What an amazing start to 2025 as we have been recognized by Magnet Schools of America as one of the Top Magnet Schools in the nation. As one of only 3 schools in the district to receive this new award, Mildred Helms Elementary IB World School will be recognized among the National Magnet Schools of Excellence during an awards ceremony held at Magnet Schools of America's Conference in Nashville in April.

In order to receive the TOP Magnet Award, members of Magnet Schools of America submit a detailed application then scored by a panel of educators. Schools are judged and scored on their demonstrated ability to raise student academic achievement, promote racial and socioeconomic diversity, provide integrated curricula and instruction, and create strong family and community partnerships that enhance the school's magnet theme. We are so very proud of this recognition!

Thank you to everyone who has participated in our Celebrate Literacy Week Family Literacy Night and Student Led Conferences. We enjoyed a fun filled evening sharing literacy activities and giving away free books for students to create or add to home libraries.

Congratulations to our Boy's Battle of the Books team who finished in 2nd place in their division. 



They understand how to use the Say Something App on their computers or report unsafe behaviors from their own computer or phone. They are encouraged to tell a trusted adult immediately and also report the incident. We are also learning how to make our school feel more welcoming and make everyone feel included, seen and heard. We will continue to learn how to recognize the signs when someone is bullying, acting in an unsafe way and making treats of self-harm. We will be gearing up for Say Something Week in March with activities to help prevent youth violence in school.

For the month of February, we will be focusing on the Social Skill of empathy. We will look into ways a student's behavior can have an effect on their peers as well as encouraging students to think about respecting other people's opinions.



"Hace frio" - It is cold


"Hace calor" - It is hot
