

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INTRODUCTION

This report has been prepared to detail the special projects and programs that have been awarded to the Pinellas County Schools in support of the district's strategic directions during the 2011-2012 school year.

SPECIAL PROJECTS OFFICE

The special projects office is responsible for assuring that the school district has the opportunity to participate in, and maintain compliance for participation in grant programs available through federal, state, local and private sources. The office maintains information regarding existing and pending legislation specific to grants and communicates this information to appropriate school district personnel and the community. A Moodle site and a grants information web page on the district website are available and updated on a regular basis.

The office also provides necessary technical assistance for the development of grant proposals and grant-funded contracts. The special projects office assists with project negotiations and monitors the implementation of regulations, policies, and restrictions of various programs. Furthermore, the office monitors budgetary expenditures, guarantees local commitments, facilitates submission of reports, maintains documents for audit purposes, and coordinates implementation activities of multi-department grant projects. The office serves as grants liaison between the school district and various community agencies and the non-public schools which may be eligible to receive services through certain federal grants
