Do you love movies/shows on streaming sites or TV? How about videos/reels on social media? Join Digital Media/Video and learn how to make videos and be a filmmaker/content creator. In this pathway students learn skills for working in the tv/film/content creation industries like editing, directing, acting, filming, lighting, audio recording, VFX, and more. You will write and create your own film projects and build a showreel. You could also choose to pursue the broadcast TV pathway and train in roles such as producer, technician, camera operator, video engineers, audio engineers, news anchors, and weather.
