WHAT IS TITLE 1?

- Title 1 is the largest federal assistance program for our nation's School
- The program serves 95 schools in Pinellas County including eligible students in 38 non-public schools
- Supplemental = Definition: provided in addition to what is already present of available to complete or enhance it.

TITLE 1 BUDGET

1. Intervention Teachers

2 intervention teachers-\$62,255 2. Family Community Liasion

\$4,159 - pays for 1 extra hour per day for Family Community to be on campus for 5 hours instead of 4.

Instructional Materials

\$7,524- Headphones for testing, chart paper, markers, can be used for technology or other needs to support the classroom.
