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Students can get on Dreambox at home through Clever. Every students goal is 5-10 lessons/week. They should not exceed 15 lessons per week.

PRE_K/KINDERGARTEN Counting to 100

- Practice counting to 100 starting at any number. Count backwards within 20.
- Count everyday objects and group them into groups of 10 until you get to 100 (see next pg).

1ST GRADE Measurement

- Practice telling & making time to nearest 5 min on a clock (or clock in take home bag).
- Identify and count coins within \$1.00. Give a handful or coins and have them count the total value!

2ND GRADE Geometry

- Identify shapes & their attributes everywhere you go! (See next pg for shapes/attributes).
- Draw & partition shapes into halves, thirds and fourths (equal parts).

3RD GRADE Measurement

- Practice telling & making time on a clock to nearest min (or clock in take home bag).
- Solve word problems with elapsed time (see next pg for examples).

4TH GRADE Geometric Figures

- Identify triangles/angles all around you as acute, right, obtuse, straight or reflex.
- Perimeter and area with unknown sides
- *See next pg for examples

5TH GRADE Measurement & Data

ATTRIBUTES OF 2D SHAPES

VERTEX (VERTICES)
the point where two sides meet



SIDES
line segments that make the outline of the shape

SHAPE	VERTICES	SIDES
CIRCLE	0	0
OVAL	0	0
TRIANGLE	3	3
SQUARE	4	4
RECTANGLE	4	4
PARALLELOGRAM	4	4
RHOMBUS	4	4
TRAPEZOID	4	4
PENTAGON	5	5
HEXAGON	6	6
OCTAGON	8	8

4th Grade

ACUTE ANGLE
Less than 90°



RIGHT ANGLE
Exactly 90°



OBTUSE ANGLE
More than 90°



STRAIGHT ANGLE
Exactly 180°



REFLEX ANGLE
More than 180° and Less than 360°



FULL ANGLE
Exactly 360°
