## NEWS YOU CAN USE ...

- Attention Parents, we are asking that you follow all traffic/parking laws that are posted around the campus. Some of our neighbors are being inconvenienced by our parking during arrival and dismissal. SPPD will be monitoring and issuing tickets to those that are illegally parked. Please be sure that you are not on the receiving end of a traffic ticket by following the traffic/parking guidelines.
- Connect for Success: 1:1 devices can be brought home for student use. If you would like to give your student permission to bring their device home, please login to Focus and sign the agreement. If you need assistance with this, please call Ms. Lavalla, our Library Media Technician at 727-893-1815.
- As shared at our Open House, detentions are now a part of our Schoolwide Discipline Plan. Detentions are assigned after behaviors have been communicated with families and the behaviors still occur. Detentions are held on Tuesdays and Thursdays each week. (30-min detentions are 3:15-3:45: 1-hour detentions are 3:15-4:15). If your child is assigned a detention, it is your responsibility to pick them up promptly, at the end of their detention assignment.
