Counselor's Connections






We are getting into the full swing of school, and I am thrilled to get to know your children.

Mr. Kiebzak's Artist's Loft

Hello families! Each grade level has completed their first drawing projects and are currently working on their second! They are doing wonderful work to start off the school year. We are wrapping up our drawing units of study, and October and November we will be getting into different types of paint projects!

Kindergarten finished their Florida Alligator drawing and is now learning about different textures in Art, both tactile and implied.

First grade bloomed some spectacular sunflowers exploring organic shapes & overlapping and learned some oil pastel blending techniques in the process! They are now working on some warm/wavy and some cool/straight landscapes!

Second grade did an amazing observational drawing of a fruit basket called a "Still Life". They are now practicing to draw 3-D shapes which will be the base of their 3-D robot drawings.

Third grade finished drawing & coloring a James Rizzi inspired "Cityscape". These are really fun buildings with depth, fun faces and expression. They just recently started working on their "Self-Portrait" drawing.

Fourth grade learned about shading, color value & lettering styles to complete their graffiti name tag project! They worked real hard on these as there were so many steps. I'm proud of the end results! They are now working on their "Finish The Image" project where they selected a piece of an image and have to draw/color their interpretation of what the rest of the page will look like.

Fifth grade finished their Kids Tag Art project and have started their multi building 1 point perspective drawing. If you signed the slip for the Kids Tag Art license plate project, those will be able to purchase around late November. I will send home information on that as soon as I receive it. Proceeds of these license plate purchases come back to the Mildred Helms Art Dept for supplies. Thanks so much for your support.
