to fill out the volunteer form provided by Pinellas County Schools and provide proof of insurance and a copy of the driver's license. Should there be a repeated issue with following the above guidelines, Mrs. Benoit will contact the student first to try to resolve the issue, then the parent.
