Pages 5 - 7

- ⇒ Kojo's life and the reason he is so tired.
- ⇒ In the beginning of the story, why do you think the author describes Kojo's house?
- ⇒ Visualize Kojo's village. What are some words from the text that helped you create your picture?
- ⇒ Each family purchases something different with their share of the loan. Note the significance of each family's choice and identify similarities among the choices?

Pages 15 - 24

- ⇒ Kojo faces many challenges in making his dreams come true. Discuss these challenges.
- ⇒ Using a map, highlight the places named on page 24. Discuss Kojo's success.

- ⇒ What is a loan and why is it important to Kojo's family? (pg. 6-7)
- ⇒ Describe the importance of the items Kojo and his mother choose to buy. (pg. 6-7)
- ⇒ Using details from the text, explain what the author means when he writes, "Bit by bit, one small hen is making a big difference"? (p.11)
- ⇒ Throughout the story, Kojo's dream changes. Identify and explain the changes in his dream.
