# SUPPLY LIST

*\*Please do not put students' names on supplies except pencil box.*

- 24 #2 Ticonderoga brand pencils (any brand is fine, prefer pre-sharpened)
- **A 5 SUBJECT SPIRAL NOTEBOOK** (If you cannot purchase, then get 5 composition books in primary colors. )
- 2 packs of 24 crayons
- 1 pair of student sized scissors
- 2 3-ring binders (any color) 1-inch, clear pocket on front with pockets on inside (you may want to buy extra while prices are low. These tend to wear out quickly).
- 1 package of rectangular erasers
